JSFootball enters 2026 sitting 12th in the Apex Legends division, and the roster grades tell you most of what you need to know before you even look at the schedule. The backfield is genuinely elite, anchored by Christian McCaffrey (RB3), Kenneth Walker III (RB10), and Jeremiyah Love (RB13), and that depth is real. The problem is everything else. The receiver group is a collection of WR45-and-worse projections, with Jakobi Meyers (WR45) as the headliner, and Patrick Mahomes checking in at QB12 after being taken a round early suggests the manager saw this coming and tried to compensate at quarterback, only to burn a sixth-round pick on Fernando Mendoza (QB27), a reach of more than six rounds. That pick, more than any single roster decision, captures the bind JSFootball is in: the assets to fix the weaknesses simply were not there, and the draft capital used chasing solutions compounded the problem. The running game can carry a team only so far when the surrounding cast grades this thin.

There is no spin available for stanj21, no angle that makes this look like a misunderstood gem. The draft tells the story plainly: five major reaches against zero steals, a combination that reads less like a strategy and more like a series of panicked decisions made under pressure. The most damning single pick is Christian Kirk at WR100, hauled off the board 7.3 rounds before his ADP, which is not aggressive drafting so much as it is paying a first-class fare for a middle seat. Malik Willis, a QB24, cost a third-round premium at pick 8.03, burning capital that could have shored up real contributors. Lamar Jackson anchors the roster at QB3, and Kyle Pitts projects as a TE7, so there is genuine talent here, but the draft capital required to accumulate the rest of this group left stanj21 with a starting lineup that bottoms out at Jonathon Brooks as a projected RB37. The team currently ranks eleventh in the Apex Legends division and sits in just the 4th percentile of the field. The math is not encouraging.

HOLDmyBEER77 enters 2026 sitting 10th in the Apex Legends division and in just the 24th percentile of the field, and the roster construction does not offer much reason for optimism. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 is genuinely elite, and James Cook at RB5 gives the team two anchors worth building around, but the draft that was supposed to fill in around them was riddled with expensive mistakes. Matthew Stafford, taken three full rounds ahead of his ADP and projecting as a QB14, is the kind of reach that echoes through a roster, and J.J. McCarthy, grabbed 4.2 rounds early, grades out at QB37, which is the sort of return that turns a reach into a verdict. The team's floor depends almost entirely on Chase and Cook carrying a lineup that projects Khalil Shakir, a WR51, as its weakest starter. Coming off a 39 percent win rate in 2025, HOLDmyBEER77 needed a draft that bought it some margin. This one did not.

Kingcole93 sits ninth in the Apex Legends division and down in the 25th percentile of the field, and the draft record offers little reason for optimism about how they got here. Three major reaches define the board, and two of them are quarterbacks: C.J. Stroud taken 2.6 rounds ahead of his ADP, Daniel Jones pulled another 2.4 rounds early. Those are significant investments in players ranked QB22 and QB25, and in a positionless format where every roster slot is a zero-sum decision, burning that kind of capital on the QB position without landing a QB1 is the kind of math that haunts a season. Brock Bowers at TE1 and Tyler Warren at TE4 are genuinely elite, and Rashee Rice and Ladd McConkey give the lineup a respectable top end, but the tier drops fast after that, with Jayden Higgins projecting as the weakest projected starter at WR54. There is no obvious lever left to pull, no underpriced asset quietly waiting to carry the load. This roster is built, and built near the bottom.

JBair2004 posted a 95th-percentile scoring season in 2025, and that reputation is now doing a lot of heavy lifting, because the 2026 projection tells a quieter story. The tournament percentile sits at 25th and the division rank lands at eighth, a gap so wide it practically has its own zip code. The roster is not without talent: CeeDee Lamb at WR5 and Justin Jefferson at WR6 are legitimate cornerstones, and Justin Herbert and Jalen Hurts give the manager real flexibility at the top of the lineup. But beyond those names, the drop-off is steep. Kenneth Gainwell checks in at RB34, Hunter Henry projects as the weakest expected starter at TE18, and the supporting cast at receiver, while long, thins out fast once you get past the top two. The draft itself offered little separation from consensus, logging 15 chalk picks and zero steals, which means JBair2004 mostly paid market price for a roster that the field currently values in the bottom quarter. Last year's performance was real. Whether it repeats is the only question worth tracking.

