Meanwhile, the choice of Hunter Henry as a starting tight end should serve as a cautionary tale for

those who dare dream big with little evidence. It's clear that this fantasy season with Off the Achane will be anything but conventional, making them a surefire pick for the connoisseur of chaos.

As TwoSeven enters the 2025 fantasy football season, optimism is hard to come by. Despite last year's unexpected success, finishing in the 72nd percentile, they're now languishing in the 8th percentile—almost rock-bottom—and struggling with an alarming set of weaknesses. Their wide receiver corps, led by Courtland Sutton (WR26) and Jerry Jeudy (WR32), lacks the punch needed to compete at a high level, while Emeka Egbuka (WR49) and Tre Harris (WR55) offer little hope of improvement. In a TE Premium setup, their tight ends are strong, especially Brock Bowers (TE1), who stands out as a lone bright spot. However, even this advantage seems insufficient to save them from the inevitable, as J.K. Dobbins (RB39) leads a questionable running back lineup. The team's

running game might be anchored by Josh Jacobs (RB10), but his early selection—a reach compared to his ADP—casts doubt on the value he brings. Despite finding some bargains like Jonnu Smith, whose ADP far exceeded expectations, and Brock Bowers, selected slightly later than projected, these few wins are overshadowed by questionable draft picks, including Omarion Hampton, taken earlier than necessary. With their divisional rank at a dismal 11th, TwoSeven faces an uphill battle in an increasingly competitive environment. As the season looms, the weight of last year's achievements seems more burden than blessing, with little sign of the strategic depth needed to turn things around.

Austin Ekeler, despite being a projected starter, stands as a glaring weakness at running back. However, the team boasts a formidable lineup of wide receivers, with Ja'Marr Chase leading the charge alongside Brian Thomas Jr., Ladd McConkey, Garrett Wilson, and Stefon Diggs. The tight end

position is a beacon of hope in this TE Premium setup, featuring Tyler Warren, Evan Engram, and Travis Kelce. Yet, reaching for several players ahead of their average draft position has raised eyebrows and may haunt their season-long aspirations. As they step into a new season, FF Shep (Gavin) is hopeful that their strengths will outweigh their vulnerabilities, but it's clear there are many hurdles to overcome if they are to climb the ranks and make a significant impact.


