GTTerp enters the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl sitting fourth percentile in the field, and the roster does not offer many reasons for optimism. The draft tells a familiar story of a team that zigged when it should have zagged: two major reaches, zero steals, and a strategy that somehow involved taking George Kittle 4.1 rounds ahead of his ADP despite him projecting as a TE9, a pick that consumed premium capital on a player the market had already priced more patiently. Then there is Patrick Mahomes, whose torn ACL and LCL from Week 15 of 2025 casts a genuine shadow over this entire operation. The recovery news has been encouraging, reportedly ahead of schedule, but "reportedly ahead of schedule" is not a starting lineup. If Mahomes misses time, GTTerp slides down to Sam Darnold at QB21, which is the kind of contingency plan that keeps managers awake at night. Last season's 59th-percentile scoring finish feels like a distant ceiling now. There is no obvious lever left to pull, and the clock is already running.

PandeeCat did almost everything right in the draft room and has almost nothing to show for it. Fifteen chalk picks, two genuine values in Tyler Allgeier and Isaac TeSlaa falling more than two rounds past their ADPs, and zero major reaches is the profile of a disciplined, patient drafter. The cruelty is that discipline does not appear to have bought much. The projected lineup leans on Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 as its clearest strengths, but the supporting cast grades out as replacement-level depth rather than a genuine second wave, and a 24th-percentile tournament projection does not lie about where this roster sits. Kyle Pitts at TE7 offers upside, and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 is a reasonable contributor, but the ceiling of this team keeps bumping against the same low ceiling no matter which angle you approach it from. PandeeCat followed the rules, played the board correctly, and still landed in 11th in the Burger Time division. Sometimes the draft just does not care how well you behaved.

There is no spin available for mattreynolds13, just a draft sheet that reads like a confession. The RB group is genuinely strong, with Christian McCaffrey, James Cook, Travis Etienne, and Quinshon Judkins all projecting as starters, so the foundation is there. But then the wheels come off, loudly. Matthew Stafford, projected QB14, was taken nearly two rounds early in round four, burning a pick that could have addressed what became a genuinely weak receiver room. Brandon Aiyuk, projected WR81, was grabbed five full rounds ahead of his ADP, and Elijah Arroyo, projected TE40, was taken nearly five rounds early as well. That is not aggressive drafting, that is panic buying at full markup. The result is a roster that sits 10th in Burger Time and in just the 26th percentile of the field, propped up by a strong backfield and let down by everything surrounding it. Wan'Dale Robinson, projected WR47, is the weakest projected starter, which tells you everything about where the receiver room landed after those late-round misfires burned the capital that was supposed to fix it.

mikemaher ran a disciplined draft, landing Woody Marks and Brian Robinson each about 1.8 rounds after their respective ADPs, and finding almost nothing to complain about in the process. Sixteen chalk picks, zero major reaches, a tidy Brock Purdy and Mike Evans stack. On paper, this looks like the work of a careful, patient drafter. And yet the roster sits at 26th percentile, ninth in Burger Time, which is the particular exhaustion that comes from doing everything right and still ending up somewhere disappointing. The problem is not the process, it is the ceiling. Purdy is a QB13 projection despite a weapons room that is, at the moment, held together with tape and optimism, with Kittle recovering from a torn Achilles, Pearsall's availability genuinely in doubt, and the 49ers leaning heavily on Evans to hold the passing game together. Puka Nacua projects as WR1, which is a legitimate anchor, but after him the drop-off is steep, and mikemaher's 2025 numbers suggest this team can score points without quite scoring enough of them.

DirtyCurti arrives in Burger Time carrying a 2025 résumé that is hard to spin: a 33 percent win rate and 22nd-percentile scoring that left little room for charitable interpretation. The 2026 outlook is not dramatically kinder. The quarterback situation is the clearest problem, with Bo Nix and Daniel Jones projecting as the best available options at QB15 and QB25 respectively, and Jones taken nearly two rounds early in a draft that produced two major reaches and zero steals. Brock Bowers at TE1 is a genuine asset, and Drake London at WR7 and Chris Olave at WR11 give the roster real upside at the top. But the draft was otherwise cautious to a fault, fourteen chalk picks and a Jordan James selection at RB67 that cost a mid-round pick to secure a projected low-end contributor. The skeleton of a competitive roster is visible, which almost makes it worse: Bowers and London are legitimate, the surrounding decisions just keep undercutting them, and at 37th percentile there is no obvious lever left to pull.

QuinNOut is the kind of team that makes projections feel meaningless and margins feel like everything. The floor is real: Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 is a genuine difference-maker, and a Jalen Hurts to DeVonta Smith stack gives this roster a ceiling most teams in Burger Time cannot replicate. But the ceiling only materializes if the connective tissue holds, and that connective tissue is fraying at the edges. Xavier Worthy projects as a WR49, the weakest projected starter on the roster, and in a positionless format where managers field whoever is producing, Worthy's boom-or-bust profile becomes the weekly variable that separates a win from a loss. The draft offered no steals and just two values, Tyjae Spears and Worthy himself, which means this roster was built almost entirely on consensus, and consensus rarely hands you the edge plays that swing tight weeks. At 59th percentile and seventh in the division, QuinNOut is not losing because of a catastrophic flaw. It is potentially losing because of twelve small ones, and that is the hardest kind of problem to fix in October.