Mike Barner's 2026 roster sits precisely at the tournament's midpoint, and the margin between a playoff push and an early exit lives in a handful of swing decisions. The headliner is Josh Allen, a QB1 who slid past his ADP to land at 1.09, and pairing him with Nico Collins at WR9 and Garrett Wilson at WR17 gives Barner a legitimate top-end core. The trouble is in how he got there. Breece Hall, a projected RB14, cost 1.4 rounds more than his draft price warranted, and that overpayment compressed the middle of the roster in ways that show up as players like J.K. Dobbins anchoring the projected starting lineup at RB36. Travis Kelce is officially back for 2026 and carrying real upside if he recaptures top-12 TE form, but he projects as TE10 right now, not a sure thing. There are no disasters here, no transformative pieces either. Barner wins if the values hit and the reaches hold, and loses if the math runs the other direction.

dfisher24 didn't need a blockbuster swing to build something worth watching in the Apex Legends division. The foundation starts at the top, where Jaxon Smith-Njigba projects as WR3 and Drake London comes in at WR7, giving this roster a ceiling that most managers would trade their best pick for. Caleb Williams lands at QB6 and runs a stack with Luther Burden, which means the two are working in concert on scoring plays, compounding upside rather than just adding to it. The draft wasn't flashy, leaning heavily on chalk, but the value plays that did land were meaningful: RJ Harvey fell more than three rounds past his ADP and projects at RB28, Rhamondre Stevenson slid more than a round to land at RB31, and both figure into the weekly lineup math. The three major reaches are worth noting, particularly Bo Nix going four rounds early to sit at QB15, but in a positionless format the damage from any one reach is contained. At 64th percentile and sixth in the division, dfisher24 has the talent to climb both.

RooneyTunes412 didn't need a signature moment to build something worth watching in the Apex Legends division. The foundation starts with Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and Saquon Barkley at RB8, two projected starters who give this roster a ceiling most managers would envy. Layer in A.J. Brown at WR8 and Tucker Kraft at TE5, and you have a core that wins quietly without requiring anything spectacular from the rest of the roster. What separates a good draft from a merely fine one, though, is what happens in the middle and late rounds, and that's where RooneyTunes412 earned something. Kyle Monangai landed at RB33 a full three rounds past his ADP, and Isiah Pacheco came in two rounds late at RB52. Neither is a star, but both represent real surplus value stacked onto an already stable base. Sitting at the 68th percentile with a starting lineup that projects well at nearly every spot, this team looks less like a gamble and more like a quiet contender with a clean bill of health between it and a deep run.

Stoney15 did not build this roster by swinging for the fences and getting lucky. They built it by consistently drafting players after the rest of the field had already passed on them, and that discipline compounds. Christian Watson landed at WR28 a full 1.6 rounds after his ADP. Tetairoa McMillan, a WR15, slid 1.3 rounds past where he should have been taken. Mark Andrews, projected TE14, came at a discount of nearly a round and a half. None of those individual wins is a championship-maker on its own, but five good-value picks and zero steals-level bargains still means this team consistently got more than it paid for. The one blemish, a 1.3-round reach on Brock Purdy, looks easier to forgive when Purdy stacks neatly with George Kittle in the starting lineup. Coming off a 78-percent win rate and a 73rd-percentile scoring season in 2025, Stoney15 sits at 80th percentile entering 2026. The Apex Legends division will need to take this one seriously.

ChivasDK is sitting third in the Apex Legends division and in the 87th percentile of the field, and the draft record explains exactly how they got there: fourteen chalk picks as a foundation, three values, and a steal, with zero major reaches to apologize for. That steal is the headline. Zach Charbonnet fell more than four full rounds past his ADP, and ChivasDK was patient enough to be there when he did. The receiver group is where this roster truly hums, with Puka Nacua, George Pickens, Malik Nabers, and Zay Flowers all projecting as starters, and Nabers himself was a value pick, sliding a round and a half down the board into ChivasDK's lap. The quarterback situation carries the most uncertainty, with Baker Mayfield losing Mike Evans to free agency and facing genuine questions about whether his 2024 form was a peak or a preview, but the depth behind the top of this roster is strong enough to absorb that ambiguity. This is a team built with discipline, and the results are hard to argue with.

Sitting at 94th percentile and second in the Apex Legends division, ajg229 built this roster the right way, finding real value where it mattered most and rarely paying a premium they didn't need to. The backfield is the engine here: Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 are projected starters who give this team a ceiling most managers in this field simply don't have. Add Javonte Williams at RB17 and Bhayshul Tuten, snagged two and a half rounds after his ADP at RB25, and the ground game depth is genuinely elite. Joe Burrow fell a full round past his ADP and lands as a projected QB4 starter, which is the kind of quiet heist that separates disciplined drafters from lucky ones. Harold Fannin rounds out the projected starters at TE6, a spot where most teams are scrambling. Two steals, four values, and zero major reaches on the draft sheet tell the story cleanly: ajg229 didn't force anything and didn't need to.

mmilliard sits first in the Apex Legends division and in the 96th percentile of the entire field, and the draft sheet tells you exactly why. The value column is loaded: five picks that fell past ADP, headlined by Derrick Henry dropping a full two rounds to Round 6 despite projecting as RB12, and Tee Higgins sliding nearly a round and a half to land as a projected starter at WR19. That is not luck, that is a manager who knew what the board owed them and waited. Jayden Daniels at QB5 and Isaiah Likely at TE13 round out a starting group that has almost no dead weight, and Likely's move to New York, where John Harbaugh follows him from Baltimore into a light tight end room, only adds intrigue to an already-sound investment. The one blemish, Malachi Fields reached by less than two rounds in the late teens, barely registers on a sheet this clean. Last season mmilliard finished in the 20th percentile scoring. This roster looks built to erase that memory entirely.
