GCLNYC enters 2026 sitting seventh percentile in the field, dead last in the Candy Crush division, and the roster tells you exactly why. The receiving corps is the soft underbelly of this team, with Davante Adams projected at WR25 and Parker Washington at WR35 leading a group that grades out weak as a unit. That is a brutal ceiling in a positionless format where top-end pass catchers function as the engine of elite rosters. Jonathan Taylor at RB4 and Chase Brown at RB11 are genuinely good players, but the draft did those strengths no favors: Dak Prescott arrived a full round and a half early at pick 2.03, and Kaytron Allen was yanked nearly four rounds ahead of his ADP, burns of draft capital that could have shored up the receiver group instead. When the most exciting thing you can say about a team is that Jake Ferguson fell a round and a half in the ninth, you are not previewing a contender. You are writing a eulogy.

LtTatertot is sitting at 11th in the Candy Crush division and the 16th percentile of the field, and the roster does not offer much reason for optimism. The top end is real enough: Ja'Marr Chase projects as WR2, Kenneth Walker III slots in at RB10, and Travis Kelce grades as TE10. But this is a format where depth matters, and the names behind those headliners fall off fast. The draft did nothing to help the cause, producing zero steals, two minor reaches, and two major ones, including Elijah Sarratt at WR98 taken five full rounds before his ADP. Then there is Cam Ward, projected at QB23 and tapped as a starter despite stepping into a Tennessee offense that now has legitimate weapons around him, which sounds encouraging until you remember that added pressure cuts both ways for a player still finding his footing. Chase and Walker can carry a week, but they cannot carry a season. LtTatertot is not rebuilding. They are simply hoping the floor does not get any lower.

There is no charitable read on billwisor's 2026 Scott Fish Bowl roster, and the draft board confirms it: zero steals, zero values, and four major reaches in a single draft is not bad luck, it is a philosophy, and a losing one. The Mac Jones reach alone, pulled 7.3 rounds ahead of his ADP to land a QB39, is the kind of decision that haunts a manager for the full season. The Joe Burrow and Tee Higgins stack gives the lineup a genuine floor, and the receiver cluster around Tee Higgins, Luther Burden, Jaylen Waddle, and Terry McLaurin projects respectably, but Burden was already a reach at 1.3 rounds early, so even the good news arrives asterisked. Down at the RB tier, the projected starters are David Montgomery at RB23 and Chuba Hubbard at RB29, which is serviceable until you remember billwisor also spent real capital on Christian Kirk at WR100, taken five full rounds before his ADP. The result is a team sitting 10th in the Candy Crush division and in just the 17th percentile of the field, which is not a projection so much as a receipt.

SieversGras enters 2026 sitting ninth in the Candy Crush division and projected at just the 23rd percentile tournament-wide, and nothing about this roster suggests a dramatic reversal is coming. The receiving corps has real names at the top, Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4) and DeVonta Smith (WR14) project as genuine contributors, and the Goff/St. Brown stack adds a layer of ceiling that most teams at this percentile cannot claim. But Jared Goff is precisely what he is: a reliable QB16 who does not lose games, but does not win championships either. The draft did nothing to change the trajectory, producing zero steals and zero values against thirteen chalk selections and two major reaches, including Kimani Vidal taken nearly four rounds before his ADP. With De'Von Achane (RB6) as the backfield anchor, the floor exists, but Jaylen Warren projecting as the weakest starter is a persistent drag, and a 2025 campaign that finished at the 45th percentile in scoring left no goodwill to spend. The levers have been pulled. The results look familiar.

DrBuccafusca sits at 31st percentile entering 2026, and nothing about this roster suggests the elevator is heading up. The foundation looks promising at first glance, with Jahmyr Gibbs projecting as the RB1 and Ashton Jeanty close behind at RB7, but the supporting cast falls apart fast. The receiver group is genuinely thin where it counts, with Carnell Tate (WR29) and Quentin Johnston (WR41) projected as the starters, and neither inspires much confidence as weekly difference-makers. Then there is Josh Jacobs, projected RB16 and taken a round early, who now arrives carrying an offseason arrest stemming from a domestic violence situation, the details of which remain unresolved and the fantasy implications of which are very much alive. Jayden Daniels projects as a QB5, which is legitimate value, but quarterback upside has a ceiling in how far it can carry a squad this lopsided. Coming off a 9-27 season that landed in the 23rd percentile of scoring, DrBuccafusca looks less like a team on the rise and more like one still searching for the first rung of the ladder.

dariusbelton sits at 51st percentile heading into 2026, which is the fantasy equivalent of a shrug emoji rendered in flesh and blood. The floor is real: Bijan Robinson at RB2 and James Cook at RB5 give this roster a backfield core that most managers would trade their left arm for, and Cook arriving as genuine value after falling nearly a full round past his ADP suggests Belton was paying attention at the draft table. The ceiling, though, has some cracks. Four major reaches, including Marvin Harrison Jr. pulled nearly three rounds early and Tank Dell grabbed almost four rounds ahead of consensus, mean Belton burned capital on optimism rather than equity. If Harrison and Dell perform to their RB36 and WR74 projections respectively, those picks look fine in hindsight. If they don't, the margin for error on a roster sitting seventh in the Candy Crush division evaporates fast. Robinson and Cook can carry a lot of weight. The question is whether they have to carry all of it.

