The Pandora Dragonflies finished 36th percentile in scoring last season and, after a draft that produced zero steals and zero values against 14 chalk picks, there is little reason to expect the trajectory to reverse. Josh Allen is a genuine anchor, projecting as QB1 and pairing with D.J. Moore in a stack that gives the roster a real ceiling, but the supporting cast grades out thin fast. The receiver group is the clearest drag, with Moore at WR26 leading a unit that bottoms out at Zachariah Branch (WR75) and Chimere Dike (WR84). Meanwhile, the draft itself offered few hints of upside hunting. Jeremiyah Love came in as the lone major reach, taken a full round and a half before consensus in the third slot, and the return on that aggression is a RB13 projection that is fine but not the high-variance moonshot that justifies the early cost. Sitting 12th in the Astro Bot division and in just the 15th percentile of the field, the Dragonflies look like a team waiting for something to break right that the roster has not yet earned.

The Tormented Charizards are a cautionary tale dressed up in receiver depth, and the draft board tells the whole story. Three major reaches in a single draft is not bad luck, it is a philosophy, and this manager committed to it fully: Jacory Croskey-Merritt dragged out of the pool nearly three rounds early, Trey Benson snagged almost six rounds before his ADP, and Michael Penix Jr. pulled forward three rounds in the back half of the draft where mistakes compound fastest. The result is a team sitting 11th in the Astro Bot division and in just the 16th percentile of the field, which tracks almost perfectly with a 2025 campaign that landed in the second percentile of tournament scoring. Justin Jefferson at WR6 is real and worth noting, and the Patrick Mahomes and Rashee Rice stack adds genuine upside, but those bright spots exist alongside a draft philosophy that spent premium currency on players ranked RB40, RB64, and QB33. Tormented is doing a lot of heavy lifting as a team name this season.

Finkle Force did almost everything right on draft day, and the standings are going to be brutal about it anyway. Brock Bowers fell nearly a full round past ADP and landed at pick 2.03, a genuine gift for a TE1 in a positionless format. Jordan Addison slipped more than two rounds and came at 12.03. The values were real. But the draft also produced Aaron Rodgers, a QB29 taken more than four rounds early, and Jaylen Warren, a RB27 dragged off the board 2.3 rounds before the market agreed. Those reaches did not sink a pick or two, they consumed the round equity that separates a good roster from a great one. The result is a team projected 10th in the Astro Bot division and in the 28th percentile of the field, despite a draft philosophy that was, on paper, sound. Finkle Force bought the right things at the right prices and still came home with the wrong groceries. That is not bad luck. That is the particular cruelty of a draft that almost worked.

Strat enters 2026 sitting ninth in the Astro Bot division and at the 33rd percentile of the field, and the roster does not offer many places to hide. The draft did surface some genuine finds, Garrett Wilson falling a round and a half past his ADP and Jake Ferguson sliding more than a round to give the back end of the roster some cushion, but the foundation was set early with Jayden Daniels taken nearly a round and a half before consensus at the first overall pick. Daniels projects as QB5, which is a fine outcome if everything breaks right, but paying first-pick premium for a quarterback in a positionless format is a bet that needs to hit perfectly to justify itself, and perfectly is a hard standard to clear. James Cook at RB5 and Saquon Barkley at RB8 are legitimate studs, but when Courtland Sutton, a WR37, is your weakest projected starter, the margin for variance is thin. Strat posted a 61st-percentile scoring season in 2025. The arrow is pointing the wrong way.

Thorn20 is sitting at 36th percentile heading into 2026, and the roster does not offer much reason for optimism. The receiver group is legitimately good, anchored by Jaxon Smith-Njigba (WR3), George Pickens (WR10), and Zay Flowers (WR16), all projected starters who give this team a real ceiling. The problem is that everything else is working against them. The draft featured three major reaches, including Kirk Cousins pulled nearly three and a half rounds early and Malachi Fields grabbed over three rounds before his ADP, which is not the kind of aggressive drafting that pays off at the margins of a competitive field. Coming off a 39% win rate and a 20th percentile scoring finish in 2025, Thorn20 needed to swing for upside and instead overpaid for aging quarterbacks and speculative depth. Jaxon Smith-Njigba and company can only carry so much weight, and right now the rest of this roster looks like it is content to watch from the wrong side of the standings.

ChefBjaf played this draft the right way. Fourteen chalk picks, two genuine values in Bucky Irving (RB21) and Michael Pittman (WR44), and not a single major reach anywhere on the board. The discipline is real. The projected finish, 43rd percentile and seventh in the Astro Bot division, is the kind of number that makes you question whether discipline is actually worth anything. The problem is not process but payoff: Irving lands at RB21 and Pittman, now buried in a Pittsburgh offense still searching for an identity around an Aaron Rodgers pushing 43, projects at WR44, which is the sort of value that looks better in a recap column than in a standings column. Caleb Williams stacking with Rome Odunze is the clearest path to a ceiling, but Odunze sits at WR30 and the rest of the receiver group thins out quickly below him. ChefBjaf did almost everything a value-conscious drafter is supposed to do, collected the right players at the right prices, and still landed in the middle of the field. That is not bad luck. That is just the draft telling you the prices were right for a reason.