jeffboggis didn't win the draft with a single thunderbolt pick. He won it by consistently getting more than he paid for, and the cumulative effect is a roster that sits in a genuinely interesting place heading into 2026. The foundation is obvious: Bijan Robinson at RB2 is the kind of projected output that makes a roster legitimate before you even look at the rest of the board. But the draft's quieter wins matter just as much. Marvin Harrison Jr. landed at WR33, taken at 9.01 with an ADP a full round later, and Jordan Addison at WR43 came in the same fashion, both falling past their market value and into jeffboggis's hands. Layer in Nico Collins projecting as WR9 and Jameson Williams at WR21 as projected starters, and the pass-catching depth here is real. The quarterback situation is thin on paper, with Jordan Love projecting at QB17 and C.J. Stroud at QB22, but in a positionless format, manageable at the top means the rest of the roster can carry the weight. This team belongs in the conversation.

gothamranger did not win the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl draft with a single flashy pick. They won it pick by pick, quietly. The receiver group is where the consistency shows most clearly: CeeDee Lamb (WR5), Rashee Rice (WR13), Zay Flowers (WR16), and Brian Thomas Jr. (WR31) are all projected starters, and that kind of sustained quality across a position group rarely happens by accident. Zay Flowers pulls double duty as part of a Lamar Jackson stack, meaning gothamranger gets to run correlated upside on top of an already-sound foundation. The most telling moment of the draft came at 13.11, where RJ Harvey (RB28) was still sitting there, a full three and a half rounds past his ADP, and gothamranger simply took the free equity. That is not luck, that is attention. The 2025 season landed in the 34th percentile, so there is real distance to cover, but this roster has the projected starter quality and the draft capital efficiency to make a genuine run at the Burger Time standings.

JohnnyBravoe didn't need a blockbuster to build something serious in the Burger Time division. The foundation is a backfield headlined by De'Von Achane at RB6 and Chase Brown at RB11, two legitimate weekly contributors who give this roster a reliable ceiling before it even gets to the depth behind them. Trey McBride at TE2 is the kind of anchor that quietly wins matchups, and Caleb Williams arriving at QB6 after sliding a full round past his ADP means JohnnyBravoe collected genuine value without forcing anything. The draft sheet reads like someone who simply kept winning small negotiations: fourteen picks at chalk, one value, and no desperate swings that backfired at the top of the board. The one reach that stands out is Chris Bell, taken more than five rounds ahead of his ADP, and that bet will need to pay off. But the rest of the construction is sound enough that even if Bell disappoints, the lineup can absorb it. Sitting at the 71st percentile of the field with this kind of quiet competence, JohnnyBravoe belongs in the conversation.

adumbli didn't win the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl draft in a single moment. There was no thunderbolt pick, no heist that had the draft room buzzing. There was just round after round of decisions that quietly tilted the board in one direction. Josh Allen at QB1 anchors everything, and pairing him with Drake Maye as a QB2 means adumbli is simply not losing the quarterback position. Below that, the roster holds its shape: Garrett Wilson at WR17, Tee Higgins at WR19, taken nearly two rounds after his ADP suggested he would be available, and Carnell Tate at WR29, whose Tennessee pairing with Cam Ward carries real upside if that connection develops into what both franchises need it to be. Mark Andrews at TE14 keeps the floor from ever dropping out. None of these picks rewrote the draft narrative. That's the point. adumbli lands at 73rd percentile in the field and third in the Burger Time division not because of one brilliant swing, but because fifteen chalk picks and one genuine value added up to something quietly difficult to beat.

TGOD176 finished this draft sitting second in the Burger Time Division and in the 74th percentile of the field, which is a genuinely impressive address for a manager who spent most of draft day ignoring the price tags. Three major reaches, two minor ones, zero steals, and yet the roster works. The conviction case looks like this: Justin Fields at QB38 taken nearly five rounds early, Michael Mayer at TE39 taken more than four rounds early, Zachariah Branch at WR75 taken nearly three rounds early. None of those are names that inspire confidence when read off a reach list. And yet the starting corps includes Jayden Daniels at QB5, Jonathan Taylor at RB4, and Justin Jefferson at WR6, all of them projected contributors, all of them surrounded by enough depth that TGOD176 can absorb a stumble. The luck case is that those reaches are still reaches, and Branch and Mayer are long odds to pay them off. The truth is probably somewhere in the middle, which is exactly where second in the division tends to live.

RotoSuperstar sits atop the Burger Time division at the 97th percentile of the field, and when you look at how this roster came together, that standing makes complete sense. The foundation is a legitimate ace stack: Joe Burrow at QB4 paired with Ja'Marr Chase at WR2, both projected starters, both acquired with discipline. Burrow slipped to 2.09 despite an ADP of 2.05, a modest gift the manager accepted without flinching. The receiver depth behind Chase is the story that seals it, with Emeka Egbuka (WR18), Ladd McConkey (WR20), and Jaylen Waddle (WR23) all projecting as starters, Waddle himself falling more than a full round past his ADP. Add Colston Loveland at TE3 and Sam LaPorta at TE8, each taken after their respective ADPs had passed, and the pattern is impossible to miss: six values scattered across the board, zero major reaches, and a clean concentration of talent at the top of the lineup. This is what a well-executed SFB draft looks like.
