Bionic Elbows did almost everything right on draft day, and the standings are going to be brutal about it anyway. The value discipline was real: Antonio Williams fell nearly two and a half rounds before this team took him, Rachaad White and Jacory Croskey-Merritt both slid nearly two rounds past their ADPs, and the board delivered Josh Allen and Jayden Daniels with stacks attached in D.J. Moore and Terry McLaurin. Twelve chalk picks and zero major reaches. The process was clean. The problem is that waiting for value only works when the value eventually arrives, and projections have this roster sitting twelfth in the Ace Attorney division, bottom twelve percent of the field. When the best receiver on your sheet is McLaurin at WR24 and your weakest projected starter is Blake Corum at RB35, patience during the draft does not manufacture upside that was never on the board. Bionic Elbows bought every ticket at a discount and still lost the lottery, which is the kind of outcome that makes you question whether the game is worth playing at all.

There is no spin available for kunleberdeen, and the draft board tells the whole story. Four major reaches across the draft, zero steals, and a 15th-percentile projection that lands this team 11th in the Ace Attorney division confirm that the problems are structural, not cosmetic. The two biggest crimes came early: Joe Burrow at QB4 and Caleb Williams at QB6 were both pulled nearly a full round before the market said to take them, burning premium capital on a position that in a positionless format should be the last place you overpay. That aggressive QB investment did not buy a better team, it just foreclosed better options elsewhere. Then there is Alec Pierce, projected at WR32 and theoretically a starting-caliber piece, except Pierce had offseason ankle surgery and landed on the PUP list, meaning he could miss the first four games entirely. A roster that was already drafting behind the curve is now potentially starting the season a key contributor short. Despondency feels like the appropriate setting here.

There is a version of this Dabears roster that looks fine on paper, and then there is the version that actually matters. Christian McCaffrey at RB3 is genuinely elite, and the Jaxson Dart and Malik Nabers stack gives the team a ceiling it can point to on its best week. But this is a squad sitting at 30th percentile and tenth in the Ace Attorney division, and the draft decisions do not inspire much confidence in a turnaround. The manager reached on five players before their ADPs, including Bucky Irving at 1.6 rounds early and Emmett Johnson at nearly three rounds early, which is a significant overpay on a back projected at RB54. Meanwhile, the team managed zero steals across the entire draft. Davante Adams at WR25 and Hunter Henry at TE18 slid nicely as values, but two fortunate falls cannot paper over a draft that spent capital in the wrong places at the wrong time. McCaffrey carries this team or nobody does, and that is a fragile foundation for sixteen weeks.

ToshiGang executed the value game about as cleanly as anyone in this draft, landing six players at or after their ADP, including James Cook at RB5 a full half-round late and Tre Tucker falling more than two rounds to pick 17.04. The discipline was real. The problem is that discipline and results are not the same thing. Lamar Jackson, taken ninth picks ahead of his ADP at 1.04, is the kind of reach that feels justified in the moment and quietly taxes the rest of the board, and the receiver group behind Rashee Rice at WR13 thins out fast, with Michael Pittman projecting at WR44 and nobody above that between them. The Mahomes and Rice stack adds a weekly ceiling that can bail out a mediocre slate, but ToshiGang is sitting ninth in the Ace Attorney division and in the bottom half of the field, which is exactly the outcome you get when every individual decision looks correct and the roster still does not quite cohere into something dangerous.

Kevin8892 sits eighth in the Ace Attorney division and at just the 44th percentile of the field, and the draft record offers little reason for optimism. The three major reaches tell the story: Tua Tagovailoa at QB31 and J.J. McCarthy at QB37 were both taken well ahead of their ADPs, locking up capital on quarterbacks who project as clear liabilities, while Sean Tucker at RB65 was grabbed nearly four rounds early for what amounts to a fringe fantasy contributor. The receiver group is genuinely strong, with Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, Nico Collins at WR9, and Tee Higgins at WR19 all projecting as starters, and Collins arriving as one of only two draft-day values on the entire roster. But that receiver depth can only carry so much weight when the quarterback situation grades out weak and the draft capital spent on reaching for Tagovailoa and McCarthy bought nothing resembling a solution. There is no obvious lever left to pull, and the ceiling here looks uncomfortably similar to the floor.

Wholahay is the kind of team that wins a Scott Fish Bowl by doing enough things right, not by doing anything spectacular. The floor is genuinely impressive: Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and A.J. Brown at WR8 give this roster a top-end punch most managers in the Ace Attorney division cannot match, and Harold Fannin at TE6 and Sam LaPorta at TE8 represent real value, with Fannin arriving a full round past his ADP. The ceiling, though, is where the margins creep in. Jakobi Meyers projects as the weakest projected starter at WR45, and that fifth-best option matters in a format where the difference between advancing and going home is often one bad week from a fringe piece. Kirk Cousins stands out as the roster's one genuinely uncomfortable decision, reached 3.2 rounds ahead of his ADP as a QB35. The elite receivers carry Wholahay into contention at the 56th percentile, but this season will not be decided by Chase or Brown. It will be decided by the players beneath them.

