There is no diplomatic way to say this: LRH is staring at a rough 2026 from almost every angle. The roster grades out near the bottom of the Among Us division and fourth percentile in the field, and the draft process did not do much to change the trajectory. Of the nineteen picks, thirteen landed on chalk and five were reaches of varying degrees, including C.J. Stroud pulled 2.4 rounds ahead of his ADP at QB22, a gamble that looks aggressive given where he projects. The one genuine standout is Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1, a legitimate weekly anchor, but below him the lineup thins fast, with Romeo Doubs projected as the weakest starter at WR53. Dak Prescott and George Pickens form a real stack, and Prescott grades out as a QB7, so the ceiling is there in flashes. But a roster built on one elite piece, a shaky middle tier, and a draft that mostly colored inside the lines is not a formula for climbing out of the basement. LRH needs things to break right in a big way.

Mike Virginia's 2026 campaign looks like a slow leak nobody noticed until the tire was already flat. Sitting 11th in the Among Us division and in just the 5th percentile of the field, the roster has real problems at the top, and the draft didn't generate the kind of surplus that rescues bottom-tier builds. Virginia spent a full round of capital reaching on Josh Jacobs at RB16, only to watch that pick get clouded by an offseason arrest stemming from a domestic violence situation, with no charges filed but plenty of uncertainty hanging over his availability and production. D'Andre Swift cost two rounds of draft premium as well, so Virginia has leaned heavily on running backs who were priced above market before a single snap. The receiver room is thin at the top, with Davante Adams at WR25 as the projected anchor, and the best available tight end is Kenyon Sadiq at TE21, who projects as the weakest starter on the roster. Drake Maye is legitimately exciting at QB2, but one elite quarterback can only carry so much weight when the rest of the depth chart is already starting from behind.

There is not much to soften here: cfishy81 is sitting 10th in the Among Us division and in the bottom 10 percent of the entire field, and the draft did not move the needle. The roster logged three major reaches and three minor reaches against zero steals, a balance sheet that leaves almost no margin for error. Ashton Jeanty at RB7 is a legitimate anchor, but cfishy81 reached a full round early to get him, meaning the value was spent before it was earned. Bo Nix, taken nearly two rounds before his ADP, grades out as QB15, which is a fine depth piece but an expensive one given where that pick landed. The supporting cast does not bail anyone out: the weakest projected starter is Jordan Addison at WR43, and the 2025 campaign finished at 28 percent wins and 28th percentile in scoring, so there is no recent momentum to cite as a counterargument. cfishy81 is not one good week from turning this around; the roster as constructed is asking a lot of luck to show up early and stay late.

AustanKas won 61 percent of their matchups last season and scored in the 86th percentile, which is the kind of résumé that earns a manager some goodwill heading into a new year. The 2026 projection is here to spend it all. A 21st percentile forecast and a division rank of ninth suggest the 2025 version of this team was doing things the 2026 version simply cannot replicate. The roster construction offers some clues why. Colston Loveland at TE3 was a genuine steal, falling nearly a round and a half past his ADP, and the tight end group as a whole grades out strong. But the roster's ceiling depends on players producing above their projections, and the draft featured four major reaches, including Jayden Reed at WR48 and Saquon Barkley taken over a round ahead of his ADP. Jordan Love quarterbacking the operation does not help, a QB17 who has never cracked the top ten in fantasy scoring despite being exactly the kind of efficient, turnover-averse signal-caller that wins real football games and loses fantasy leagues. Reputation carried AustanKas far in 2025. Projection says the bill comes due in 2026.

Dilly dilly drafted with discipline. Almost every pick landed at or after ADP, and the two steals, Tucker Kraft and Greg Dulcich, both fell multiple rounds past their price tags. The problem is that disciplined drafting and good outcomes are not the same thing, and this roster is the proof. The starting group is built around a remarkable collection of backfield talent, Bijan Robinson at RB2, De'Von Achane at RB6, Derrick Henry at RB12, Breece Hall at RB14, and Kyren Williams at RB15 among the projected starters. In a positionless format that depth is genuinely deployable, and yet the team still sits at 43rd percentile and eighth in the division. The reason is Travis Hunter at WR62 and Antonio Williams at WR64 contributing almost nothing at the top of the receiver projection, combined with Tyler Shough at QB20 and Malik Willis at QB24 offering zero upside at quarterback. Shough is 27 years old and hoping for a leap that older players rarely make. You can draft correctly and still lose, and Dilly dilly is on track to prove it.

