Last year, whodatspain was untouchable, a 27-9 machine that scored in the 100th percentile and made the whole tournament look slow. The 2026 version is something else entirely, sitting at the 5th percentile of the field and dead last in the Mario Kart 64 division, and the gap between those two realities is genuinely hard to look at. The backfield is legitimate, Kenneth Walker III, Jeremiyah Love, Josh Jacobs, and Bucky Irving all projecting as starters and covering themselves in enough projected value to carry real weeks. But the receiving corps is where the dream dissolves, Jalen Coker at WR55, Tyreek Hill at WR77, Calvin Ridley at WR78, a trio that reads less like a receiving group and more like a closing argument. The draft did not help the cause, producing no steals, six minor reaches, and two major ones, including Justin Fields taken a stunning 6.3 rounds ahead of his ADP. For a team that once looked like it could win everything, this projection does not feel like a rebuild so much as a reckoning.

There is not much to feel good about in the Mario Kart 64 division if you are rooting for Reservoir Dogs. Sitting 11th in the division and in just the 9th percentile of the field, this roster is in a difficult spot, and the draft choices that built it do not offer much comfort. The two most consequential misses were at quarterback, where Bo Nix cost the team 3.4 rounds of draft capital over his QB15 projection, and Bryce Young cost an almost unfathomable 4.8 rounds over his QB26 projection. Those are the projected starters. Burning premium picks on the two weakest spots on the roster is a brutal way to construct a team. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 gives the Dogs a legitimate anchor, and Luther Burden arrives with real momentum after a strong finish to 2025 and Ben Johnson comparing him to Amon-Ra St. Brown, but even a Burden breakout season papers over only so much. When your quarterback situation grades out this poorly and you overpaid to get there, the ceiling drops fast.

VollDamm72 finished 6-30 last season and ranked in the 13th percentile in scoring, and the 2026 projection offers almost no reason to expect a reversal. The roster grades at the 12th percentile in the tournament and sits 10th in the Mario Kart 64 division, and the draft did nothing to change the math. The most glaring problem is the quarterback situation, where the manager burned a third-round pick on Jared Goff, a QB16, and a sixth-round pick on C.J. Stroud, a QB22, reaching a combined six rounds ahead of consensus on two passers who grade out as middling starters at best. Those are the kinds of decisions that haunt a roster all season because there is no later-round fix for early-round misjudgments. Jonathan Taylor at RB4 and Brock Bowers at TE1 give this team a legitimate foundation, but two elite anchors can only carry so much when the rest of the projected starters hover around replacement level. There is no obvious lever left to pull, and the standings look like they already know it.

Pakkum drafted like someone who actually reads the room, waiting out the market and collecting receiver after receiver at prices nobody else wanted to pay. Terry McLaurin fell two full rounds past his ADP before Pakkum scooped him at WR24. Michael Pittman and Josh Downs each slid more than two rounds before landing here too. The patience was real and the execution was disciplined. So why does a team sitting ninth in the Mario Kart 64 division and projecting to the 27th percentile feel like the punchline to a joke about doing everything right? Because value only converts when the players are good enough, and this roster is stacked with WR23s and WR44s and WR46s while Joe Burrow at QB4 is the lone unambiguous star anchoring the whole enterprise. The Burrow-Tee Higgins stack provides a genuine ceiling, but below that tier the depth reads less like an asset and more like a collection of reasonable guesses that never quite resolved into a contender. Pakkum played the percentages. The percentages shrugged.

Alexpf08 enters 2026 sitting eighth in the Mario Kart 64 division and hovering around the 30th percentile of the field, and the draft did little to change the trajectory. The most glaring self-inflicted wound is at quarterback, where Baker Mayfield was taken nearly three full rounds ahead of his ADP and grades out as only QB18, a price that would sting for a locked-in starter and stings worse given that Malik Willis, a QB24, is also projected to start. You are reaching early and starting late, which is not a strategy so much as a trap. The saving grace is a backfield headlined by Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7, genuine difference-makers who keep the floor from completely caving in. But in a positionless format where scoring volume is everything, leaning on Robinson and Jeanty to carry a quarterback situation this thin is like asking two people to bail out a boat with one bucket between them. Last season's 50th-percentile finish feels, in hindsight, like the ceiling rather than the floor.

Dimoni Scuat enters 2026 sitting seventh in the Mario Kart 64 division and at just the 36th tournament percentile, and there is not much in the draft record to suggest a turnaround is coming. The draft was a parade of reaches, six of them major, including Brock Purdy pulled more than two rounds ahead of his ADP and Malachi Fields taken nearly seven rounds early, a pair of decisions that cannibalized the capital needed to build depth behind a thin top line. Purdy projects as QB13 and arrives already banged up after a turf toe injury last season, and the weapons around him are a mess: George Kittle is recovering from a torn Achilles, Ricky Pearsall's availability is reportedly in question, and the receiving room is otherwise so battered that the 49ers had to sign Mike Evans just to paper over the cracks. Purdy could still pay off the early price, but a manager who reached that aggressively throughout the draft is essentially betting everything on projections breaking just right, and at 36th percentile, the math says that is not the way to bet.

