There is no flattering angle here. cmcentee80 landed in the bottom 10 percent of the field and sits dead last in the Aiai division, and the draft record explains exactly how it happened: zero steals, zero values, four major reaches, and a positional anchor at WR that amounts to Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and then essentially nothing. The reaches are the real autopsy, though. Jordan James was pulled six-plus rounds before his ADP, a move so aggressive it borders on performance art. Tyler Shough was grabbed 2.5 rounds early at a position where cmcentee80 already had Trevor Lawrence projected as a starter. The team leans heavily on a running game headlined by James Cook at RB5 and Derrick Henry at RB12, which is genuinely good, but every dollar of goodwill those two generate gets spent covering for a receiver room that collapses after one name and a draft process that treated ADP as a polite suggestion rather than a useful signal.

BrianRobinsonNR enters 2026 ranked 11th in the Aiai division and in just the 13th percentile of the field, and the roster construction tells you exactly why. The backfield is genuinely excellent, Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Jonathan Taylor at RB4 anchoring a group that could carry a contender, but the receiver corps is the roster's death sentence, Courtland Sutton at WR37 and Chris Godwin at WR38 projecting as the top two options in a format where wideout production matters enormously. The draft didn't help matters. Bo Nix was snagged 2.2 rounds ahead of his ADP at QB15, a reach that cost real capital at a position where C.J. Stroud, taken much later at a similar QB22 projection, suggests the manager paid a steep premium for little gain. Pull on any thread here and the same problem unravels: tremendous running back depth propping up a roster that grades out near the bottom because the surrounding cast simply isn't good enough to matter.

There is no soft landing for FFRRedMan in the Aiai division, just a draft sheet that reads like a confession. The roster is anchored by genuine talent, Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Saquon Barkley at RB8 give this team a real foundation, but the draft capital spent building around that foundation tells the story of a manager who panicked and reached compulsively. Cam Ward, a QB23, came off the board nearly four full rounds before his ADP. Daniel Jones, a QB25, followed two-plus rounds early. Together they consumed premium draft equity chasing quarterback depth that projects as middling at best, while the receiver group quietly collapsed into Xavier Worthy at WR49 and Jayden Higgins at WR54 as the projected starters. Zero steals, zero values, three major reaches across the entire draft. The math does not forgive that kind of drafting, and the 15th percentile projection confirms it. Robinson and Barkley deserved better architects.

Sacman37 sits ninth in the Aiai division and in the 19th percentile of the field, and the roster offers little reason to expect a dramatic reversal. The draft tells most of the story: fourteen chalk picks, two major reaches, and zero steals. Jaxson Dart, reached 2.2 rounds ahead of his ADP, projects as a QB11, which is serviceable but not the kind of dart throw you want to anchor a roster built this conservatively everywhere else. Tony Pollard, the other major reach, projects as an RB30 and grades out as the weakest projected starter on the team. That is two of the biggest draft-capital decisions producing middling outcomes. Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 is genuinely elite and gives Sacman37 a floor to stand on, and Nico Collins projects as a WR9 with starting upside, but beyond those two the drop-off is steady and steep. The Brock Purdy and Mike Evans stack adds a thin thread of ceiling, but threading needles is not a strategy when the roster grades out near the bottom of the field with no obvious lever left to pull.

HeathGoad enters 2026 sitting eighth in the Aiai division and at just the 32nd percentile of the field, and the roster doesn't offer much of an argument against either number. The draft tells the story plainly: two major reaches against one steal, which is roughly the ledger of a manager who spent premium capital chasing upside and watched it evaporate. Malik Willis at QB24 is the projected weakest starter on the roster, taken 2.4 rounds before his ADP, and that kind of aggressive misfire at quarterback is hard to recover from in a positionless format where you need your best players to actually be good players. George Kittle, the one genuine value find, graded out as a steal at TE9, but Kittle spent the offseason recovering from an Achilles tear and his Week 1 availability is genuinely uncertain, which means even the best card in the hand comes with an asterisk that has nothing to do with fantasy projections. Drake Maye and A.J. Brown give HeathGoad a legitimate stack to build around, but a functional floor is not the same thing as a ceiling, and this team needs one badly.

rockvelvet sits seventh in the Aiai division and right at the 40th percentile of the field, and nothing about the draft process suggests a climb is coming. The clearest problem is at the top: De'Von Achane, the projected RB6 and one of the roster's two elite anchors alongside Justin Jefferson, was taken nearly a full round early at 1.11. Paying a premium for a player and then needing him to hit perfectly just to break even is not a recipe for outscoring anyone. The draft did produce a genuine win in Ashton Jeanty, a projected RB7 who fell 1.4 rounds to pick 4.02, but one late-round gift does not restructure a roster that grades out with a weakest projected starter of Wan'Dale Robinson at WR47. Jefferson and Jeanty are real, and Matthew Stafford and Harold Fannin give the lineup functional production at their spots, but this is a team built around two stars and then a long drop-off, with four reaches already committed and no obvious surplus to trade away. Seventh place looks about right.

