performances last year hovering around mediocrity and critical gambits on players like Courtland Sutton and Deebo Samuel, DezDeuce faces an uphill battle to claw their way out of the trenches and vie for prominence in their division.

Jalen Royals suggest a potential unraveling of team strategy. With the comfort of stack bonuses offering only cold comfort, the road ahead seems fraught with challenges, and BestBallBruni's hopes hang by a thread as they begin what promises to be a grueling season.