End Zone is the kind of team that lives and dies by the margins, and the draft reflects exactly that tension. The foundation is genuinely strong: Josh Allen at QB1 anchors the roster, and Malik Nabers at WR12 was taken at 5.01 after slipping nearly a round and a half past his ADP, a quiet win that gives this lineup real upside. The problem is that the draft board also shows Patrick Mahomes taken at 2.12 despite an ADP of 5.08, a reach of nearly three rounds for a player still working back from a torn ACL and LCL suffered late in 2025. The optimistic read is that Mahomes is reportedly ahead of schedule and could be a monster value if he suits up Week 1. The pessimistic read is that a second-round pick on an uncertain commodity, paired with reaches on Jerry Jeudy and Kenyon Sadiq, left this roster thin where it needed depth. Sitting sixth in the Mario Kart 64 division and 41st percentile overall, End Zone is not losing on talent at the top. It is losing on the bets that did not pay off.

Maresme Hotwings didn't need a flashy draft to build something real. The foundation is Christian McCaffrey (RB3) and De'Von Achane (RB6), a pair of projected starters who give this team a top-end floor most managers would envy, and Achane arriving at pick 3.09 against a 2.07 ADP means the Hotwings got one of the field's better backs at a meaningful discount. That kind of patient accumulation runs through the whole board: DeVonta Smith (WR14) slipped to pick 6.04 despite a 4.03 ADP, and Brian Thomas Jr. (WR31) fell more than two full rounds before Maresme grabbed him at 9.09. Seven players came in at or better than their ADP against only two major reaches, and those reaches were concentrated at quarterback, where Dak Prescott (QB7) and Jordan Love (QB17) cost real draft capital to secure. That's the one spot where the draft got impatient. Everywhere else, the Hotwings simply waited and collected, and 63rd percentile teams built this way tend to be sturdier than their rank suggests.

Sospechosos Habituales drafted like a team that trusted its own board more than the room's, and the finished roster makes it hard to argue with the results. Three major reaches dot the draft sheet, including Fernando Mendoza (QB27) going 3.3 rounds early and David Njoku (TE29) disappearing off the board 4.3 rounds before consensus said he should. Those are the kinds of picks that get a manager chirped in the recap thread. But flip to the other side of the ledger and Justin Jefferson (WR6) fell nearly a full round into their lap, Chris Olave (WR11) slid almost another, and Chigoziem Okonkwo (TE19) came 1.7 rounds late. The conviction plays and the value plays stacked on top of each other, which is how you end up at the 65th percentile of the field with Jahmyr Gibbs (RB1) and Bhayshul Tuten (RB25) in the same backfield group, Tuten now in a Jacksonville situation where Travis Etienne is gone and the job is genuinely open. Was this shrewd roster building or a manager who kept getting lucky in both directions? Probably some of both, which is fine. Both cash the same check.

The Golden Ducks sit third in the Mario Kart 64 division and in the 71st percentile of the field, and the draft record tells you exactly why: eight values, eight chalk, and almost nothing that blew up in their face. That kind of consistency is rare, and it compounds. Trey McBride at TE2, Tucker Kraft at TE5, and Harold Fannin at TE6 are the headliners, but what makes this roster hum is how those pieces were acquired. Fannin fell a full round and a quarter past his ADP when Golden Ducks grabbed him at 6.06. Travis Kelce slid more than a round and landed at 8.06. Dallas Goedert fell a round and change to 10.06. Those aren't flukes; that's a manager who stayed patient while others panicked and kept coming out ahead pick after pick. The two quarterback reaches on Matthew Stafford and Aaron Rodgers are real, and they stand out precisely because everything else looks so clean. When your main criticism is the quarterback room, you built something worth watching.

Koopa King's Krushers sit at 96th percentile in the field and second in the Mario Kart 64 division, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. The manager opened by taking Lamar Jackson (QB3) and Caleb Williams (QB6) ahead of their ADPs, two reaches that look aggressive on paper but make a lot more sense when you see what happened everywhere else on the board. Garrett Wilson (WR17) slipped nearly three rounds past his ADP and landed here. Tyler Warren (TE4) fell over a round and landed here. Omarion Hampton (RB9) dropped more than two rounds and, again, landed here. That is not luck across three positions, that is a manager who knew where the board was soft and stayed patient until it opened up. Ladd McConkey (WR20) and Drake London (WR7) both came in as good value picks as well, giving the starting lineup a foundation that almost any honest observer would tip their cap to. Marvin Harrison Jr. (WR33) carries real uncertainty given his injury history and Arizona's unsettled quarterback situation, but at WR33 the price already reflects the risk. This roster was built with discipline, and it shows.

The Toad Gurley's didn't win their division by accident, and at 97th percentile in the tournament, they didn't get lucky either. This roster was built the same way a good meal gets made: no single flashy ingredient, just competent decisions stacked on top of each other. Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 were both taken after their ADPs had already passed, meaning the manager collected two of the best receivers in the field at a discount before the third round arrived. Then came the real craftwork: Colston Loveland, projected TE3, fell a full 1.6 rounds past his ADP and landed at 4.03, and Oronde Gadsden at TE16 dropped 2.3 rounds to round eleven. Five values, two steals, and a division title last season that saw the team win 81 percent of its matchups. The Cam Ward and Mac Jones quarterback situation introduces genuine uncertainty, but a starting corps anchored by Smith-Njigba, St. Brown, and Loveland can absorb a lot of mediocrity at the position and still make noise.
