As they grace the tournament with their presence in the illustrious 7th percentile, perhaps they'll usher in a new era defined by daring drafts and distant dreams.

As the 2025 fantasy football season looms, Chris Jackle (@ChrisJackle) finds itself bracing for a challenging campaign. With an uninspiring ranking of 10th within the AverageJoe's division and languishing in the bottom 10 percentile overall, the outlook is bleak. Despite boasting a formidable wide receiver corps led by CeeDee Lamb, Brian Thomas Jr., and Garrett Wilson, the team is marred by glaring weaknesses elsewhere. Justin Herbert, while capable, is a middling QB13, leaving the quarterback position vulnerable to inconsistency. The running back stable, headlined by James Cook and Aaron Jones, ranks a disappointing 10th, offering little reassurance. Tight end Colston Loveland, inexplicably drafted ahead of his market value, only adds to the concerns with his tenuous TE11 standing. While there were glimmers of draft savviness with late-round steals like Ricky Pearsall, these seem overshadowed by costly early picks and reaches that squandered potential value. As the

season unfolds, Chris Jackle can only hope for unexpected breakthroughs to salvage what appears to be an uphill battle.
