Questionable draft choices, like reaching for Patrick Mahomes and Keaton Mitchell, have cost the team valuable capital, leaving a noticeable impact on their overall

strategy. As the season unfolds, FrankDuffy will need a strategic overhaul and perhaps a bit of luck to recapture the momentum of last year's respectable finish.

As the 2025 fantasy football season looms on the horizon, schardt312 finds itself in a precarious position, balancing hopes for improvement against the reality of last year's middling performance. Sitting at a lowly 10th in their division and languishing in the bottom 9th percentile overall, this team faces an uphill battle. Their wide receiver corps is the undeniable strength, led by Justin Jefferson WR2 and Garrett Wilson WR14, yet the pressure falls on Emeka Egbuka WR49 to step up as a projected starter, despite being the weak link. The running back situation, ranking 7th in the division, features Chuba Hubbard RB18, whom they reached for early, alongside Isiah Pacheco RB29 and Jaylen Warren RB32. Some savvy drafting saw value picks like Jalen Hurts and Rashid Shaheed shore up other parts of the roster, but questionable decisions overshadow these gains, notably the

reach for quarterback Jordan Love, which cost them potential depth elsewhere. With a tournament history that saw them scrape the mid-40s percentile last year, schardt312 must navigate these challenges and find consistency if they hope to rise from the doldrums of past seasons.

As ESPlathletics gears up for the 2025 season, the outlook is anything but rosy, casting a shadow over their aspirations. Although their wide receiver lineup shines with the likes of CeeDee Lamb and Malik Nabers leading the pack, the team languishes at a disappointing rank of 9 in their Alpine Racing division and a disheartening 26th percentile overall. The running back core, despite Omarion Hampton offering a glimmer of hope, struggles with depth and consistency, notably with Jaydon Blue's precarious position as RB42, making his season pivotal for any chance of success. While they boast a youthful average age of 23.8 and managed to snag some valuable players slightly after their expected draft spots, questionable draft choices have left them vulnerable. Adonai Mitchell, taken well ahead of his ADP, underscores this misstep, placing additional strain on their prospects. As they




face an uphill battle, hopes rest heavily on their young talents rising to the occasion, though the daunting road ahead may prove too steep.
