strategic miscalculation. While the team extracted some value with Kraft, the rest of the squad remains a patchwork of missed opportunities and risky gambles. With past mediocrity and present concerns converging, Darrh faces an uphill battle to climb from the depths of their league standings.

CeeDee Lamb offers a rare spark amid an otherwise middling receiver corps, but even he can't completely compensate for Zach Ertz's faltering presence at tight end. The decision to reach aggressively for Justin Herbert and C.J. Stroud has left their roster hamstrung, overshadowing what little value they scavenged with Austin Ekeler and Pat Freiermuth. It's a cruel reflection of how quickly fortunes can turn, as this once-promising squad finds itself languishing in familiar depths,

looking up longingly at competitors who have left them in the dust. With a tournament standing that confirms their woes, tfisch27 seems destined to fade quietly into obscurity, a shadow of its former self.