TripPlayFantasy came into this draft swinging early and often, and the board will tell you they overreached three times in significant fashion. The roster will tell you to pipe down. Justin Jefferson at WR6 landed a full round after his ADP, which is the kind of gift that covers a lot of sins, and pairing him with Trey McBride at TE2 and Omarion Hampton at RB9 gives this team a genuine top-end that most managers in the Candy Crush division would trade for without blinking. Now, about those sins: Kyle Monangai was grabbed 2.3 rounds early, Sean Tucker nearly four rounds early, and Jauan Jennings over two rounds ahead of schedule. None of those three project as stars. But in a positionless format, depth picks exist to shore up the back of the lineup, and if even one of those reaches blooms into something real, TripPlayFantasy's 55th-percentile projection starts looking conservative. Last season's 64-percent win rate says this manager knows how to build a roster that plays. Whether the reaches were conviction or coin flips, Jefferson and McBride make the argument easier to win.

QuintonLeo didn't need a lottery ticket to build a contender in the Candy Crush division, just a steady hand and the discipline to let the board come to them. The foundation is genuinely elite: Josh Allen at QB1 and Tyler Warren at TE4 give this roster a pair of projected top-five anchors before the rest of the pieces even matter. What elevates the profile, though, is how consistently the middle rounds delivered. Cam Skattebo fell a full round and a half past his ADP before QuintonLeo scooped him up, and Khalil Shakir slid nearly two rounds before getting claimed as well. Four values against zero major reaches across the entire draft is the kind of quiet, disciplined ledger that doesn't generate highlight clips but does generate wins. The 2025 campaign at 48th percentile in scoring left real room for improvement, and a roster sitting at 76th percentile in the field suggests the upside is now there to cash in on it. This isn't a flashy team. It's a well-built one.

BrettorVision is what happens when a manager trusts the board and lets value come to them. The foundation is unimpeachable: Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and CeeDee Lamb at WR5 give this roster two of the cleanest weekly producers in the tournament, and Lamb arriving at pick 2.05 when his ADP sat at 1.11 is the kind of half-round gift that compounds over a full season. The tight end group is where the draft gets genuinely special. Tucker Kraft, Harold Fannin, and George Kittle project as TE5, TE6, and TE9 respectively, and Fannin fell more than a full round past his ADP to boot. Yes, Kittle's Achilles recovery carries real uncertainty heading into Week 1, but a manager with TE5 and TE6 already locked in can afford to let that situation breathe. One minor reach on Jalen Coker is barely worth circling in red. Sitting 80th percentile in the field with a draft that shows 15 chalk calls and almost zero panic, BrettorVision looks like a team that knew exactly what it was doing.

timmymr landed in the 86th percentile of the field and sits third in the division, and the draft sheet tells you exactly why: disciplined, patient, and almost surgically clean. The anchor here is Brock Bowers at TE1, a positional advantage that compounds every week, paired with a projected starting corps that includes A.J. Brown at WR8, Saquon Barkley at RB8, and Patrick Mahomes, who, if his ahead-of-schedule ACL recovery holds, slots in as QB12 and turns this roster from very good into something genuinely dangerous. Where timmymr really separated himself was in the mid-rounds, where Jordan Love fell two full rounds past his ADP to land at QB17, and Jameson Williams came in as a projected starter at WR21 with room to climb. Against two major reaches on the whole board and zero, timmymr posted six steals or values. The weakest projected starter is Jayden Reed at WR48, and even that feels like a quibble. This roster was built with the kind of conviction that does not need luck to bail it out.

Ravens Super Bowl didn't build this roster on one flashy gamble. They built it pick by pick, and the ledger shows it: four values, fifteen chalk, and not a single major reach across the whole board. The foundation is Lamar Jackson, a QB3 projection landed slightly past his ADP, which in a competitive field counts as a quiet win. The receiver group is where the consistency compounds. Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, George Pickens at WR10, and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 all project as starters, and all three arrived at or near fair value, no desperation spending required. Jaxson Dart at QB11 slid a full round past his ADP and gives the roster a genuinely useful depth piece. The weakest projected starter is Jadarian Price at RB26, which is a fine problem to have. That 2025 track record, 69 percent wins and 75th-percentile scoring, suggests this manager knows how to turn a well-constructed roster into actual results. Sitting second in the Candy Crush division at the 86th tournament percentile, Ravens Super

Bowl looks like a team that did the boring things right, which is usually how you end up with something that isn't boring at all.

salamancaaa sits atop the Candy Crush division and in the 88th percentile of the field, and the draft sheet explains exactly why: no flashy gambles, just a consistent pattern of coming out ahead. The receiver group is the engine here, with Puka Nacua (WR1), Nico Collins (WR9), Emeka Egbuka (WR18), and D.J. Moore (WR26) all projecting as starters, and the value pick that quietly stands out is Colston Loveland (TE3), nabbed at pick 3.04 when his ADP suggested he'd be gone almost a full round earlier. The Baker Mayfield situation deserves honest acknowledgment: he stumbled to a QB18 finish in 2025 after a top-five season in 2024, Mike Evans is gone, and consensus projections are skeptical he rebounds. But Egbuka is in the building as a legitimate target, and the Mayfield-Egbuka stack at least gives salamancaaa a built-in upside lever if that skepticism turns out to be wrong. This roster did not need a miracle swing to be dangerous. It just needed a competent draft, and that is precisely what it got.
