Pistola4373 drafted like someone who arrived at the auction with a single-item shopping list and just kept buying the same thing. Five major reaches in one draft is not bad luck, it is a philosophy, and the results are predictable: Ashton Jeanty at RB7 cost a round-plus premium at 1.06, Oronde Gadsden at TE16 was yanked two rounds early despite a situation now clouded by the late signing of David Njoku, and Rachaad White at RB39 was essentially bought at clearance-rack prices from a shelf where he hadn't been marked down. Meanwhile, the receiver corps landed at WR8 for A.J. Brown and then fell off a cliff to Tre Harris at WR72, Germie Bernard at WR79, and Malachi Fields at WR90, all of which reflects what happens when early draft capital gets burned reaching elsewhere. The 2025 campaign came in at the 16th percentile in scoring, and with a projected tournament percentile of fifth and a division rank of 12th, the trajectory here is not a turnaround story. It is a confirmation.

The Jacksonville Jaguars sit 11th in the Bad Dudes division and project in the bottom 15th percentile of the entire field, and the draft board tells you most of what you need to know about why. Three major reaches defined the early rounds, most painfully Jake Ferguson at TE12 burned in round six and Hunter Henry at TE18 burned in round eight, capital that could have built the kind of foundation a team in this position desperately needs. The tight end group is genuinely elite on paper, with Trey McBride, Colston Loveland, Travis Kelce and Ferguson all projected starters, and yes, Kelce returning after an uncertain offseason is a real thing. But this is a positionless format, and stacking four strong tight ends only helps if the rest of the roster keeps pace, and it does not. The wide receiver group grades weak, the quarterback situation leans on Caleb Williams while Bryce Young sits at QB26, and the values the manager did find, mostly late-round receivers, were not enough to offset the early-round missteps. There is no obvious lever left to pull. This one was likely decided in the draft room.

Metaxa07 sits 10th in the Bad Dudes division and in just the 21st percentile of the field, and the roster gives very little reason to argue with either number. Christian McCaffrey at RB3 is a genuine weapon, and Harold Fannin at TE6 adds real upside, but the supporting cast drops off quickly and painfully. Rhamondre Stevenson projects as the weakest starter on the board at RB31, and the draft process did almost nothing to create separation, producing zero steals and zero values across 20 picks. What it did produce was 13 chalk selections and a major reach on Tory Horton, taken nearly five rounds ahead of his ADP to land a WR93. Horton is not the kind of gamble that changes a team's ceiling; he is the kind that confirms there were no better options available. McCaffrey and Fannin are real, but two players cannot carry a squad that graded out this flat from top to bottom, and with no obvious lever left to pull, Metaxa07 looks headed for a long, quiet autumn.

mburnsco drafted like someone who read every cheat sheet, circled every value, and still walked out of the room holding a bag full of question marks. Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 is a genuine anchor, and the draft board cooperated, sliding him four picks past his ADP. But after Smith-Njigba, the projected starters are a collection of high-variance pass-catchers, Christian Watson, Alec Pierce, Quentin Johnston, Xavier Worthy, none of whom projects better than WR28, and most of whom have spent their careers auditioning for reliability without ever quite landing the role. KC Concepcion adds another layer of uncertainty: a promising talent dropped into Cleveland, where quarterback remains an unsolved equation and receiver upside has historically evaporated on contact. The tight end situation offers no relief, with Terrance Ferguson projecting as a TE28. Twelve chalk picks, only one steal, and the team still sits at 25th percentile. mburnsco did not beat the market, and the market did not beat mburnsco. They just arrived at the same mediocre destination together.

Nebilizer did almost everything right at the draft table and still landed in the bottom quarter of the field, which is the kind of outcome that makes a person stare at a spreadsheet at 2 a.m. wondering where it all went wrong. The draft was disciplined: sixteen picks classified as chalk or better, zero major reaches, and genuine value at spots like Tyler Warren and Brenton Strange at the TE position. And yet the projections have this team sitting eighth in the Bad Dudes division. The problem is not process, it is ceiling. The starting group leans on a cluster of receivers ranked WR14 through WR16 in DeVonta Smith, Tetairoa McMillan, and Zay Jones, none of whom project as a weekly difference-maker at the top of the field. Smith is genuinely interesting, finally stepping out of A.J. Brown's shadow in Philadelphia, but "interesting" is not the same as "elite." The quarterback situation offers no cover. The value picks were real. The sum of those picks just was not enough.