GuiceGuiceBaby enters 2026 sitting at the 47th percentile of the field, which is the fantasy equivalent of being exactly as dangerous as advertised, no more, no less. The receiver group is genuinely good: Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 was snagged at 2.02 when his ADP sat at 1.10, a quietly excellent get, and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 fell nearly two rounds into the manager's lap as well. That kind of value at the top of the roster creates real upside. What keeps this team anchored to the middle is the uncertainty layered underneath those names. Jonathan Taylor projects as RB4 but carries the asterisk of a player always one bad week away from a roster conversation, and Dallas Goedert, back in Philadelphia on a one-year deal after an offseason that looked like a goodbye, is a legitimate TE15 with a recent track record of delivering in big moments, but a one-year deal means the floor can

disappear fast. The margins here are real. GuiceGuiceBaby has the ceiling to make noise in the Astro Bot division and the fragility to finish exactly where it started.

KennnyB didn't swing for the fences and miss, didn't chase upside at the cost of a floor. This roster was built pick by pick, and the draft board rewarded the patience. CeeDee Lamb landing at 2.05 when his ADP sat at 1.11 was the headline move, a WR5 sliding half a round into KennnyB's lap. Jaylen Waddle followed a round later than he should have, and Jakobi Meyers slipped a full round and a half in the back half of the draft. Three values, zero major reaches, fourteen chalk selections: this is what a clean draft looks like. The starting core is legitimate, anchored by Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Lamb at WR5, with Chase Brown at RB11 and Waddle at WR23 giving the lineup real depth behind them. The projected weakest starter is Rhamondre Stevenson at RB31, which tells you something about the floor here. A 55th-percentile tournament projection and fifth in the Astro Bot division feels like an underread on a team that consistently came out ahead at the table.

abroc21 didn't force anything in this draft, and the roster reflects it. The foundation is genuinely strong: Jahmyr Gibbs lands as RB1 and Ashton Jeanty comes in at RB7, giving this team a top-of-market backfield presence that most managers would envy. From there, abroc21 kept steady, adding Tee Higgins (WR19), Davante Adams (WR25), and Mike Evans (WR27) as projected starters who round out a starting lineup with real upside. The draft board shows 16 chalk picks and zero major reaches, which sounds boring until you realize that disciplined drafting is exactly how you build a team sitting at the 70th percentile of the field. The one true value on the board, David Njoku at TE29, came 1.9 rounds later than expected, a quiet win that reinforces the pattern. The 2025 campaign was rough at 28 percent wins, but this roster is a clear step forward in projection, and the Astro Bot division should take notice that abroc21 came to the table with a plan and mostly executed it.

MSly didn't win the draft with a single thunderclap moment. They won it pick by pick, quietly coming out ahead often enough that the cumulative advantage is hard to ignore. The wide receiver group is the centerpiece: Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 anchors everything, and Drake London (WR7) and Nico Collins (WR9) arrived as genuine values, both sliding past their ADPs to land in MSly's lap. Jameson Williams at WR21 fell another round and a half beyond where he should have been taken, which means four of MSly's top receivers were acquired at a discount. That kind of consistent execution is what separates a good draft from a great one. Tucker Kraft at TE5 gives the roster a legitimate edge at that position, and Matthew Stafford projects as a serviceable QB14. The Daniel Jones reach at round nine is the one blemish, two rounds early for a QB25, but one questionable quarterback selection does not unravel a draft this disciplined. Third in the Astro Bot division and 73rd percentile overall, MSly is built to compete.

What aperry21 built in the Astro Bot division is the kind of draft that makes other managers set down their coffee and stare. The headline is the tight end room: Trey McBride at TE2 fell nearly a full round past his ADP, Tyler Warren at TE4 slipped another eight-tenths of a round, and Sam LaPorta at TE8 joins them as a projected starter, giving this roster a positional advantage that compounds with every week. Layer on top of that a Justin Herbert and Ladd McConkey stack, with McConkey himself a round-plus value at WR20, and the draft starts to look less like luck and more like a plan being executed. Thirteen chalk picks, five values, one steal, and zero major reaches: the discipline behind those numbers is the real story. After a brutal 2025 that landed at the 1st percentile in scoring, aperry21 responded not with panic but with precision, and the result is a team sitting second in the division and in the 81st percentile tournament-wide.

The Big Loubowski didn't win the Scott Fish Bowl draft with one big swing. They won it with consistency, and sitting first in the Astro Bot division at the 92nd tournament percentile is the receipt. Start with Puka Nacua, projected WR1 in the field and grabbed at 1.06 when his ADP sat at 1.01, a modest slip that a sharp manager recognized and capitalized on immediately. Then De'Von Achane, a projected RB6 who fell nearly a full round past his ADP and landed in this lineup like a gift. Five values against zero steals tells you something: this roster wasn't built on lottery tickets, it was built on showing up when other managers blinked. The one genuine concern is Alec Pierce, a projected WR32 starter who brings legitimate big-play upside but carries PUP list uncertainty into the summer, and a slow recovery could cost this team a projected starter for the first four weeks. Even accounting for that, the foundation here is sound, the depth is real, and The Big Loubowski looks like a team built to go deep.
