There is no charitable read on what Hoen built here, and the draft log makes that impossible to hide. Six major reaches across the board tell the story: this was a draft run on impulse rather than board management, and the results are exactly what you would expect from that approach. Ashton Jeanty at RB7 anchors the roster, but Hoen reached 0.7 rounds for him at 2.01 and then kept reaching, taking Kyren Williams at 3.12 despite an ADP nearly two rounds later, David Montgomery at 6.01 when he should have waited until round eight, and Sean Tucker a staggering 5.6 rounds before his number was called. The problem is that Montgomery, who was increasingly a secondary option behind Jahmyr Gibbs in Detroit before departing for Houston, now projects as a battle for top billing against Woody Marks, a far cry from the reliable contributor Hoen apparently priced in. Meanwhile Rashee Rice at WR13 is the lone bright spot in a receiver group that drops to Michael Pittman at WR44. Third in the

division and in the third percentile of the field, this roster spent all its draft capital chasing the same position and still did not land enough to justify the cost.

There is no polite way to say this: jb7929 enters 2026 as one of the Angry Birds' weakest teams, sitting 11th in the division and in the 11th percentile of the field, and the roster does not hide that verdict well. The receiver group is the clearest culprit, a genuinely weak corps headlined by DK Metcalf at WR36 and propped up by Jerry Jeudy, Deebo Samuel, and Tyreek Hill, three names that once commanded respect and now project in the WR66-to-WR77 range. The backfield is more encouraging, with Saquon Barkley and Derrick Henry projecting as starters, though Barkley was the draft's one major reach, taken nearly a full round ahead of his ADP, which means jb7929 paid a premium to simply be average at that spot. What makes this situation genuinely grim is the draft offered almost no surplus to offset those costs: one steal across the entire board, against five reaches. The lever-pulling is done, the assets are locked in, and the projections say this roster is not good enough to climb.

There is no flattering spin available for BIGBABYWESH, so let's not pretend otherwise. The draft tells the whole story: zero steals, zero values, and six major reaches spread across 19 rounds, which is less a draft strategy than a slow-motion collapse of judgment. The most damaging pattern is the late-round hoarding of running backs nobody asked for at those prices, Jaylen Wright taken nearly seven rounds early, Kaelon Black taken more than seven rounds early, two picks that vaporized draft capital that could have shored up a receiver room that tops out at Mike Evans at WR27 and Chris Godwin at WR38. Meanwhile, the manager reached on Jeremiyah Love at 3.01 when the market said wait until the fifth round, surrendering a prime pick for a player ADP pegged more than a round later. Bijan Robinson at RB2 is a legitimate anchor, and Jayden Daniels projects as a QB5, but those two bright spots only make the surrounding carnage more visible. Sitting 10th in the Angry Birds division at the 14th

percentile, BIGBABYWESH drafted like someone convinced they saw something nobody else did, and the board simply did not agree.

GordonSquare enters 2026 sitting ninth in the Angry Birds division and in just the 39th percentile of the field, and the roster does not offer an obvious path out of that hole. The headliners are real: Lamar Jackson grades out as QB3, Joe Burrow as QB4, and the Burrow/Tee Higgins stack gives the team a legitimate anchor. But the draft log tells a cautionary tale. Burrow was taken nearly a round early, and the team burned additional capital reaching on Kenneth Gainwell, Zachariah Branch, and Ja'Kobi Lane, the last of whom went 3.5 rounds before his ADP. That is a lot of draft equity spent chasing upside that may not materialize. The one player with a genuine situation upgrade is Jaylen Waddle, who escapes Miami's dysfunction for Denver, where Bo Nix and a suddenly stocked receiver corps give him a real chance to outperform his WR23 projection. That might be the ceiling, though. When Waddle represents your margin for error, the season is already playing on hard mode.

jeremym815 played the value game almost perfectly and still landed at 46th percentile in the field, which is the kind of outcome that makes you question everything. Malik Nabers falling a full 1.5 rounds past his ADP at WR12 looks like a gift, except Nabers is coming off a torn ACL his new coach described as "not simple," and the open questions around his Week 1 availability and his chemistry with a new quarterback mean that value comes with an asterisk that has nothing to do with projected starter status. James Cook at RB5 was the cleanest win on the board, a genuine draft-night bargain that reads well on paper. But beneath Cook and Nabers, the roster softens quickly. Jaylen Warren projects as the weakest starter at RB27, and Bucky Irving, reached 2.6 rounds ahead of his ADP, was supposed to be the upside bet that justified the aggression. Instead Irving projects at RB21, a fine number that does not quite cover what jeremym815 gave up to get him. The value was real. The ceiling, somehow, is not.

