danidlaxref enters 2026 sitting 12th in the Assassin's Creed division and in the 7th percentile of the field, which is roughly the part of the standings where hope goes to retire. The roster does have two genuine anchors: Brock Bowers projects as TE1, and danidlaxref snagged him at 2.03 against an ADP of 1.07, the clearest win on the entire draft board. Chris Olave at WR11 gives the lineup a credible second pillar. The problem is that beyond those two, the floor drops fast, and the draft did little to reinforce it. Fourteen chalk picks and two major reaches define a board that rarely got creative and paid too early for the players it wanted most. Josh Jacobs, reached 1.8 rounds ahead of ADP, projects as RB16 under ordinary circumstances, but an unresolved legal situation clouds whether he plays at all, let alone at that level. Strip away Bowers and Olave and danidlaxref is leaning on a roster the projections already distrust, with no obvious trade chip left to change the conversation.

There is no sugarcoating the arithmetic here. Requiescat In Pace sits 11th in the Assassin's Creed division and projects at just the 13th percentile of the field, and the roster does not hide why. The quarterback situation is the most obvious wound, with Baker Mayfield at QB18, Sam Darnold at QB21, and Aaron Rodgers at QB29 forming a trio of middling starters, and the draft made it worse rather than better, reaching three full rounds early for Darnold and two-plus for Rodgers. Jonathan Taylor at RB4 and Trey McBride at TE2 are genuine assets, and McBride arriving as a half-round value at 2.02 was about the only moment the draft worked in this team's favor. But after Taylor and McBride, the projected starters include Marvin Harrison Jr. at WR33 and Jayden Reed at WR48, and last season's 42 percent win rate suggests this roster has been treading water for a while. The name translates to "rest in peace," and after a long look at this depth chart, the sentiment feels less like a brand choice and more like a forecast.

There is no pretty way to say this: MyFantasyScores is projected to finish 10th in the Assassin's Creed division and in just the 15th percentile of the field, and the draft didn't generate the kind of surplus value that might change that trajectory. Fifteen chalk picks and one good value against a pair of genuine reaches, including Chimere Dike pulled three full rounds ahead of his ADP, is not a recipe for outrunning a thin projection. Lamar Jackson is the obvious anchor, a projected QB3 who cost a minor reach at 1.09, but the receiver group behind him grades out weak, with DeVonta Smith as the best of them at WR14 and the next projected starter, Carnell Tate, sitting at WR29. James Cook at RB5 and Chase Brown at RB11 give this team some real firepower, but in a positionless format the ceiling depends on how many of those players actually hit, and right now the roster looks like a team that drafted competently and still ended up without enough. There is no obvious lever left to pull.

There is not much to sugarcoat here for T1000, currently sitting ninth in the Assassin's Creed division and in just the 16th percentile of the field after a 2025 campaign that produced a 14-22 record and 26th-percentile scoring. The clearest bright spot is Drake Maye, a genuine QB2 projection with a legitimate case for upside after finishing second in MVP voting last year, and the addition of A.J. Brown in New England gives him the alpha wideout he lacked when he was making do with Stefon Diggs and Hunter Henry. But Maye is essentially the ceiling here, not the floor, and everything below him grades out as middling at best. Kenneth Walker III projects as RB10 but cost the team nearly a full round of draft capital as a reach at 2.06, and three major reaches overall means T1000 paid full price for players the market had already discounted. Nico Collins at WR9 is a legitimate piece, but a roster this dependent on its top two players performing perfectly, with a projected weakest starter in Chigoziem Okonkwo at TE19, has almost no margin for error and very few levers left to pull.

manolo316 drafted like someone who walked into the wrong auction and just started bidding anyway. The clearest evidence is at quarterback, where Cam Ward lands as QB23 and was still taken 2.4 rounds before his ADP at pick 8.01, burning a premium selection on a player who projects as a fringe starter at best. That reach would sting less if the rest of the draft compensated, but this roster produced zero steals and zero values across the entire board, just chalk picks and a cascade of reaches, including Ashton Jeanty taken 0.7 rounds early and Chris Bell dragged in nearly six rounds ahead of his ADP. The receiver group is genuinely good, with Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4, Malik Nabers at WR12, and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 giving this team a real foundation. But in a positionless format, elite receivers can only carry so much, and when your quarterback ceiling is Ward, the whole enterprise

runs into a ceiling fast. Division rank of eighth and a 16th-percentile tournament projection say everything the draft board already implied.

wyaththoward sits at 63rd percentile and seventh in the Assassin's Creed division, which is exactly the kind of résumé that keeps you up at night without actually scaring anyone else. The ceiling here is real: Josh Allen at QB1 stacked with D.J. Moore at WR26 is the kind of pairing that can torch a week by itself, and Omarion Hampton at RB9 and Jeremiyah Love at RB13 give this roster genuine firepower at the top. The problem is the margins, and the draft exposed them. Reaching five-plus rounds early on Emanuel Wilson at RB69 and Elijah Sarratt at WR98 suggests a manager who got anxious in the late rounds, burning picks on depth that may never matter while Hunter Henry at TE18 quietly anchors the weakest spot in the starting lineup. When Allen and Moore are humming, wyaththoward looks like a threat. When they're not, the roster around them is just average enough to lose a close week to almost anyone in the field.

