There is no diplomatic way to say this: macksteelers drafted like someone who had one eye on the board and the other somewhere else entirely. The centerpiece of this disaster is the QB situation, where Jordan Love landed at pick 1.07 despite projecting as QB17, a reach of nearly six rounds that would be defensible only if Love were an elite talent being snagged before the rush. He is not, and there was no rush. Then, as if to double down on the commitment to bad quarterback decisions, Aaron Rodgers materialized in round six at QB29, another seven-and-a-half-round reach on a player who projects to spend most of the season as a spectator on this roster. Two first-ten picks effectively buried in a position group that projects weak, while the rest of the draft followed the same logic: Pat Freiermuth snagged seven rounds early, Germie Bernard yanked off the board ten rounds before his ADP, Jaylen Warren taken six-plus rounds ahead of schedule. This is not a rebuilding team. This is a roster that confirms every bad decision in real time, sitting dead last in the Legend of Zelda division and at the 0th percentile of the field.

Seven major reaches in a single draft is not a strategy, it is a confession, and ZELDA TXAPELDUN's board tells you everything you need to know about how this team was built. The most damaging reach of the draft was Alvin Kamara, taken at 6.10 against an ADP of 16.03, a nine-round overpay for a RB50 projection that would have been sitting there untouched deep into the draft while better options evaporated. Then there is Brock Purdy, grabbed at 3.03 when a QB13 projection had no business consuming that kind of capital in a positionless format where quarterback scarcity barely exists. The result is a roster where the few legitimate pieces, Christian McCaffrey, George Kittle, and Sam LaPorta, are surrounded by the wreckage of compulsive early triggers. ZELDA TXAPELDUN sits 11th in the division and in the 1st percentile of the tournament field, which tracks perfectly with a 2025 campaign that finished 10th percentile in scoring. There is no reason to believe the draft that produced this roster has changed that trajectory.

There is no sugarcoating the situation in Kandor Politos's corner of the Legend of Zelda division: this roster grades out third from the bottom, and last year's 42-percent win rate and 32nd-percentile scoring suggest the 2026 outlook is not a correction waiting to happen but a continuation. The one area where the team projects to have genuine juice is at receiver, with CeeDee Lamb (WR5), George Pickens (WR10), and Davante Adams (WR25) forming a legitimate top-line group, but the draft decisions that built this thing undercut confidence in everything surrounding it. Fernando Mendoza came off the board at pick 5.01 against an ADP of 12.10, a reach of nearly eight full rounds on a QB27, which is the kind of swing that warps a draft and leaves the rest of the roster built around what was left over. When your most glaring reach is a player projected outside the top 25 at his position, there is no obvious lever left to pull, and Politos is heading into 2026 looking for answers that the roster simply does not have.

luiseviya drafted like someone who read every ADP chart twice and still walked out of the room holding the wrong bag. The value was real: Ladd McConkey fell more than three rounds before being snagged at 8.03, and Kyle Pitts dropped more than two rounds to land at 7.10, the kind of market inefficiencies that are supposed to compound into a competitive roster. And yet the projected finishes tell a colder story, with the team sitting ninth in the division and in the 42nd percentile of the field. The problem is not the process but the ceiling. Jaxon Smith-Njigba projects as WR3, which is an elite anchor, but then the lineup leans on Chuba Hubbard as its weakest projected starter at RB29, and Baker Mayfield, a three-and-a-half round reach at pick 4.03, is now tasked with holding together the quarterback situation alongside Jalen Hurts, who enters 2026 facing real questions about his passing after the offseason trade of A.J. Brown. luiseviya did the homework. The grade still came back a C.

moogito is a team that lives and dies by the gap between floor and ceiling being razor thin, and in the Scott Fish Bowl, razor thin is exactly where seasons go sideways. The core here is genuinely good: Nico Collins at WR9 was a value, sliding a full round past his ADP, and Trey McBride at TE2 gives this roster a positional edge that compounds quietly across a long tournament. Marvin Harrison Jr. at WR33 falling nearly two rounds past his ADP is the kind of secondary win that separates a well-drafted team from a lucky one. But moogito sits eighth in the division and at the 67th percentile, which means the cushion everyone assumes exists probably does not. David Montgomery, brought in to challenge for carries in Houston after his role in Detroit quietly eroded over the past season, is the avatar of this whole situation, a player whose ceiling is real but whose floor depends entirely on circumstances outside his manager's control. Get the coin flips, finish comfortably. Lose them, and 2025's 47 percent win rate starts looking less like a fluke.

