Rashid Shaheed stands out as a weak link amongst the wide receivers, further confounding their chances. While they managed to acquire Jarquez Hunter slightly later than expected, questionable drafting decisions,

notably on quarterbacks like Joe Burrow and Justin Herbert, have drastically undermined their potential value. Even if Burrow and Higgins can maximize their stack bonus, it seems unlikely they'll lift 11AgainstTheWorld from their current predicament, leaving fans bracing for another challenging season.


