GraytonPoppy sits 12th in the Angry Birds division and in just the 4th percentile of the tournament field, and the draft record offers little reason for optimism. The roster produced zero steals and three major reaches, including Jake Tonges at TE34 taken more than three rounds ahead of his ADP, and Josh Jacobs at RB16 pulled nearly two rounds early. Those are the kinds of draft-day decisions that haunt a manager all season, not because the players are worthless, but because the price paid leaves no margin for error when things go sideways. And things are already going sideways at the margins. C.J. Stroud, projected at QB22, is among the projected starters here, and the scouting on him is grim: backsliding since a promising start, a concussion that cost him games in 2025, and still searching for the form that made him special. Jonathan Taylor at RB4 and Lamar Jackson at QB3 give GraytonPoppy a real foundation, but this roster grades like a house built on sand after the first two rooms, and there are no obvious fixes left in the blueprint.

Blackbelt7 enters 2026 sitting at the 6th percentile of the field, and the draft record explains everything: five major reaches, four minor reaches, zero steals. The clearest symptom is the receiver situation, where Justin Jefferson at WR6 stands alone among the starters, backed by Elic Ayomanor at WR95 and Christian Kirk at WR100, the latter two taken a combined 5.8 rounds ahead of their respective ADPs as if Blackbelt7 was in a private war with consensus. Jefferson himself was the one moment the board cooperated, sliding nearly half a round past his ADP to land at WR6, but one gift does not redeem a draft that otherwise reads like a case study in manufactured urgency. Ashton Jeanty, reached 1.2 rounds early at RB7, is a legitimate asset, but he was drafted as though scarcity was closing in fast when it wasn't. Last season's 67 percent win rate earned this manager some goodwill. This roster asks for a lot of it back before Week 1 even arrives.

There is a version of this roster that looks almost functional on paper, and then you stare at it long enough and the cracks start to show. roricmaday lands at 10th in the Angry Birds division and the 17th percentile of the field, and the draft did not do much to change the underlying math. The headlining move was taking Drake Maye first overall at pick 1.06, a full seven-tenths of a round ahead of his ADP, which is the kind of aggressive bet that needs to pay off big to justify the cost. Then came RJ Harvey, reached nearly three full rounds early to land a RB28, making him the weakest projected starter on the roster by a meaningful margin. Against those gambles, the values were modest: Kyle Pitts fell a round to give roricmaday a TE7, and Woody Marks slipped a round and a half to add depth. That is not enough reclamation to offset a roster that graded out weak at receiver and came in at the 37th percentile in scoring last season. The levers have been pulled. This is close to the ceiling.

FredSDTW finished in the 82nd percentile last year and is now projected in the 35th, which is the kind of drop that demands an explanation. The explanation is mostly sitting in the receiver rankings. Brock Bowers at TE1 and a backfield that includes De'Von Achane (RB6), Chase Brown (RB11), and Breece Hall (RB14) give this roster genuine upside, but the projected starters at receiver top out at Matthew Golden (WR52), and the rest of that group only gets worse from there. In a positionless format that rewards top-end talent across the board, that receiver ceiling is quietly doing damage. The draft didn't help matters either, with Quinshon Judkins taken 2.1 rounds ahead of his ADP and Brandon Aiyuk reached 3.2 rounds early, two picks that cost real draft capital without moving the needle on the team's biggest weakness. Jared Goff is a reasonable quarterback who has quietly finished top ten four straight years, but he is not the kind of player who papers over structural problems. This roster looks less like a regression and more like a different team wearing last year's trophy.

The islandninjaz enter 2026 sitting eighth in the Angry Birds division and at just the 36th percentile of the field, and it is hard to find the argument that changes either of those numbers by much. The top of the roster has genuine appeal: Joe Burrow at QB4 paired with Tee Higgins at WR19 is a real stack, and Christian McCaffrey at RB3 gives the team a true anchor. The problem is that Burrow is the kind of asset you build around while crossing every finger you own. He missed most of last season after a Week 2 turf toe injury and did not return until Week 13, and his injury history before that was similarly brutal. When he plays, he is elite, but "when he plays" is doing an enormous amount of work in that sentence. Below that top tier, the roster thins quickly, with Blake Corum projected at RB35 as the weakest projected starter and a draft that produced zero steals or values against 15 chalk picks and two major reaches. There is no obvious reinforcement coming and nowhere left to squeeze production out of this thing.

The Angry Birds division is a rough neighborhood, and monaxjose showed up with a butter knife. The receiver corps is genuinely impressive, with Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4), Malik Nabers (WR12), Garrett Wilson (WR17), and Davante Adams (WR25) all projecting as starters, and Trey McBride (TE2) anchoring the tight end spot after sliding past his ADP. But those bright spots only make the quarterback situation more painful to look at. Daniel Jones (QB25), Jacoby Brissett (QB28), and Shedeur Sanders (QB32) represent a ceiling so low you'd need to crouch to walk under it, and the draft didn't offer any salvation, with Jones taken more than a round earlier than his ADP suggested he was worth. The running back group projects as middling at best, with Tony Pollard (RB30) slotted as the weakest projected starter on a roster that already has nowhere to hide. Sitting seventh in the division and in just the 40th percentile of the field, monaxjose has premium weapons and no one to throw them the ball.

