There is no charitable read on DaBadGuys, and the draft log does not leave much room for spin. The most damning evidence sits at the top: Caleb Williams burned the first overall pick at 1.12, a full round and a half before his QB6 projection demanded it, and then the manager turned around and did it twice more with Daniel Jones and Aaron Rodgers, reaching 3.3 and 3.9 rounds early respectively on quarterbacks ranked QB25 and QB29. That is not a plan, that is a panic. The receiver group papers over some of the damage, with Zay Flowers, Jameson Williams, Rome Odunze, and Brian Thomas Jr. all projected as starters, though Thomas carries his own baggage after a 2025 that raised real questions about his connection with Trevor Lawrence. Colston Loveland at TE3 is the one bright spot the roster can genuinely point to. But when three of your four major reaches are quarterbacks and you still land a QB22 and a QB29 among your starters, the draft has not gone sideways. It has fallen off a cliff.

DaBadGuys sits last in the Animal Crossing: New Horizons division, and nothing in this draft log argues with that verdict.

There is no charitable read available for astrosloth57, and the draft sheet makes no attempt to offer one. The most damning exhibit is the quarterback situation, where the manager reached for Tyler Shough at 6.02 when his ADP sat at 8.09, then turned around and did it again with Cam Ward at 7.11 against a 10.06 ADP, burning two premium picks on a pair of QBs projected QB20 and QB23 respectively. That is not a strategy, that is a panic attack with a clock on it. The receivers are genuinely excellent, CeeDee Lamb at WR5, Justin Jefferson at WR6, and Malik Nabers at WR12 give this team a legitimate top of the board, and Kyle Pitts quietly carries real upside after his standout 2025 campaign, regardless of which quarterback Atlanta trots out. But the sum of zero steals, zero values, and six total reaches across the draft is not a foundation, it is a confession. Animal Crossing: New Horizons has seen worse, probably. This is not that.

Bankster17 enters 2026 sitting 10th in the Animal Crossing: New Horizons division and in just the 34th percentile of the field, and the roster doesn't offer much reason for optimism. The headline names are real: Lamar Jackson at QB3 and Brock Bowers at TE1 give this team a genuine ceiling, and in a positionless format those two alone can carry weeks. The problem is what surrounds them. After Jackson and Bowers, the projected starters grade out as thoroughly middling, and the draft didn't uncover the kind of surplus value that might offset that. Bankster17 recorded zero steals and just two values on a 19-round board, while racking up six minor reaches and a major reach on Malik Willis at QB24, taken more than two full rounds before his ADP. Kenneth Gainwell projects as the weakest starter on the roster at RB34. A 13-23 finish last season already suggested this build was leaking, and the 2026 projection offers no obvious patch. Jackson and Bowers can paper over a lot, but not everything.

stefanovaccarino sits ninth in the Animal Crossing: New Horizons division and checks in at just the 46th percentile of the field, and the roster explains both numbers without much mystery. The receiver group is genuinely strong, with Amon-Ra St. Brown projecting as WR4 and Chris Olave, Luther Burden, and Jaylen Waddle all grading out as viable starters, and Waddle's move from Miami's dysfunction to a Denver offense where Bo Nix led the league in pass attempts last year gives him real upside. But the rest of the roster is quietly dragging the whole operation down. Christian McCaffrey at RB3 is elite, yet the drop-off beyond him is steep, and the quarterback situation is a slow leak the team never properly addressed. Jordan Love and Sam Darnold were both taken before their ADPs, and Deshaun Watson was pulled a full four rounds early at QB34. You can build around St. Brown and Waddle, but not when the quarterback room is this shaky. There is no obvious correction available. This one grades out as a grind.

TheOnlyJenSmith drafted like a patient, disciplined operator: fourteen of nineteen picks landed at or after ADP, Joe Burrow fell nearly a full round past his number, and Woody Marks slid more than three and a half rounds before Jen scooped him up at 18.11. The process was sound. The result is an 8th-place division projection and a 51st-percentile finish, which is the draft equivalent of doing everything right on a job application and still getting a form rejection. The problem is not process, it is profile. Burrow is a QB4 talent, but his recent history reads less like a quarterback's and more like a medical chart, and a repeat of last year's turf toe nightmare leaves this roster leaning on Jared Goff as a starter. Beyond that, the projected starters thin out quickly, with Wan'Dale Robinson, a WR47, anchoring the back end of the lineup. Jen found the value. The value just did not find its way into a top-half roster.

Bufallogan sits at the 53rd percentile, which is exactly as nerve-wracking as it sounds: good enough to believe, not good enough to relax. The margins here are thin, and the draft reflects that duality. Manager Bufallogan found real late-round value, landing Cam Skattebo (RB20), Chuba Hubbard (RB29), and Jordan Mason (RB41) all well past their ADPs, which means the depth behind the starters costs almost nothing. But a 4.5-round reach on Fernando Mendoza (QB27) is the kind of move that quietly haunts a roster, especially when Drake Maye (QB2) is already locked in and the Maye / A.J. Brown (WR8) stack gives the lineup a genuine high-end ceiling. The week Maye and Brown both go off, Bufallogan looks like a contender. The week they go quiet, Hubbard as the projected weakest starter is a thin safety net. This team does not lose the division from the top of the roster, it loses or wins it from the bottom, and that is a very uncomfortable place to spend a season.

