Dammons Anvil finished 5-31 last season and scored in the 4th percentile, and nothing about this draft suggests the trajectory is changing. The clearest summary of how this went: three major reaches across 17 rounds, zero steals, and a 2026 projection that lands dead last in the Baldurs Gate 3 division and in the 3rd percentile of the entire field. Taking Malik Nabers at 2.12 when the market said 3.11 is a forgivable sin on its own, but then burning a 15th-round pick on Rashod Bateman (WR92) and a 17th-rounder on Christian Kirk (WR100) when both were available five-plus rounds later is how you build a roster that looks busy without actually getting better. The one bright spot, Bijan Robinson (RB2), is real, and Chris Olave (WR11) and Nabers (WR12) give the lineup a legitimate ceiling. But the engine room is Tyler Shough running a QB20 projection with Jacoby Brissett as the backup, and Kenneth Gainwell projects as the weakest starter on the roster at RB34. Dammons Anvil did not draft a contender. It drafted a wish list that the market had already priced out.

Withers' Walking Dead enters 2026 ranked 11th in the Baldurs Gate 3 division and sitting in just the 14th percentile of the field, and the uncomfortable truth is that the draft did almost nothing to improve the outlook. Christian McCaffrey, Saquon Barkley, Derrick Henry, Jeremiyah Love, and Josh Jacobs give this roster a genuinely impressive top tier, but after the top players the drop-off is steep, and the draft board tells a damning story: three major reaches, zero steals, and only two values across the entire haul. Barkley was pulled nearly a round early, T.J. Hockenson came off the board two and a half rounds before his ADP, and Deshaun Watson, a QB34, cost a 15th-round pick that could have bought almost anything more useful. The quarterback room sits at average on its best day, anchored by Brock Purdy at QB13 and Kyler Murray at QB19, neither of whom inspires confidence as a primary option. This roster drafts like a team that kept reaching for names instead of value, and 14th-percentile projections are the honest receipt.

There is no elegant way to dress up what PeoplezPen is working with in 2026. The roster grades out at the 17th percentile of the field and sits tenth in the Baldurs Gate 3 division, and the draft offers little comfort: not a single steal or value on the board, just fifteen chalk picks and three minor reaches that generated no surplus whatsoever. The best argument for this team is Drake Maye, a QB2 projection that is genuinely elite, paired with a Joe Burrow and Tee Higgins stack that at least gives the offense a coordinated pulse. But the projected starters behind that top tier thin out quickly. Tyler Warren grades as TE4, which is real, but Javonte Williams at RB17 and D'Andre Swift at RB24 are serviceable rather than scary, and by the time you reach Jayden Higgins as the projected weakest starter at WR54, the floor feels closer than the ceiling. Maye and the Burrow-Higgins connection are legitimate building blocks. They just need more building around them than this roster currently has to offer.

Last year's 80th-percentile finish has a way of making a roster look more formidable than it actually is, and Auntie Ethels Hut Hut is about to find out how far reputation travels. The 2026 version sits at the 19th percentile and ranks ninth in the Baldurs Gate 3 division, a gap wide enough to feel like a different team entirely. The wide receiver group is legitimately strong, with Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4), Garrett Wilson (WR17), and Ladd McConkey (WR20) all projected to start, and that depth is real. But the rest of the roster is working against that foundation. George Kittle (TE9) is the kind of upside play that can reshape a season, except that Achilles tear has his Week 1 availability genuinely in doubt, and a tight end projected TE9 who misses time quickly becomes a roster liability you cannot roster your way out of. Jonathan Taylor (RB4) provides a legitimate anchor, but the quarterbacks are a collective QB22-and-worse situation. The 2025 version of this team earned its finish. This one is going to have to prove it all over again.

Elves n' Dwarves sit at 30th percentile in the field and eighth in the Baldurs Gate 3 division, and the draft chart does not offer much reason for optimism. The roster leans heavily on Ja'Marr Chase, who grades out at WR2 and is genuinely elite, but after Chase the falloff is steep and unforgiving. Caleb Williams comes in at QB6 and pairs with Rome Odunze for a stack that at least makes sense on paper, but Odunze is projected WR30 and that stack is carrying more weight than it probably can. The bigger problem is at the margins: Kenneth Walker III, the team's most aggressive early investment at RB10, was reached on by nearly a full round, meaning the roster paid premium capital for a player who grades out as merely solid rather than elite. Jaylen Warren projects as the weakest projected starter at RB27, and with 13 chalk picks and zero steals, there is no hidden upside baked into this roster waiting to emerge. This team is what it is, and what it is looks like a long season.

House of Hope arrives in Baldurs Gate 3 carrying the reputation of an 80th-percentile scorer from 2025, which is a fine coat to wear into a tournament until people start looking at what's underneath it. The 2026 roster projects 40th percentile, a drop severe enough to suggest last year's finish was peak performance rather than floor. The draft didn't help close that gap. Bucky Irving, projected RB21, was taken 2.6 rounds ahead of his ADP, the kind of aggressive move that signals conviction but burns currency that could have bought depth or upside elsewhere. Thirteen chalk picks out of eighteen total selections tells you this manager drafted the board without finding an edge, and the one genuine value, Jared Goff at QB16, came on a position where Josh Allen already anchors the room. Drake London at WR7 and Omarion Hampton at RB9 give the roster a real ceiling, but a 40th-percentile projection suggests the supporting cast around them doesn't sustain it. The reputation says contender. The roster says wait and see.

