skschmitz enters 2026 sitting 12th in the Animal Crossing division and in just the 4th percentile of the field, and the roster does not make a convincing case for a turnaround. The draft leaned heavily on early emotion rather than late-round discipline, producing three major reaches and three minor ones against just a single genuine steal. The most damaging call came at pick 1.04, where skschmitz grabbed Jayden Daniels a full 1.7 rounds before consensus, surrendering the value that typically funds a viable back end. That back end now bottoms out with Rico Dowdle as the weakest projected starter, a RB32 taken 2.2 rounds early in round nine who was already a reach before anyone expected him to anchor anything important. Dallas Goedert, the one player who actually fell to skschmitz, grades out at TE15, a fine asset but not the kind of difference-maker that repairs a roster projecting this far below the field. When your best draft story is a tight end sliding two rounds, and last season's record was 11-25, the math is not pointing anywhere encouraging.

Last year, Clever Christie went 29-7 and scored in the 92nd percentile, the kind of season that earns a manager a reputation they may not deserve heading into 2026. This year's roster projects 11th in the division and in the 11th percentile of the field, and the gap between that legacy and this reality is genuinely uncomfortable to look at. Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and James Cook at RB5 give the team a legitimate top-end foundation, and that much is real. But the draft did nothing to build around it, producing zero steals and zero values across 20 picks while managing two major reaches, including Jaxson Dart taken nearly two rounds before his ADP and Josh Jacobs grabbed almost two rounds early. Dart projects as QB11, which is fine, but paying a premium for fine is not how championship rosters are built. Christie is sitting on last year's trophy like it means something about this year's team, and the projections are not being kind about the difference.

J Love Squared sits 10th in the Animal Crossing division and in the 15th percentile of the field, and the roster makes it easy to understand why. The wide receiver group is genuinely elite, with CeeDee Lamb (WR5) and Justin Jefferson (WR6) anchoring a corps that also includes Chris Olave (WR11) and Mike Evans (WR27), and on paper that looks like a foundation worth building around. The problem is that everything above that foundation is load-bearing and cracking. Jordan Love (QB17) was a reach at QB17, and the fallback options are C.J. Stroud at QB22 and Cam Ward at QB23, meaning the quarterback situation grades weak no matter which way you turn. The draft did not help matters, producing two major reaches in Braelon Allen (RB58) and Demond Claiborne (RB63), both taken nearly three rounds ahead of their ADPs, with little upside to justify the aggression. When your most conspicuous draft-day swings land on RB58 and RB63, you have spent premium picks papering over a ceiling problem rather than raising it. This team needed a lever to pull. There does not appear to be one.

SheTalksFootbal finished 10-26 last season and landed in the 23rd scoring percentile, and the 2026 outlook offers little reason to rethink the pessimism. The roster sits at the 21st percentile in the field and eighth in the Animal Crossing division, which means this is not a team that merely needs one break to go its way. The real problem is the draft did not create much runway either, producing just one steal against six reaches, including two major ones. David Njoku, taken nearly five rounds ahead of his ADP, projects as TE29, which is a steep price for a player who grades out that deep. Ja'Kobi Lane, reached on by 3.6 rounds, projects as WR89. Those are not the kinds of gambles that flip a roster's trajectory. Jonathan Taylor at RB4 and Drake Maye at QB2 are legitimate pillars, but in a positionless format where the whole roster competes for spots, the back end of this lineup is thin enough that Taylor and Maye can only carry so much weight.

Triforce Tactics finished the 2025 season at 21st percentile and somehow drafted their way into the same neighborhood in 2026, sitting ninth in the Animal Crossing division at the 21st percentile in scoring. The draft chart tells the story: zero steals, zero values worth celebrating, and three major reaches that will haunt this manager for months. Burning the 1.03 on Lamar Jackson when his ADP sat a full round later is the kind of move that cascades, and cascade it did, with Jaylen Warren getting taken 3.3 rounds before his ADP and Dontayvion Wicks somehow getting reached on in round 16. Meanwhile, the one legitimate asset with real upside, Luther Burden, is a hype train that has not left the station yet. Ben Johnson's Amon-Ra St. Brown comparisons are encouraging, but Burden enters 2026 still needing to prove it, which is cold comfort when he sits behind a draft board that confirms this roster was assembled by someone reaching left and right and connecting on neither. There is no charitable read here, and none is available.

The Animal Crossing division is not going to be kind to 410Beckett in 2026. Sitting seventh in the division and at just the 23rd percentile tournament-wide, this roster is projecting as a bottom-tier outfit, and the draft did not generate the kind of surplus value needed to escape that gravity. Sixteen chalk picks and zero steals is a draft profile that says a manager got more or less what they paid for, which is fine if what you paid for was good, and less fine when your projected starter list bottoms out at Tony Pollard. There is genuine talent at the top, Jahmyr Gibbs projects as RB1 and the quarterback room is legitimately interesting, but Justin Herbert's path to relevance now runs through Mike McDaniel's offense on a team that has prioritized winning games over padding passing stats, which is a narrower lane than it sounds. Last year's 52nd-percentile scoring finish at least proved the roster

can perform, but with no obvious lever to pull and no draft-day windfalls to cash in, 410Beckett looks like a team hoping circumstance bails them out.