jhynes67 sits at 43rd percentile and sixth in the Aiai division, which is precisely the kind of standing that makes a season feel like it hinges on a coin flip. The core is genuinely good: Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and Jayden Daniels at QB5 give this roster a ceiling that most managers in the middle of the pack cannot match. But the margins that will decide this season live in the draft's smaller decisions, and those cut both ways. DeVonta Smith at WR14 arriving just under a round late is the kind of quiet find that compounds over a long tournament. Sean Tucker at RB65, on the other hand, was taken 4.6 rounds ahead of his ADP, a commitment to a projection that the numbers simply do not support. That one reach does not sink a roster built around Chase and Daniels, but it is a reminder that this team earns nothing automatically. The talent at the top keeps jhynes67 dangerous; the choices at the margins keep them vulnerable.

mefreedman did not win the draft with one earth-shaking pick. This team was built pick by pick, in the way that actually holds up over a long season. The receiving corps is the engine: Malik Nabers (WR12), Tee Higgins (WR19), Luther Burden (WR22), Davante Adams (WR25), and D.J. Moore (WR26) give this roster a projected starting group that most managers in the field would envy, and that is before accounting for DK Metcalf (WR36) lurking behind them. Meanwhile, the quarterback situation is quietly the best argument for mefreedman's chances: Josh Allen (QB1) and Lamar Jackson (QB3) are not depth insurance for each other, they are two of the most valuable players in the format, and Jackson arriving at 2.07 against an ADP of 2.03 means the cost was essentially market rate. Throw in the Allen-Moore stack as a bonus correlation and the floor rises further. The draft log reads like someone who did their homework and then just stayed disciplined, 17 chalk calls, two genuine values, and

nothing that backfires. Fifth in the Aiai division at the 73rd percentile is a fair landing spot, but this roster has the pieces to climb.

There was no heist here, no moment where eabelson fleeced the room for a WR1. What there was, quietly and repeatedly, was a draft that just kept coming out ahead. Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Drake London at WR7 give this roster a receiver core that most managers in the Aiai division would trade their entire late-round section to own, and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 and Jameson Williams at WR21 round out a group of projected starters that amounts to genuine, compounding quality. The running back side is where the value hunting showed most clearly: Bucky Irving fell a full round and a half past his ADP before eabelson stepped in at 8.08, and Bhayshul Tuten slipped another round before getting claimed at 9.05. Neither move looks like luck. Fourteen chalk picks and only one major reach tell you what kind of drafter this is: someone who trusts the board, collects what the board offers, and does not manufacture drama where none is needed. Landing at 75th percentile in the field reflects a team built to be exactly that good.

There are no magic tricks in alexandrehebert's draft, no lottery-ticket swings that either saved the roster or sank it, just a steady accumulation of edge that compounded into something genuinely dangerous. The clearest example is Joe Burrow, a QB4 projection who fell half a round past his ADP and landed at 2.11, the kind of quiet transaction that separates disciplined drafters from everyone else. Terry McLaurin is another one, a WR24 who slipped more than a full round and now slots in as a projected starter at a price that should have been impossible. Pair those two values with Puka Nacua at WR1, the unambiguous top projection at his position, and alexandrehebert's floor looks remarkably high before you even get to the depth. At 87th percentile in the field and third in the Aiai division, this roster reflects what good process actually looks like: not the thrill of one great pick, but a draft where the manager almost never lost an exchange.

zgreub didn't stumble into correlation, they engineered it. The spine of this roster runs through Dallas: Dak Prescott stacked with both CeeDee Lamb (WR5) and Jake Ferguson (TE12), meaning when that offense erupts, zgreub scores in waves rather than trickles. Lamb at WR5 and Ferguson at TE12 are legitimate weekly difference-makers on their own, but the point is that their ceilings compound each other, and that's the whole game plan. The value story reinforces the vision rather than distracting from it, because zgreub landed Lamb at 2.04 despite an ADP of 1.11 and grabbed Ferguson more than a round late, so the stack didn't cost a premium to assemble. Trey McBride (TE2) adds a second elite tight end who lifts the floor when Dallas has an off night. The 2025 résumé, a 75 percent win rate and 98th-percentile scoring, suggests this manager knows exactly what kind of team wins this tournament, and the 2026 build looks like a deliberate evolution of that same philosophy rather than an accident.

MaxDunbar sits first in the Aiai division and at the 96th percentile of the field, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. The steals column tells the story cleanly: Travis Kelce slid three-plus rounds past his ADP and landed here, Kyle Pitts fell two full rounds into MaxDunbar's lap, and both project as starters alongside Brock Bowers at TE1 and Colston Loveland at TE3. That is not luck, that is a manager who knew what the board was doing and stayed patient until it rewarded him. The discipline extends to the receiver corps, where George Pickens projects as WR10 and Jaylen Waddle came in a round late at WR23. The one name worth watching is Marvin Harrison Jr., a WR33 projection whose first two seasons have underdelivered against enormous expectations, and whose situation in Arizona remains genuinely unsettled at quarterback. That is a real question mark, but in a draft with zero reaches across twenty picks, MaxDunbar earned the right to carry one.