ShadyLtd is the kind of team that will drive its manager absolutely insane by March, and not in the fun way. The floor here is real: Josh Allen at QB1 paired with D.J. Moore at WR26 gives this roster a genuine stack that can win any single week, and A.J. Brown at WR8 and Tee Higgins at WR19 round out a starting group with legitimate upside. But the 44th percentile ranking tells the real story, because every edge this roster has gets quietly offset somewhere else. Kenneth Gainwell projects as the weakest projected starter at RB34, a meaningful drag in a format where every player slot counts. The draft offered almost no separation, sixteen chalk picks with one major reach on Emmett Johnson taken nearly three rounds early, which means ShadyLtd enters 2026 with essentially the market consensus and no hidden leverage. After a 28 percent win rate in 2025, this team needs things to break right, not just go according to plan.

hinesk5 drafted like someone who trusted their board more than anyone else trusted theirs, and the results are hard to argue with. The major reach on J.J. McCarthy, taken nearly four rounds early, and the minor reach on Kyler Murray, pulled almost two rounds ahead of schedule, look like aggressive overpays on paper, but those two quarterbacks now sit as QB37 and QB19 projections behind the anchor of Jayden Daniels at QB5, giving this team genuine upside at the position regardless of which arm catches fire. The real story, though, is the receiver group. Puka Nacua projects as WR1, Nico Collins at WR9, Tetairoa McMillan at WR15, and Zay Flowers at WR16 form a top line that most managers would not assemble by design, let alone through a draft where thirteen picks landed at chalk. hinesk5 somehow built a 61st-percentile roster by reaching too early and too often and still coming up roses. Call it conviction, call it luck, call it both. The roster does not much care what you call it.

Chubbarubbas didn't win the draft on one flashy pick. They won it the way a good poker player wins a session: quietly, consistently, and by the end you're not sure exactly where it happened. The foundation is legitimate, with Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Justin Jefferson at WR6 anchoring a roster that projected starters alone would carry into most weeks. From there, the draft kept delivering. Courtland Sutton fell a full round past his ADP, Xavier Worthy fell another, and Jalen Nailor and Tre Tucker slid even further, giving the back half of the roster a cushion most managers don't have. The one blemish is Elijah Arroyo, reached for 4.4 rounds early at TE40, though in a positionless format the cost is absorbed more easily than it would be elsewhere. Sitting fifth in the Among Us division and at the 62nd tournament percentile, chubbarubbas isn't a championship favorite yet, but the draft gave them every chance to become one. This roster was built without luck. That tends to matter.

Jaggfann1 didn't make headlines on draft day, but the ledger at the end of it looked quietly excellent. The backbone of this roster is a starting group that just keeps producing: Lamar Jackson at QB3, Omarion Hampton at RB9, Jeremiyah Love at RB13, and Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 give this team a ceiling that most managers in the Among Us division would take without hesitation. Then there's Jaylen Waddle, a genuine value at WR23, scooped up a full round past his ADP. Waddle escapes one of the league's more dysfunctional passing offenses and lands in Denver alongside Courtland Sutton, where Bo Nix threw the ball more than any quarterback in the league last year. That context makes the value even sharper. The draft was heavy on chalk, which is not a criticism when the chalk includes four projected starters in the top third of their positions. Jaggfann1 lands at 65th percentile and fourth in the division, numbers that feel like a floor more than a ceiling.

Clembots didn't need a heist to build one of the more quietly dangerous rosters in the Among Us division. The receiver group alone tells the story: Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, Chris Olave at WR11, and Garrett Wilson at WR17 form a projected starting core that would make most managers envious, and Terry McLaurin at WR24 and Mike Evans at WR27 didn't even start that list. Evans is the draft in miniature, actually, falling nearly two rounds past his ADP before clembots scooped him at pick 8.06. That kind of discipline repeated itself across the board, with four players landing as genuine values against ADP and only two real misfires, a premature grab at Jacoby Brissett and an aggressive reach on Keenan Allen. Neither should sink a team sitting at the 74th tournament percentile with James Cook projected at RB5 anchoring the backfield. After a 39 percent win rate in 2025, clembots didn't swing for the fences to rebuild. They just drafted better.

DoctorSquatch didn't force anything in the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl draft, and the roster reflects exactly that kind of patience. The headliner is Ja'Marr Chase, a WR2 projection who gives this team a genuine top-end anchor, but the more telling story is how DoctorSquatch kept adding value well into the middle and late rounds. Tyler Warren was the clearest example, a TE4 projection who slid a full round and a half past his ADP before DoctorSquatch reached out and grabbed him in the fourth round. Jordyn Tyson and Khalil Shakir arrived with similar quiet efficiency, both falling past their ADPs before landing here. Add Drake London at WR7 and Malik Nabers at WR12, and this is a starting group that competes on projection, not just roster depth. After a 33rd-percentile finish in 2025, DoctorSquatch came back with something closer to a plan, building a team that currently projects at the 84th percentile of the field. Second in the Among Us division is the floor, and there is a credible case for more.

TE University sits at the top of the Among Us division and in the 100th percentile of the entire field, and the draft tells you exactly why. Not a single reach on the board, eight players acquired at or better than expected value, and two outright steals headlining the haul. Trey McBride, a TE2 projection, slid a full round past his ADP and landed at 2.08. Dallas Goedert, projected TE15, fell more than two rounds before this team scooped him at 11.05. That kind of discipline compounds: when you are not overpaying for talent, you accumulate it, and TE University accumulated plenty. Brock Bowers at TE1, Harold Fannin at TE6, and Kyle Pitts at TE7 round out a starting group that would make most managers envious. Caleb Williams projects as a QB6 and anchors the position. The 2025 season, a 75 percent win rate and 94th-percentile scoring, suggests this is not luck or projection optimism. This team is built correctly, run correctly, and right now there is very little reason to bet against it.