NASDAQ sits seventh in the Bad Dudes division and barely cracks the 40th percentile of the field, and the draft log does not offer much reason for optimism. The roster has real talent at the top, Lamar Jackson at QB3, De'Von Achane at RB6, and Kenneth Walker III at RB10 are legitimate anchors, but the construction around them is where things get shaky. Four major reaches in a single draft is a lot of capital spent chasing upside that the market had already priced lower for a reason, and the late-round fliers on Dylan Sampson, Mike Washington Jr., and Jaylen Wright each came off the board three to five rounds ahead of consensus. Meanwhile, the one genuine steal of the draft, RJ Harvey at RB28, is also the weakest projected starter on the roster, which says something about the margin for error here. Coming off a 2025 campaign that finished in the second percentile in scoring, NASDAQ needed a draft that bought insurance. This one bought lottery tickets instead.

jakebob10 lands at 62nd percentile, which sounds modest until you look at how the roster was actually built. The backbone is a pair of elite projected starters who cost almost nothing extra to acquire: Jonathan Taylor, a projected RB4, slid nearly a full round past his ADP and landed in jakebob10's lap at 2.09, and the Bo Nix and Jaylen Waddle stack adds a coordinated bonus that quietly boosts the floor on both players. Nix slots in as a QB15 projection, which is fine, but Waddle at WR23 is the real prize of that pairing, taken just under a round early at 4.09 and worth every bit of the slight premium. The draft skewed toward chalk, which is not a knock, because chalk means getting what you paid for, and jakebob10 mostly did, with one legitimate steal headlining the board. The Cooper Kupp reach at 14.09 against an ADP of 19.09 is the one move that raises an eyebrow, but a five-round reach at the back of the draft does not undo what was built up top.

Farquadfantasy built something real here, and the draft log is going to confuse people. Four major reaches, one steal, the board lighting up red in spots, and yet the finished roster sits at the 62nd percentile with a starting core anchored by Ja'Marr Chase (WR2) and Drake London (WR7) at the top and a Matthew Stafford (QB14) / Davante Adams (WR25) stack running underneath it. The reaches that will get the most raised eyebrows are Deshaun Watson (QB34), pulled nearly six rounds early, and Josh Jacobs (RB16), grabbed a round and a half before consensus said to. Watson looks like a dart thrown in the dark. Jacobs, though, is projected as a starter and lands at RB16, which means the reach cost real draft capital but delivered a real player. That is the pattern here: not every conviction paid off, but enough of them did that the roster looks better than the process deserves. Last year's 75-percent win rate suggests Farquadfantasy knows how to push chips in. Whether 2026 validates the bold calls or exposes them is the only question left.

SalParadise22 did not build this roster with one flashy moment. They built it by consistently being right. The wide receiver group alone makes a case: Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4), CeeDee Lamb (WR5), Malik Nabers (WR12), and Rashee Rice (WR13) are all projected starters, and that is before you get to Tee Higgins (WR19) and Terry McLaurin (WR24). Henderson (RB19) arriving a full round after his ADP, and Higgins falling 1.3 rounds past his, are the kind of quiet wins that separate a good draft from a great one. Speaking of quiet, Rice carries real noise around him, with a knee procedure pushing him toward a late start and an off-field situation that has become genuinely hard to track, but when he is active and healthy he remains a WR13-caliber difference maker, and SalParadise22 has enough depth behind him that the chaos is manageable. The result is a team sitting at the 72nd percentile with a starting group that punches well above that number.

NY_trainXpress enters 2026 sitting at 78th percentile and third in the division, and the clearest explanation is a draft that simply kept winning small. Not one pick cracked the steal threshold, but Jalen Hurts landed a full round past his ADP and Brock Purdy slipped more than a round, giving this roster two legitimate QB options without paying premium prices for either. The most consequential question mark on the roster is George Kittle, a TE9 projection who spent part of 2025 on the mend and then tore his Achilles in the NFL playoffs. Kittle has said publicly he expects to be ready for Week 1, but that surgery has a way of humbling timelines, and his real value only materializes if healthy. The upside case here is built around Brock Bowers at TE1, Nico Collins at WR9, and George Pickens at WR10 forming a core that would be the envy of most rosters in this field, and a drafting process disciplined enough to build it without a single major reach attached to the bill.

GeeeeZeeeee didn't build this roster with one flashy pick. They built it by winning almost every exchange. James Cook fell nearly a full round past his ADP before this team scooped him up at RB5. Kyren Williams slid another round further than he should have and landed at RB15. Even Marvin Harrison Jr., still carrying question marks around the quarterback situation in Arizona and some injury history from last season, came off the board a round late at WR33, giving GeeeeZeeeee the upside without the premium price. Add a Jordan Love and Tucker Kraft stack that creates natural scoring correlations, and the foundation here is quietly excellent. The weakest projected starter in the lineup is Tony Pollard at RB30, which is the kind of floor that most managers would envy. Three values, thirteen chalk picks, and a 78th percentile tournament ranking tell the same story: this is a team that did the work before draft day and cashed in when the board cooperated.

Team Uncivilized did not stumble into a 99th percentile roster. This is a draft built on patience and board awareness, with six good values and a steal anchoring a lineup that has almost nothing to apologize for. That steal is Puka Nacua, projected WR1 and taken at 1.09 when the board slid him nearly a full round past his ADP, a quiet moment in the draft room that quietly won the tournament. The discipline extended into the middle rounds, where Breece Hall (RB14), Travis Etienne (RB18), and Justin Jefferson (WR6) all fell past their ADPs and landed on this roster like they were expected. Jefferson's situation deserves the extra attention: his 2025 struggles tracked closely with JJ McCarthy's failures, and with Kyler Murray now in Minnesota and stacked here alongside Jefferson, the upside on that WR6 projection may be conservative. The weakest projected starter is Chigoziem Okonkwo at TE19, and even that feels like a minor footnote. This is what a clean SFB draft looks like.
