The 2026 Scott Fish Bowl is shaping up to be another long autumn for justeast, a team sitting in the bottom of the Asteroids division and projecting at just the 11th percentile of the field. Last season's 7-29 record and 3rd-percentile scoring make that projection feel generous. The roster has real building blocks, Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Saquon Barkley at RB8 give this team a legitimate core, and both arrived as values relative to ADP. But the rest of the roster is carrying weight it probably cannot hold. Malik Nabers at WR12 is a capable piece, yet below him the receiver group falls off sharply into Deebo Samuel at WR70 and Chimere Dike at WR84. Meanwhile, a sixth-round pick on Fernando Mendoza, a QB27 taken nearly seven rounds before his ADP, is the kind of draft decision that quietly poisons a roster by diverting capital away from the spots that needed it most. With Rhamondre Stevenson at RB31 projecting as the weakest starter, justeast looks like a team that built its floor carefully and then forgot to build a ceiling.

TheYetiExpress arrives in the Asteroids division sitting 11th and projecting in the 13th percentile of the field, which is the kind of number that makes a manager refresh the standings page hoping for a clerical error. The core is not without talent, Patrick Mahomes projects as QB12 and Bijan Robinson as RB2, and Justin Jefferson landed two rounds past his ADP, a genuine find. But the draft tells a story that undercuts all of it. The manager spent third and fourth round capital on Mahomes and Jordan Love, reaching 2.2 and 2.9 rounds early respectively, which is real equity burned on a position that barely moves the needle in a positionless format. Those picks could have bought another Robinson or a second Jefferson-tier receiver. Instead the projected lineup bottoms out at Matthew Golden, a WR52, and the team went 27th percentile in scoring a year ago. Last season was already the canary. The 2026 version does not look like a team that found the answers over the offseason.

T-Fantasaurus Rex lands 10th in the Asteroids division and in just the 18th percentile of the field, and the draft record tells you most of what you need to know about why: three major reaches against a single steal, which is the drafting equivalent of paying full sticker price on a car, then tipping the salesman. The two biggest culprits are sitting right at the top of the roster. Joe Burrow at QB4 cost a first-round pick when his ADP sat in the second, and Justin Herbert at QB8 came off the board a round and a half early in the second. Herbert is genuinely intriguing with Mike McDaniel now running the offense, but the Chargers have won 11 games in each of the last two seasons by playing ball-control football, and Herbert's pass attempts have slid accordingly, capping his ceiling in a format where volume is oxygen. Burning premium capital on two quarterbacks before the rest of the roster filled in left T-Fantasaurus Rex short on the upside plays that a bottom-tier projected lineup desperately needs to make noise.

Drunk At The Turn finished 83rd percentile in scoring last season and came into 2026 drafting like someone who needed to prove something, and what they proved is that confidence and competence are not the same thing. The running back group is genuinely impressive, with Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 anchoring a deep collection of contributors, but the draft board tells a story the final roster cannot hide: four major reaches, zero steals, and a quarterback situation built around Jaxson Dart, taken 2.8 rounds ahead of his QB11 projection, as though the manager spotted something the entire rest of the field missed and most certainly did not. Then the team spent two more early picks reaching for Rachaad White and Gunnar Helm before the market agreed those players were worth selecting. The values the roster does carry, Jeanty and Chase Brown, arrived because the market handed them over, not because the manager forced anything. This is a team that drafted with urgency and

without discipline, landing at 25th percentile in the field and ninth in the Asteroids division, which is exactly where the board said they would end up.

Gator_Jay_ went 27-9 last season and finished in the 80th percentile, which earns a certain amount of credibility going into 2026. The projection does not honor that credibility. A 36th-percentile forecast and a division rank of 8 suggest the gap between last year's reputation and this year's roster is real, and the draft offers some explanation for how it opened up. Four major reaches dot the board, including Jayden Daniels off the first round at QB5 and Bo Nix taken 2.3 rounds early at QB15, and in a positionless format where every pick competes against the entire field for value, paying that kind of premium twice at quarterback is a compounding problem. There are genuine assets here, Trey McBride at TE2 was a legitimate value, and Kenneth Walker III and Jaylen Waddle project as quality starters, but the foundation built on those good picks keeps getting taxed by the reaches surrounding them. The 80th percentile is a fact about 2025. The 36th percentile is a warning about 2026.

GrapeApe sits at 48th percentile and seventh in the Asteroids division, which is about as middle-of-the-road as it gets, and that is precisely why the small edges matter so much here. The roster has a real ceiling: Lamar Jackson at QB3 anchors everything, Tyler Warren at TE4 is a genuine difference-maker, and Jonathan Taylor at RB4 gives the lineup a high floor alongside him. The question is what happens after those top names, and that is where the margins get tight. D.J. Moore and Michael Wilson both fell past their ADPs, offering quietly useful depth, but the weakest projected starter is Quentin Johnston at WR41, and that is the kind of soft spot that separates 7-6 seasons from 9-4 ones. Travis Kelce is officially back after an offseason of uncertainty, hoping to climb back into TE12 range, which would push this ceiling higher, but "hoping" is doing a lot of work in that sentence. GrapeApe does not lose the room, but it also does not walk in owning it.