know13dge1 is a team that exists in the uncomfortable geometry of almost, a roster that finishes most weeks having done nothing particularly wrong and nothing particularly memorable. Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 is the genuine anchor here, the kind of projection that wins weeks outright, and Colston Loveland at TE3 gives the lineup a second player capable of tilting a matchup. Those two are the margin. Everything else around them is fine in the way that beige is fine: Derrick Henry at RB12, Kyren Williams at RB15, Justin Herbert at QB8, a supporting cast that collectively projects as competent and collectively projects as uninspiring. Mike Evans complicates the middle of the roster further, a player who shredded through injuries last season, lost his eleven-year thousand-yard streak, and now restarts in San Francisco with something to prove and a durability question mark trailing him. The draft was almost entirely chalk, with one reach on Michael Mayer that cost real capital. Forty-seventh percentile is the forecast, and in this field, that is exactly how close the margins have to go right.

Red did not win the Scott Fish Bowl draft in one thunderclap moment, and that is precisely the point. Pick by pick, this roster accumulated an edge so quietly that you almost miss how good it is until you look at where it lands: 81st percentile in the field. The foundation is a receiving corps anchored by Ja'Marr Chase (WR2) and Nico Collins (WR9), with George Pickens (WR10) and Emeka Egbuka (WR18) extending that group into territory most managers would envy at the top alone. Patrick Mahomes (QB12) adds another layer. The ACL and LCL recovery from late in the 2025 season still carries some Week 1 uncertainty, but every update out of his camp has been encouraging, and a healthy Mahomes is a QB12 floor with a significantly higher ceiling. Four players landed past their ADP, none of them sensation, all of them substance. There is no single flashy trophy pick to point at here, which is also why this team is quietly dangerous.

GameofJones sits at 81st percentile in this field and fourth in the Angry Birds division, and the interesting part is how they got there. The board does not flatter them. Two major reaches, two minor reaches, zero steals. On paper, this manager spent the draft paying premiums for players they wanted instead of waiting for the market to come to them. But look at what those convictions built: Puka Nacua at WR1, A.J. Brown at WR8, and Zay Flowers at WR16 form a starting core that most managers would construct around in a heartbeat, and Tyler Warren at TE4 and Tucker Kraft at TE5 give the team elite production at the position regardless of who the opponent game-plans against. The one genuine cloud is George Kittle, taken as a projected TE9 but coming off an Achilles' tear that makes Week 1 availability genuinely uncertain, and Kittle is exactly the kind of player you reach for and then hold your breath on. Whether this roster rewards conviction or survives it may be the most interesting question in the division.

ThereTheyGoAgain lands at 86th percentile in the field and third in the Angry Birds division, and the draft record explains why: six values, twelve chalk, and zero major reaches across the entire board. That is not a flashy portfolio, it is a disciplined one. The foundation is legitimate, with Jahmyr Gibbs projected at RB1 and Saquon Barkley at RB8 forming a backfield core that most managers would trade a first-round pick to own outright. From there, the value picks quietly do the work. Sam LaPorta fell 1.2 rounds past his ADP and lands as a projected TE8 starter. Brian Thomas Jr. slipped more than a round and projects at WR31. Jordan Love dropped nearly two rounds and slots in as a projected starter at QB17. None of those are lottery tickets, they are players taken at a discount who are expected to contribute. The 2025 campaign finished below the median in scoring, so the résumé needs updating, but the draft suggests the infrastructure is finally in place to do it.

HarryLaFey didn't win the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl draft in one flashy moment, they won it in the margins, round after round, quietly coming out ahead. Drake London, a projected WR7, was still sitting at pick 2.10 when ADP had him gone by 2.06, a small gap that adds up when it happens repeatedly. Jaxson Dart fell nearly two full rounds past his ADP to 7.03, and HarryLaFey was there to collect a QB11 projection at a discount, then doubled down in round ten with Sam Darnold at a price that undercut his market by nearly two rounds as well. Anchor those values around Bijan Robinson at RB2 and DeVonta Smith at WR14, layer in Kenneth Walker III at RB10 and a Dart-Isaiah Likely stack that gives the roster a bonus scoring connection, and you have a team sitting second in the Angry Birds division and in the top 10 percent of the field. The reach on Jaylen Wright is the one moment the process slipped, but one miscue buried in round 18 is a footnote, not a flaw.

matthbrandon sits atop the Angry Birds division and in the 96th percentile of the field, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. The headliner is CeeDee Lamb, a WR5 projection who slipped to pick 2.08 despite an ADP of 1.11, the kind of gift that tends to define championship rosters before the season even starts. Pair Lamb with Dak Prescott, a QB7 who also fell past his ADP, and you have a live stack anchoring the lineup. Josh Allen at QB1 gives matthbrandon a second quarterback most managers would start without hesitation, and Harold Fannin projects as a TE6 with Dalton Kincaid and Mark Andrews behind him as genuine contributors. Meanwhile, Carnell Tate steps into Tennessee as the first receiver off the board in the NFL draft, linking up with Cam Ward in a pairing the Titans need to deliver. Sixteen chalk picks and zero reaches tells you something important about the process here: matthbrandon did not force anything. The talent was already there.
