MalinFA sits ninth percentile in the field heading into 2026, and the draft record offers little reason for optimism. Of 18 selections, the team logged zero steals, one value, and two major reaches, including RJ Harvey pulled 2.5 rounds early and Kyle Monangai grabbed 2.2 rounds ahead of consensus. Those two are now projected starters, with Monangai slotting in as the weakest projected starter on the roster. There are genuine pieces here, Drake Maye and Caleb Williams give the team real upside at QB, and Justin Jefferson anchors the receiving corps at WR6, but the supporting cast grades out as middling across the board, and the draft capital spent chasing Harvey and Monangai early is capital that never came back as value elsewhere. This roster feels like a team that reached for a floor and ended up with a ceiling problem instead. Dead last in the Frogger division, with no obvious trade chip to flip and no projected breakout waiting in the wings, MalinFA looks like a team already running out of road before the season begins.

BDeraney drafted with the discipline of someone who read every ADP chart twice and still ended up exactly where patience was supposed to save them from. Christian McCaffrey, De'Von Achane, and Derrick Henry form a genuinely imposing core, and Justin Herbert falling nearly a full round past his ADP looks like the kind of quiet win that props up a roster. The problem is everything around that core. The projected starters at receiver top out at Parker Washington at WR35 and Courtland Sutton at WR37, and the weakest projected starter, Wan'Dale Robinson, arrives in Tennessee after a breakout 2025 season only to immediately compete for targets with a receiver Tennessee took fourth overall in the 2026 draft. BDeraney reached for Robinson 1.1 rounds early to acquire that uncertainty. That is the specific cruelty here: the draft process was mostly clean, 14 chalk picks and no major reaches, but the value the board offered was concentrated exactly where this roster was already strong. Following ADP is supposed to be insurance. BDeraney paid the premiums and the building still flooded.

Last year's 89th-percentile chemburns team was built on something. This year's version is living on the memory of it. The receiver corps is genuinely impressive, with CeeDee Lamb (WR5), Chris Olave (WR11), Tetairoa McMillan (WR15), and Jaylen Waddle (WR23) forming a projected starting group that most managers would envy, and the depth behind them is real. But the rest of the roster is where the reputation starts to curdle. The running back group tops out at Jacory Croskey-Merritt (RB40), and none of the three projected contributors crack the top 50 at their position. The draft offered no help, producing zero steals and zero values across 20 picks, while the two major reaches, Malik Willis at QB24 and Matthew Golden at WR52, pulled early capital toward players who weren't worth it. Lamar Jackson (QB3) is a genuine anchor, but he cannot carry a 19th-percentile projection alone. The Frogger division ranks chemburns 10th, and it is hard to argue with that math.

There is something quietly deflating about watching last year's best team walk into 2026 looking like a different outfit entirely. hboyd6 scored at the 100th percentile in 2025, went 32-4, and now sits at 31st percentile in tournament projections, ninth in the Frogger division. The roster tells you why. The top end is real: Bijan Robinson at RB2, Kenneth Walker III at RB10, Breece Hall at RB14, all projected starters. But the draft that built this roster leaned heavily on chalk, logged three major reaches, and produced zero steals. Jeremiyah Love, pulled 1.6 rounds ahead of his ADP and projecting as RB13, is either the bold move that makes this work or the early pick that cost hboyd6 the receiver depth that might have separated them. Patrick Mahomes lands at QB12 and still projects as a starter, taken at value, but the surrounding cast is thinner than the 2025 version of this team had any right to produce. Reputation is a debt this roster now has to pay.

gunrwilson enters 2026 sitting eighth in the Frogger division and in just the 34th percentile of the field, and the roster offers little reason for optimism. The foundation looks promising enough: Josh Allen is a genuine QB1 asset, and Drake London (WR7) and Nico Collins (WR9) give the lineup legitimate upside at receiver. But below that top tier, the floor drops quickly. The draft sheet is almost entirely chalk, with 14 picks tracking consensus and not a single steal on the board. The one value the draft produced was Jonathon Brooks at RB37, who fell nearly two rounds past his ADP, and even that prize arrives with the kind of injury history that makes you squint at it sideways. Meanwhile, Chuba Hubbard projects as the weakest starter on the roster at RB29, which tells you something about how thin the margin is. Allen can carry a bad week on his own, but he cannot carry a whole season, and right now gunrwilson is asking him to do exactly that.

Last year, dachhack went 34-2 and finished in the 100th percentile, which is the kind of season that makes your offseason roster decisions feel bulletproof. The 2026 version is here to test that confidence. The receiver corps is genuinely elite, anchored by A.J. Brown (WR8), DeVonta Smith (WR14), and Zay Flowers (WR16) as projected starters, and Brock Bowers (TE1) gives this team a foundational piece most managers would trade two draft picks to acquire. But the draft tells a different story about how this roster was assembled: two major reaches, including Alec Pierce at WR32 taken more than two rounds before his ADP, and the team projects 36th percentile overall with a seventh-place division ranking. The gap between what dachhack was and what the numbers say it is now is the central tension of their 2026 season. Reputations from one dominant year do not start games. The roster has real weapons, but it is operating on borrowed credibility until the scores say otherwise.