mrBIG21 didn't light the draft board on fire, and that's exactly the point. With 16 chalk picks, two values, and zero major reaches, this is a team built on discipline rather than desperation, and the results speak quietly but clearly. Drake London slipping to WR7 at 2.10 when the field was taking him a few picks earlier, and Justin Herbert falling a full round past his ADP to land as QB8, are exactly the kind of compounding advantages that separate a solid roster from an also-ran. Add Bijan Robinson at RB2 as the projected backfield anchor and a wide receiver group that runs four starters deep, including Jaylen Waddle, Rome Odunze, and Brian Thomas Jr., and mrBIG21 has real scoring equity baked in before even picking a lineup. The one genuine question mark is Jalen Hurts, whose five straight top-10 finishes make him easy to trust, but the offseason departure of A.J. Brown puts his passing volume in uncertain territory. A 57th-percentile projection feels conservative for a roster this consistently constructed.

Str8Savages didn't build this roster with one flashy move. They built it pick by pick, and the cumulative result lands them in the 64th percentile with a starting group that's genuinely hard to attack. CeeDee Lamb at WR5 and Trey McBride at TE2 give this team a pair of projected top-tier producers at their positions, and DeVonta Smith (WR14) and Emeka Egbuka (WR18) round out a receiver corps that could carry a week on its own. Egbuka is worth singling out: taken at pick 5.11 against an ADP of 4.08, he's the clearest evidence that Str8Savages drafted with patience and discipline rather than chasing names. The draft log shows 16 chalk calls and just two minor reaches, which sounds boring until you realize boring drafts with Lamb and McBride at their cores tend to win in November. Derrick Henry at RB12 keeps the ground game respectable. This isn't a team built around one bet. It's a team built around not losing the draft, and on that measure, Str8Savages mostly won it.

joey9toes didn't win the 2026 draft with one thunderbolt pick. They won it by being right almost every time. The foundation is a tight end group that reads like a fever dream for the position: Colston Loveland (TE3), Tyler Warren (TE4), Tucker Kraft (TE5), Kyle Pitts (TE7), and George Kittle (TE9) are all projected starters, and that's before getting to Isaiah Likely (TE13) and Mark Andrews (TE14). Kraft's situation alone is quietly compelling, stepping back into a Packers offense that lost more receivers than it added, which means his path to a starring role is largely unobstructed if he can recapture his pre-injury form. Then there's Puka Nacua (WR1), who slipped to 1.05 despite an ADP of 1.01, essentially handing joey9toes a WR1 at a slight discount. That's not a dramatic heist, just competent execution at the exact moment it mattered. A team that finished in the 99th percentile in scoring in 2025

now sits at 70th percentile in projections, which sounds like a step back until you actually look at what's on this roster.

There was no heist here, no midnight swing for a superstar that may or may not pan out. bdams just drafted well, round after round, and the cumulative effect is a roster sitting at the 72nd percentile with a genuine case to go higher. The engine is a backfield anchored by Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and De'Von Achane at RB6, the latter arriving a full round after his ADP suggested he'd be gone, which is the kind of quiet competence that separates good drafts from forgettable ones. Garrett Wilson at WR17, Ladd McConkey at WR20, and Mike Evans at WR27 give the receiver group real teeth, and Travis Kelce, who reportedly considered stepping away before officially committing to another season, adds upside at TE10 if he can claw back toward the top twelve at his position. There are no household-name steals on this sheet, just sixteen chalk picks and three values that all quietly landed in bdams' favor. Third in the Ace Attorney division for now, but the math says there's more room to climb.

samlawyer didn't build this roster with one flashy move. This is a team assembled pick by pick, quietly coming out ahead at almost every turn. The receiver group is the clearest proof: Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4, Chris Olave at WR11, Luther Burden at WR22, and Parker Washington at WR35 all project as starters, giving this lineup a tier of wideouts that most managers in this field would envy. Jonathan Taylor at RB4 anchors the backfield and is the kind of asset that keeps a roster in contention even when other things go sideways. On the draft itself, the value picks tell the story. Zach Charbonnet fell nearly two rounds past his ADP before samlawyer grabbed him, and Isiah Pacheco and Chuba Hubbard were similarly available later than they had any right to be. The Mac Jones reach is the one mild asterisk on an otherwise clean draft, but Jones sits outside the projected starting lineup anyway. Second in the division and 74th percentile overall, this team earned its standing the quiet, reliable way.

devinmci didn't win the draft room with one thunderbolt pick. He won it by being right, over and over, in ways that compound quietly. The foundation is hard to argue with: Justin Jefferson at WR6 and Brock Bowers at TE1 give this roster two players who project as genuinely elite at their positions, and pairing Kyler Murray with Jefferson as a stack adds a layer of upside that can separate good weeks from great ones. What makes this roster worth admiring, though, is how the middle of the draft held up. George Pickens landing at WR10 after slipping nearly a full round past his ADP, Khalil Shakir falling almost two rounds to his spot, and Terrance Ferguson sneaking past his number too, none of those were accident. They were patience. The one blemish, reaching four-plus rounds early for Darnell Washington, barely registers against that backdrop. devinmci finished 2025 in the 93rd percentile and currently sits first in the Ace Attorney division. The process that built this thing looks just as sharp heading into 2026.