AlexLFO didn't win the draft with one flashy move, they won it by consistently coming out on the right side of the ledger. The clearest example is Ja'Marr Chase, projected WR2, landing at pick 1.07 when his ADP sat at 1.02, a small slip that handed AlexLFO one of the best players in the tournament without paying full price. Pair that with De'Von Achane at RB6 and Tyler Warren at TE4 among the projected starters, and the foundation is genuinely difficult to argue with. Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 and Marvin Harrison Jr. at WR33 add real depth to the top of the lineup. The one area where AlexLFO paid forward rather than waited is Elijah Arroyo, reached for 4.2 rounds ahead of his ADP at TE40, a gamble that has not paid off on paper yet. Still, one speculative late-round swing does not unravel a draft that was otherwise disciplined, patient, and sharp where it mattered most. Sitting 63rd percentile in the field with a ceiling that feels higher, this roster belongs in the conversation.

postman218 drafted like someone who did their homework and actually read it. The headliner is Trey McBride, a TE2 snagged at pick 2.04 when the field had him priced closer to the first round, a full 0.7 rounds of free equity that most managers left sitting on the board. Pair that with Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Nico Collins at WR9, both projected starters, and the top of this roster has genuine tournament-winning upside. Collins alone came at a discount, falling nearly a round past his ADP. The draft profile tells the same story the names do: one steal, three values, and a single minor reach across the entire board. That kind of discipline does not happen by accident. postman218 finished in the 53rd percentile in scoring last season, which means this is not a team that got lucky chasing a ceiling and stumbled into the 78th percentile of the field. The foundation was built right, and the talent is there to back it up.

The average Simon lands at 82nd percentile in the field and fourth in the Animal Crossing division, and the draft tells you exactly how they got there: not through lottery tickets, but through consistent, disciplined execution. Josh Allen at QB1 was taken first overall, a minor reach in pick number but hardly a controversial one. The real craftsmanship shows in the values. Travis Kelce, projected TE10, slid nearly two rounds past his ADP and landed right in this roster. DeVonta Smith, projected WR14, fell almost a full round. Colston Loveland at TE3 and Sam LaPorta at TE8 round out a position group that gives this team a genuine structural advantage at the top of the lineup. The major blemish is Jaydon Blue, taken nearly six rounds ahead of consensus, a swing that raises an eyebrow. But one aggressive late-round flier does not undo a draft that otherwise stayed patient, took what the board gave, and walked away with top-end talent that most managers in this field would envy.

Last year Macapplechic finished in the 2nd percentile in scoring, a 5-31 wreck that was painful to watch. The 2026 roster reads like a formal apology for all of it. The receiving corps alone is enough to make other managers nervous: Puka Nacua projects as WR1, George Pickens as WR10, and Malik Nabers as WR12, all projected starters, and Nacua and Nabers both slid past their ADPs, meaning Macapplechic got top-shelf production at a modest discount. Ashton Jeanty, Travis Etienne, and Javonte Williams round out a strong backfield presence, giving this lineup real punch from multiple angles. The draft was mostly chalk, which is fine when the chalk is this good, and the two major reaches in the late rounds on Chimere Dike and Skyler Bell are the kind of low-cost swings that look smart if even one connects. Sitting third in the division and at the 85th percentile overall, Macapplechic has quietly built the roster that last season's scoring total suggested was nowhere in sight.

IngleMartinIV sits second in the Animal Crossing division and in the 90th percentile of the field, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. This team didn't chase anyone. Six values scattered across the board, zero reaches, and a clean top of the roster headlined by Bijan Robinson at RB2, Drake London at WR7, and A.J. Brown at WR8, the latter sliding nearly a full round past his ADP and landing right in IngleMartinIV's lap. That kind of patient discipline tends to compound: Greg Dulcich fell 2.2 rounds, Pat Freiermuth fell 1.6, Stefon Diggs fell 1.7, and the manager collected every one of them without overpaying. Jared Goff at QB16 also slipped past his number and brings a live stack with Jameson Williams at WR21 baked into the build. The weakest projected starter is Quentin Johnston at WR41, which tells you something about the ceiling here. When the floor of your lineup is a WR41, you drafted well.

gerv86 sat at the 99th percentile in the Animal Crossing division and earned every bit of it. The blueprint is right there in the numbers: eight values and one outright steal across the draft board, zero reaches of any kind. Brock Purdy, a projected QB13, fell more than two full rounds past his ADP before gerv86 quietly scooped him up at the back of the seventh. Brock Bowers came off the board as the TE1, and Harold Fannin and Kyle Pitts followed as projected TE6 and TE7, giving gerv86 a ceiling at that position that most managers would trade their entire draft for. Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and Rashee Rice at WR13 round out a starting group that would make anyone nervous. Even the projected weakest starter, Courtland Sutton, arrived as a value pick, taken more than a round after his ADP. After a 29th-percentile finish in 2025, gerv86 came back with a sharper pencil and built the kind of roster that makes draft grades look easy.