The Snarling Ditzkas sit at the 49th percentile heading into 2026, and that number is basically a shrug emoji rendered in fantasy football data. There is genuine upside here: Brock Bowers at TE1 and Colston Loveland at TE3 give this roster a positional advantage that most managers in the Asteroids division cannot match, and Jeremiyah Love at RB13 and Dak Prescott at QB7 anchor a respectable top end. But the margins are where this season gets decided, and the margins are genuinely unsettling. The manager reached 4.2 rounds early for Jonathon Brooks at RB37, a bet that has to hit for the depth to hold up. Meanwhile, Greg Dulcich lands as the projected weakest starter at TE25, a notable drop-off from the Bowers-Loveland tier above him. Last year's 97th-percentile scoring output sets a high bar that this construction does not obviously clear. The Snarling Ditzkas are not a pushover and not a contender, and figuring out which way they tip probably depends on Brooks justifying that early investment.

Toothfxr drafted like someone who trusted their board more than the board trusted them back, and so far the roster is making a decent case for the defense. Twelve chalk picks and one steal do not scream visionary, but three major reaches and three minor reaches sprinkled throughout suggest a manager who saw something the consensus missed, or got away with something the consensus was right to avoid. The honest answer is probably both. Josh Allen at QB1 anchors everything, taken first overall when the field pegged him four spots later, a minor reach that looks more like a formality than a mistake. The deeper question is whether the late-round conviction holds. Emanuel Wilson at RB69, grabbed nearly five rounds ahead of schedule, is the clearest swing, and Tucker Kraft at TE5 adds legitimate upside if his post-ACL recovery translates into the same ascending role he occupied before November interrupted the conversation. This roster sits 59th percentile, fifth in the Asteroids, which undersells the talent at the top and fairly sells the uncertainty underneath it.

The Yum Yums didn't make any single move that screams genius, but round after round they came out ahead, and that's a harder trick than it looks. The centerpiece is Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and CeeDee Lamb at WR5, both projected starters, and Lamb arriving two rounds after his ADP tells you the draft was going their way before they even pushed their chips in. From there the roster just kept accumulating value: Josh Downs, Rashid Shaheed, and Jalen McMillan each slid past their ADPs by more than a round, so the back end of this roster is built on late-round surplus rather than desperation. Trevor Lawrence at QB10 was taken 1.3 rounds early, and RJ Harvey at RB28 was an even more aggressive call at 2.8 rounds ahead of schedule, so there are real questions about whether those picks gave back what the receiver run generated. Still, five values against three major reaches is a ledger that favors the Yum Yums, and 64th percentile standing in the field reflects a team that quietly drafted its way into the conversation.

Last year, Podfather5000 finished in the 11th percentile in scoring, a result so grim it practically dared this manager to rebuild with conviction, and that is exactly what happened. The 2026 roster lands at 73rd percentile in the tournament and third in the Asteroids division, and the upgrade is not subtle. Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4), George Pickens (WR10), and Chris Olave (WR11) headline a receiver group that could carry a lineup on any given week, while Harold Fannin (TE6) and Kyle Pitts (TE7) give the manager elite upside at tight end as well. Fannin is the particularly interesting piece: he outplayed David Njoku last year, Njoku is now gone, and any improvement to Cleveland's offense opens the door for more red zone work. Caleb Williams (QB6) was the one aggressive move in the draft, taken a full round and a half before his ADP, and if that bet pays off, this team has a ceiling that last year's version could not have imagined from its seat at the bottom of the standings.

Patty Pickles sits second in the Asteroids division and in the 85th percentile of the field, and the draft record tells you exactly why: thirteen chalk picks, three genuine values, and not a single major reach. That is not a flashy résumé, but it is a winning one. The foundation is Puka Nacua at WR1 and A.J. Brown at WR8, two projected starters who give this roster a ceiling most managers would trade for right now. Then there is the Jalen Hurts and DeVonta Smith stack, a connection that rewards Pickles every time Hurts engineers a big game, which happens often enough to be a real structural asset. Where the draft got quietly excellent was in the middle rounds: DeVonta Smith fell nearly a full round past his ADP at 4.11, and Jadarian Price slipped more than a round at 10.11. Neither pick made headlines in the moment. That is exactly the point. Pickles did not need one transformative swing because the draft was full of small edges that quietly compounded into something worth watching.

justinherzig sits atop the Asteroids division at the 97th percentile, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. This is a roster built with patience and precision: six good values, one outright steal, and only a single minor reach across the entire board. The foundation is Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and De'Von Achane at RB6, a pair of projected starters who give this team a ceiling that most managers in this field would trade their draft boards to own. Drake London fell to the second round at WR7, Derrick Henry slid nearly a full round past his ADP, and Dallas Goedert quietly arrived in round eleven as a TE15 steal, two rounds after the board valued him. Even the weakest projected starter on this roster is a TE15. The Brandon Aiyuk reach in the final rounds is the lone blemish, and calling it a blemish is being generous to the competition. justinherzig didn't luck into this draft. He worked for it.