katrimt didn't swing for the fences and miss, didn't load up on upside and pray. They just drafted well, round after round, and the ledger shows it. Joe Burrow at QB4 slid past his ADP at 2.10, a quiet win that also unlocked the Burrow/Tee Higgins stack, a proven connection that gives this roster a reliable scoring floor on game days. Bijan Robinson at RB2 anchors what is genuinely a strong group of projected starters, and the depth behind him, Travis Etienne, Jaylen Warren, RJ Harvey, keeps the floor elevated even when injuries start doing what injuries do. The draft wasn't flawless: Kyle Monangai was taken 2.8 rounds ahead of his ADP, a meaningful overpay. But one aggressive miscalculation doesn't undo thirteen chalk picks and three real values. Sitting 64th percentile in the field and sixth in the Assassin's Creed division, katrimt isn't the loudest name in the room, just one of the better-constructed rosters in it.

David91R didn't win the draft with one flashy pick. He won it by consistently getting more than he paid for. Justin Jefferson landing at WR6 when his ADP had him going nearly a full round earlier is the kind of quiet win that compounds across a roster, and Dalton Kincaid slipping to TE11 almost two rounds past his ADP is exactly that compounding in action. Pair those values with Jaxon Smith-Njigba projecting as a WR3 and you have a starting core that most managers in the Assassin's Creed division would take without blinking. Zay Flowers at WR16 and Christian Watson at WR28 round out a projected starting group that gives David91R real margin for error on any given week. The draft log shows sixteen chalk picks against zero reaches, which sounds boring until you realize boring drafts tend to age well. Sitting at 68th percentile puts this team firmly in the conversation without guaranteeing anything, but the foundation here was built correctly, and that matters more than it gets credit for.

Stevie31 lands at 77th percentile in the field and fourth in the Assassin's Creed division, which sounds modest until you look at the roster underneath those numbers. The headliners are real: Ja'Marr Chase at WR2, De'Von Achane at RB6, and Saquon Barkley at RB8 form the kind of top end that wins weeks outright. Now here is where the story gets interesting. Achane and Breece Hall both fell past their ADPs, genuine values that Stevie31 pocketed. But the draft also includes two major reaches, AJ Barner taken two full rounds early and Troy Franklin taken more than three rounds ahead of consensus. Those are not accidents, they are convictions, and the roster suggests most of them landed. Goff going a round early, Pat Bryant going two rounds early, Barkley going slightly before his number, none of it cratered the build. The board said Stevie31 was aggressive to the point of recklessness. The projections say the aggression mostly worked. In a format this deep, that combination of a elite top end and a drafter willing to trust their own board might be exactly enough.

ffbigcat arrives in the Assassin's Creed division ranked third, sitting at the 81st percentile, and carrying a roster that has no business being this good given how the draft unfolded. The board shows two major reaches and four minor ones, which is the kind of draft profile that usually earns a polite eulogy. Instead, ffbigcat walks away with Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1, Tyler Warren at TE4, and Caleb Williams at QB6 anchoring a lineup that projects as a genuine threat. The conviction reads clearly: ffbigcat decided what they wanted and paid early to get it, consequences be damned. The question is whether that philosophy holds under pressure, because Jalen Hurts at QB9 is the roster's most interesting fault line, a player who has delivered five consecutive top-10 fantasy finishes but now faces a passing offense stripped of A.J. Brown and a scrutiny he has never quite faced before. If Hurts bends, ffbigcat has Williams to absorb the blow. If the reaches at the back end, Isiah Pacheco and Chris Brazzell II, come up empty, the foundation still holds. This team was built by someone who trusted their board over everyone else's. After last

season's 17th percentile finish, that kind of defiance looks less like arrogance and more like the only rational response.

mjgard64 lands at 84th percentile and second in the Assassin's Creed division, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. The foundation is elite: Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and CeeDee Lamb at WR5 give this roster two of the most reliable point-generators in the field, and both came at value, with Lamb sliding nearly a full round past his ADP. From there, mjgard64 just kept finding soft spots in the board. Tucker Kraft, projected TE5, fell nearly three rounds before getting scooped at 7.08, the kind of market inefficiency that separates disciplined drafters from lucky ones. Isaiah Likely at TE13 came 1.5 rounds late. David Njoku at TE29 came 1.5 rounds late. The one blemish is Brock Purdy, taken 1.3 rounds ahead of schedule at 4.05, but in a positionless format where starting the best available player is the whole game, a QB13 reaching slightly early is a footnote, not a crisis. Six values, one steal, zero major messes. This roster was built with patience and precision, and the standings reflect it.

Sitting atop the Assassin's Creed division and landing in the 98th percentile of the entire field, fantasyzip built this roster the right way: disciplined, patient, and sharp when the board gave an opening. Six values across the draft tell the real story. George Kittle slipping to a TE9 projection two rounds past his ADP, Harold Fannin landing at TE6 nearly two rounds late, Rashee Rice falling a full round to become a projected starter at WR13, these are the kinds of wins that separate a clean draft from a lucky one. The receiver group is the engine, with Puka Nacua projecting at WR1, A.J. Brown at WR8, and Rice at WR13 all penciled into the starting lineup. If there is anything to nitpick, it is that the weakest projected starter is Josh Downs at WR46, and after a 50th percentile scoring season in 2025, fantasyzip has something to prove in terms of execution. But the roster construction gives every reason to believe this is the year the results match the blueprint.