AlexLauque sits at exactly the tournament's median, which is either a launching pad or a waiting room depending on how the margins break. The receiver group is the engine here: Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, Nico Collins at WR9, and Emeka Egbuka at WR18 give this roster a genuine top-end that most teams at this division rank cannot match. The problem is that the draft was almost entirely chalk, with just two values and one significant reach in AJ Barner at TE24, taken more than two rounds before his ADP suggested anyone else wanted him. That kind of roster is built on projections holding, not on hidden upside. If Smith-Njigba and Collins perform to rank, AlexLauque has enough to climb out of sixth. If either stumbles, the depth behind them ranges from solid to speculative, and Brenton Strange projecting as the weakest starter at TE17 does not inspire confidence that the floor holds. This is a team that wins a normal season and loses a weird one.

After finishing 2025 at the bottom of the entire field, scoring just 2921 points against a 1-35 record, MFlorio enters 2026 looking like a team that actually did its homework in the offseason. The foundation here is legitimately exciting: Lamar Jackson at QB3 and Brock Bowers at TE1 are the kind of projected anchors that paper over a lot of sins, and Jayden Daniels, grabbed a full round and change past his ADP, adds real upside at QB5. The running back group does the rest of the heavy lifting, with Chase Brown projected at RB11 and Travis Etienne at RB18 giving the roster a credible mid-tier core. The wide receiver group is the quietest part of the projection, with D.J. Moore at WR26 leading a unit that doesn't have a top-end name, but in a positionless format the stars elsewhere can compensate. Blake Corum, the roster's weakest projected starter at RB35 and the draft's one notable reach, is the soft spot to watch. Still, 57th percentile is a long way from 1st. The rebound is real.

All Gas No Avernus didn't win their draft with one headline move, they just kept coming out ahead on deal after deal, and that consistency is exactly why they belong in the conversation in the Baldurs Gate 3 division. The clearest example is Jaxson Dart, a QB11 projection taken at pick 7.12 when his ADP sat at 5.06, meaning the market handed him over nearly two and a half rounds late. Pair that with a receiving group headlined by CeeDee Lamb (WR5), Justin Jefferson (WR6), and George Pickens (WR10), all projected starters, and the top of this roster has genuine teeth. Pickens himself came as a minor gift, slipping nearly a full round past his ADP in Round 3. The team landed 17 chalk picks alongside those values, which sounds boring until you realize chalk means the market agreed those players were worth exactly what was paid, so there is no dead weight hiding in the back half of the roster. At 63rd percentile, All Gas No Avernus is a serious contender quietly dressed like a middle-of-the-pack team.

Mind Flayer Tush Push didn't build this roster with one seismic swing. They built it pick by pick, and the cumulative effect lands them at 87th percentile in the field and third in the Baldur's Gate 3 division before a single week is played. The foundation is legitimate: Trey McBride at TE2 and Tucker Kraft at TE5 were both drafted past their ADPs, with Kraft representing one of the better values in the entire draft, falling 1.3 rounds. Jalen Hurts, projected QB9, came at a similar discount, slipping nearly two rounds before Mind Flayer scooped him up, and his stack with DeVonta Smith at WR14 gives the team a connected scoring engine that can erupt on the same night. The Hurts situation deserves a closer look, though: five consecutive top-10 fantasy finishes are impressive, and 60 rushing touchdowns over that stretch explain most of it, but the offseason departure of AJ Brown to New England puts real pressure on his passing game in a way it simply hasn't faced before. This team earned its standing through discipline and value accumulation, not luck. It will need that same steadiness if Hurts has to prove something new.

Golden D20 did not win this draft on a handful of bold swings. They won it by being right, over and over, in the middle and late rounds. Justin Herbert at QB8 fell more than a round past his ADP and landed in round four. Kyle Pitts at TE7, Sam LaPorta at TE8, and Dalton Kincaid at TE11 each slid a full round or more, and Golden D20 was there every time to collect. That kind of draft is less like gambling and more like the house slowly raking in chips, quiet and relentless. The one real scar is Rashee Rice, a projected WR13 whose situation reads like a police blotter, a medical chart, and a soap opera running simultaneously. Off-field violations, a knee procedure, and a looming jail stint make him genuinely hard to count on, but if he plays he is a difference maker, which is exactly why this team sits second in the Baldurs Gate 3 division and in the 95th percentile of the field. Golden D20 built their floor sky-high and still has Rice as a ceiling-raiser if the chaos clears.

FootBhaal Spawn didn't try to be clever. They just kept coming out ahead, round after round, and the cumulative effect landed them in the 99th percentile of the field. The clearest example is the quarterback group: Trevor Lawrence at QB10 and Patrick Mahomes at QB12 both fell nearly two rounds past their ADPs, meaning this team collected a pair of legitimate starters at a discount while the rest of the room was pricing them correctly. That kind of efficiency compounds. Add Matthew Stafford at QB14 sliding two and a half rounds to round ten, and suddenly the team has three viable passers secured below market rate, with Stafford stacking directly alongside projected WR1 Puka Nacua for bonus upside. Courtland Sutton fell two full rounds to provide another projected starter at receiver depth that costs nothing in terms of lineup flexibility. Two major reaches in the late rounds keep this from being a perfect draft, but Jaydon Blue and MarShawn Lloyd are low-cost bets. The headline is consistency: this roster was built one quiet advantage at a time.