JBBurns didn't win the draft with one flashy swing. They won it by consistently being on the right side of the equation. The receiver group tells the story most clearly: Puka Nacua projects as WR1, George Pickens sits at WR10, and Jameson Williams and D.J. Moore round out a starting group where WR44 Michael Pittman is the weakest link, which is a comfortable place to be. Layer in a Matthew Stafford and Nacua stack, and the offense has a connective tissue that can pop on the same big days. The draft itself was almost aggressively disciplined, fourteen chalk picks with zero major reaches, and the two values the team did land, Brian Robinson and Oronde Gadsden, came at a combined discount of roughly three rounds. After a 2025 campaign that landed in the 46th percentile, JBBurns needed a cleaner build, and this looks like one. Sitting sixth in the Frogger division with a 55th percentile roster projection isn't a victory lap, but it is a real foundation.

MrFriskums didn't make headlines on draft day, but the results are hard to argue with. The foundation is legitimate: James Cook at RB5 and Trey McBride at TE2 are the kind of projected starters that make a roster immediately credible, and the supporting cast was assembled without the reckless reaches that tend to haunt managers by October. Jalen Hurts slid nearly two full rounds past his ADP, landing at QB9 value for a round-five price, and Chase Brown came in at RB11 after falling most of a round. That's not luck, that's a manager who knew what prices he was willing to pay and waited. The draft chart shows fourteen chalk picks and just two minor reaches, which tells you this wasn't a team built on bold swings, it was built on discipline. Romeo Doubs projects as the weakest projected starter at WR53, so the ceiling isn't unlimited, but a team that finished in the 84th percentile in scoring last season and is projecting 65th percentile this year isn't declining. It's steady, and steady wins divisions.

AlexGilstrap didn't win the draft with one flashy pick. This team was built pick by pick, round by round, with the kind of quiet discipline that looks boring in the moment and brilliant in hindsight. The most telling detail is how the values materialized: Trevor Lawrence at QB10 slipped more than a round past his ADP, Tee Higgins at WR19 fell a similar distance, and Chris Godwin at WR38 landed ten rounds into the draft for a player still worth starting. Three values across the board, zero steals, and just one reach worth noting in Darnell Mooney, who cost a couple rounds of premium but lands as depth rather than a load-bearing piece. What makes this roster dangerous is the top of the receiver group, where Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4, Rashee Rice at WR13, and Garrett Wilson at WR17 give AlexGilstrap genuine week-winning options before most managers have finished reading their starting lineups. A team that finished 97th percentile in scoring in 2025 and added consistent draft efficiency in 2026 is not sneaking up on anyone. It belongs in the conversation because it earned it.

Amphibious Assault did not build this roster by swinging for the fences on one flashy pick. They built it by winning the margins, round after round. The clearest example is Jayden Daniels, a QB5 projection who fell more than two full rounds past his ADP before this staff scooped him up at 5.01. That kind of patience compounds. Jahmyr Gibbs lands as the RB1 projection, Tyler Warren slots in as a TE4, and the supporting cast fills in with starters like Ladd McConkey at WR20 and Emeka Egbuka at WR18, the one meaningful reach on a board that was otherwise disciplined. The 2025 season, a 94th-percentile scoring finish, tells you this is not a team that stumbled into a good draft grade. They know how to convert a roster into points. Sitting third in the division and in the 77th percentile of the field entering 2026, Amphibious Assault does not need to convince anyone they belong in the conversation. The roster does that without any help.

drewdonbrown didn't need a single flashy move to land at 85th percentile and second in the Frogger Division, which is honestly the most underrated way to build a winner. The foundation is legitimate: Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and Harold Fannin at TE6 give this roster a ceiling that most managers in the field would trade for on the spot, and pairing them with Ashton Jeanty at RB7 means the projected starters are pulling real weight from top to bottom. What makes this draft quietly impressive is how little it cost to get there. Fourteen chalk picks sounds boring until you realize chalk is another word for not making mistakes, and drewdonbrown sprinkled in Jaxson Dart at QB11 a full round after his ADP suggested he'd be gone. Quinshon Judkins adds a compelling storyline too, a player who showed enough last season before a fractured fibula cut things short and is reportedly on track for training camp. If Judkins picks up where he left off, this roster gets meaningfully deeper at a position where it was already solid.

therealffGOAT sits first in the Frogger division and in the top 10 percent of the field, and the draft tells you exactly why. This is a roster built on discipline: five values, zero reaches, and a finishing floor anchored by Jayden Reed at WR48. That last part is the tell. When your weakest projected starter ranks WR48, you have drafted well. The value column does the explaining, starting with Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Malik Nabers at WR12, both locked into the starting lineup, with Nabers sliding to therealffGOAT nearly a full round past his ADP. The tight end group is where the quiet efficiency becomes something closer to art: Colston Loveland at TE3, Travis Kelce at TE10, and Jake Ferguson at TE12 were all taken after their ADPs, each one a small correct decision that compounds into a major structural advantage. Coming off an 83 percent win rate and 97th-percentile scoring in 2025, this team does not look like a fluke chasing a repeat. It looks like a process producing expected results.