PhillyD1979 walked out of this draft looking like someone who bets on themselves and then has the audacity to be right. The board shows four reaches, two of them major, and yet the roster they built sits at the 57th percentile with a starting lineup that is genuinely difficult to attack. The foundation is real: Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 give this team two of the most reliable projected scorers in the field, and Kyren Williams at RB15 arrived as a value, sliding past his ADP by more than a round. George Pickens at WR10 anchors the receiving corps and Patrick Mahomes at QB12 does what Mahomes does. The reaches are where the story gets interesting. Justin Fields at QB38, taken nearly eight rounds early, is either a visionary call on a breakout or the kind of conviction that looks great on a podcast and rough on a scoresheet. J.K. Dobbins falling to the 15th round as a legitimate value partially cushions the gambles. This roster earned its ranking, even if the path there required some creative accounting.

garyjackson1988 didn't build this roster with one flashy swing. The thing was constructed pick by pick, and the cumulative effect is a team sitting at the 59th percentile with a legitimate case to climb. The backfield depth is the clearest expression of that philosophy: Saquon Barkley at RB8, Omarion Hampton at RB9, Josh Jacobs at RB16, and Travis Etienne at RB18 are all projected starters, and that group didn't happen by accident. Three of the draft's clearest values came from letting the board come to them, including Courtland Sutton at WR37, taken nearly two full rounds after his ADP suggested he'd be gone. The one moment where patience broke down was Bryce Young, a reach of more than three rounds at QB26 when Josh Allen and Brock Purdy were already locked in. That pick didn't cost the roster its identity, but it's the kind of detour a contender can't afford to repeat. The foundation here is sound, and if Barkley and Hampton perform anywhere near projection, garyjackson1988 is going to be a problem in the Animal Crossing: New Horizons division.

leashleo did not build this roster with one flashy move. They built it pick by pick, and the cumulative effect is a team that sits at 62nd percentile with a credible path to climbing. The tight end group alone would make most managers envious: Trey McBride at TE2, Tyler Warren at TE4, and Travis Kelce at TE10 are all projected starters, and Kelce came at a discount, sliding a full round past his ADP. At receiver, Drake London at WR7 anchors a group that also features Ladd McConkey at WR20 and Christian Watson at WR28, giving leashleo genuine depth where it counts. The one area worth watching is the quarterback situation, where Geno Smith at QB30 and Carson Beck at QB40 were both taken significantly ahead of their ADPs, which is the clearest sign that leashleo pressed a little harder than the market warranted. But last season's 64 percent win rate and 77th-percentile scoring suggest this manager knows how to turn a reasonable roster into results, and the foundation here is more than reasonable.

GurmeetSahni sits third in the Animal Crossing: New Horizons division and in the 80th percentile of the field, and the draft record explains exactly how: not flashy, just consistently right. Five values against two minor reaches and one major reach is a ledger that reflects a manager who let the board work for them rather than forcing moves. The two standout examples are Puka Nacua, projected WR1 and taken fifth overall when his ADP sat first, and James Cook, projected RB5 and grabbed just four picks past where the field had him, both quietly slipping into range. Justin Herbert at QB8 fell nearly a full round past his ADP and landed in the mix as a legitimate starter. The one blemish worth noting is Tua Tagovailoa, taken more than two rounds ahead of schedule at QB31, which is the kind of price that can sting in a draft where every pick matters. But one costly departure from value did not define this roster. GurmeetSahni built something steady, and steady tends to last.

Pookieee98 didn't need a lottery ticket to build this roster, just consistent, patient drafting that left the field behind pick after pick. The centerpiece is Ja'Marr Chase at WR2, a genuinely elite anchor, and Jayden Daniels at QB5 pairs with Terry McLaurin in a stack that gives this team a built-in multiplier on big Daniels days. Then there's Jalen Hurts, projected QB9, who fell more than a round past his ADP and landed at 5.03, a quiet windfall that gives Pookieee98 one of the stronger quarterback rooms in the tournament. The draft as a whole produced three values and zero major reaches across the board, which is less a highlight reel than a body of work, and that body of work lands this team at 93rd percentile in the field and second in the Animal Crossing: New Horizons division. After a 51st-percentile finish in 2025, the upgrade in projected talent is real. This is a team that didn't beat the room on one flashy pick. It beat the room everywhere.

Deep Thoughts w Pascal sits first in the Animal Crossing: New Horizons division and in the 96th percentile of the entire field, and the draft record tells you exactly why: zero reaches, five values, fifteen chalk picks. That is not luck, that is discipline. The foundation is Jonathan Taylor at RB4 and Breece Hall at RB14, both projected starters secured at or near their price, and Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 gives the team a genuine top-shelf receiver to build around. Where the manager really separated themselves was in the middle and late rounds, picking up Javonte Williams nearly two full rounds after his ADP suggested he would go, then doing the same with Quinshon Judkins and Deebo Samuel. The projected weak link is Oronde Gadsden at TE16, and even that is a mild concern at worst given the overall construction. When the floor of your worries is a TE16 projected starter, you drafted a clean sheet. Pascal would approve.