Shirey31 sits at 47th percentile in the field, which is the fantasy equivalent of a shrug emoji rendered in human form, and yet that placement obscures a roster with genuine upside concentrated in a few key spots. Puka Nacua at WR1 and A.J. Brown at WR8 form the kind of top-end pairing that wins weeks outright, and the Brown situation in particular deserves attention: reunited with a young, ascending quarterback in Drake Maye after a move to New England, Brown's WR8 projection carries real boom potential if he stays healthy, something his injury history makes no guarantee. Dak Prescott at QB7 stabilizes the starting lineup, and TreVeyon Henderson at RB19 gives the manager a credible third pillar. Where this team gets uncomfortable is at the margins, with Juwan Johnson projected as the weakest starter at TE20 and two major reaches on the draft sheet in Emanuel Wilson and Christian Watson suggesting the manager overreached late when patience might have served better. Nothing here collapses the season. Nothing guarantees it either.

fishbag888 sits at the 49th percentile, and that number is almost too honest: this is a roster that will win the weeks it is supposed to win and lose the weeks it is supposed to lose, with the season decided in the handful of games where neither outcome is obvious. The engine here is a genuinely elite receiver corps, with Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and CeeDee Lamb at WR5 forming a top-line tandem that most teams in the Angry Birds division cannot match, and DeVonta Smith, Tetairoa McMillan, and Terry McLaurin extending that depth into the double-digit rounds. What muddies the picture is where the draft capital went elsewhere. Tank Bigsby and Ray Davis were both taken well ahead of their ADPs, Bigsby by more than three rounds and Davis by nearly five, and both project outside the top 50 at their position. In a format where the margins decide everything, that is precisely where margins get surrendered. Trevor Lawrence steadies the back end at QB10, but fishbag888 will live and die by whether those receivers can carry the weight the rest of the roster asks them to.

Tshadle didn't swing for the fences and miss, didn't reach for upside at the cost of the floor, just built a roster the quiet, disciplined way and landed in the 69th percentile with something to show for it. The crown jewel is Justin Jefferson, a WR6 projection that Tshadle secured at 2.05 while the rest of the field had Jefferson priced at 1.12, a full round of free equity baked in before the roster even takes shape. Pair that with Josh Allen sitting as a QB1 and a productive stack through D.J. Moore at WR26, and the team's ceiling games have real teeth. Kyler Murray stacking with Jefferson only deepens that upside. The draft itself was almost entirely chalk, 15 of 19 picks coming right on market value, which sounds boring until you realize it means Tshadle rarely gave anything away. The weakest projected starter is Quentin Johnston at WR41, which is a fine problem to have when the anchor of your lineup is projected as one of the best receivers in the field.

Karnage211 finished in the 82nd percentile last year and drafted an even cleaner roster in 2026, landing five values and a steal across the board while logging zero major reaches. The headliners are hard to argue with: Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Jonathan Taylor at RB4 form a backfield foundation that most managers would mortgage the future to hold, and Tyler Warren at TE4 and Harold Fannin at TE6 give Karnage211 a stranglehold at a position that routinely separates contenders from pretenders. The value story is what really elevates this preview, though. Nico Collins fell nearly a full round past his ADP and lands as a projected WR9 starter. Tyler Warren himself came nearly a round late at pick 4.03. Matthew Golden and Tank Dell were both acquired with round-plus cushions, adding real depth at minimal cost. Chuba Hubbard is the one minor reach on the sheet, and even that is a forgivable sin when the rest of the board looks this tidy. Fourth in the Angry Birds division is where the projections slot Karnage211, but the 79th percentile tournament standing says this roster is built to climb.

DellyFF enters 2026 sitting at 87th percentile in the field and third in the Angry Birds division, and the draft record tells you exactly how they got there: 14 chalk picks and three genuine values, zero major reaches, a roster built on discipline rather than drama. The foundation is Ja'Marr Chase at WR2, as reliable an anchor as exists in this tournament, surrounded by a receiving group that runs four projected starters deep, with Garrett Wilson (WR17), Emeka Egbuka (WR18), and Carnell Tate (WR29) all in the mix. Where the draft revealed its sharper edge was in the later rounds. Jaxson Dart slid nearly two full rounds past his ADP and landed at QB11, a quarterback who projects as a genuine difference-maker acquired at a discount. Oronde Gadsden fell a similar distance and fills out the starter column at TE16. DellyFF did not swing for the fences and miss, they just kept finding favorable prices while the rest of the room looked elsewhere. Coming off a 21-15 season at 81st percentile in scoring, this is a roster with the consistency to go further.

apulianas didn't win the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl draft in a single moment. They won it in four quiet ones. Justin Herbert slid a full round past his ADP to land at 4.09, Chris Olave fell a round and a half before apulianas grabbed him at 5.04, and Jared Goff and Colston Loveland each arrived a round late into waiting hands. That's the story of this roster: consistent, patient accumulation that left the manager sitting at 88th percentile in the field with a starting lineup featuring a projected WR10 in George Pickens, a WR11 in Olave, and a TE3 in Loveland alongside projected starter Mark Andrews at TE14. The 2025 season, a 75 percent win rate and 90th percentile scoring, suggests this isn't a fluke approach either. There's a late-round Rashod Bateman reach that raised an eyebrow, but one swing at a dart in the 15th round doesn't change the character of a draft this steady. apulianas belongs in the Angry Birds conversation, and the board basically handed them the reason why.

kfish55 sits atop the Angry Birds division and in the 94th percentile of the field, and the blueprint for how they got there is less about any single home run pick and more about a draft that quietly kept winning exchanges. Drake London, landing at WR7, was taken a full round after his ADP suggested he would be gone. Josh Jacobs, projected RB16, slid a round and a half past his number and kfish55 was right there waiting. Those are not flukes, that is a manager who knew their board and stayed patient while others reached. The foundation underneath those values is real: Brock Bowers projects as TE1, De'Von Achane as RB6, and the starting group holds together across the board. The one question worth watching is Wan'Dale Robinson, who reunited with Brian Daboll in Tennessee and crossed 1,000 yards last season but now faces a fresh target competition with the Titans drafting Carnell Tate fourth overall. Robinson is not a fatal flaw at WR47, but he is the one spot where the margin tightens. Everything else earned its ranking.