The Titans of Argentown did not build this roster on one splashy pick. They built it by winning exchanges over and over, and the standings reflect it: 70th percentile in the field, seventh in the Legend of Zelda division, quietly worth watching. The foundation is real. Jahmyr Gibbs projects as RB1, and James Cook lands at RB5 after falling more than a round past his ADP, a gift the manager cashed in at 3.08. Tucker Kraft at TE5 came a round and a half late by the board's math. Those are not flukes, they are the product of a draft that logged eight good values and two outright steals across the board. The QB room carries some cost, with Dak Prescott and Jared Goff each taken noticeably earlier than consensus suggested, but both project as starters, and the damage is offset by the discipline shown everywhere else. This roster does not have a marquee moment to point to. It has a ledger that keeps coming out green.

Daovir did not build this roster on one thunderbolt moment. They built it pick by pick, round by round, and the ledger reflects it: six values and two steals scattered across the draft, a pattern of consistent execution that compounds quietly and pays loudly. Brock Bowers at TE1 is the anchor, and the fact that Daovir landed him half a round past his ADP is almost beside the point since the point is that they have him. The same discipline shows up at receiver, where DeVonta Smith at WR14, Zay Flowers at WR16, and D.J. Moore at WR26 were all taken after the field had assigned them elsewhere, each one a small transaction that individually looks like luck and collectively looks like a plan. Joe Burrow at QB4 cost a first-round pick, a minor reach by the numbers, but when Bowers is already on your roster and Smith and Flowers are lining up behind him, the math on Burrow gets friendlier. Sitting 90th percentile in the field heading into 2026, Daovir has not bet the house on anyone. They have just quietly acquired most of the furniture.

The Ganon Silverbacks didn't build this roster with one flashy move. They built it pick by pick, and the cumulative effect is a team sitting at the 93rd percentile of the field. The spine of it runs through the receiver group, where Justin Jefferson at WR6 arrived at 2.11 despite an ADP of 1.12, and Mike Evans at WR27 slid nearly two and a half rounds past his number before the Silverbacks quietly took him at 8.11. Add Puka Nacua at WR1 and Luther Burden at WR22, both projected starters, and this team has the kind of receiver depth that makes a positionless format sing. Harold Fannin at TE6 and Mark Andrews at TE14 were each taken nearly two rounds after their ADPs, extending a pattern that holds throughout the draft: the Silverbacks consistently let value come to them rather than chasing it. Matthew Stafford at QB14 was the one notable overpay, but with a Stafford-Nacua stack already baked in, it reads less like a mistake and more like conviction.

DiDu did not win the Scott Fish Bowl on a single bold swing. They won it, or close enough to it, by simply being right more often than everyone else. Landing at the 98th percentile of the field tells you the draft worked, and the receipts back that up: eight values across the board, a steal in Rashee Rice at WR13 taken two full rounds after her ADP, and a secondary tier of running backs, Kenneth Walker III at RB10 and Travis Etienne at RB18, both acquired well below market rate. The top end is legitimate, with Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and Malik Nabers at WR12 anchoring a starting group that would make most managers blush. The one blemish worth noting is RJ Harvey at RB28, whose path to volume in Denver looks increasingly crowded with Dobbins back and a new addition in the mix. That dampens an otherwise clean roster. Fourth in the Legend of Zelda division does not capture how good this team is. The rest of the field should be paying attention.

ChekyPatriots sits at 98th percentile in the field and third in the division, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. The headline is a pair of major values that would make any SFB manager's eyes light up: A.J. Brown fell nearly two full rounds past his ADP to land at 4.07, and Jaylen Waddle slid more than two rounds to arrive at 7.06. Both are projected starters, both are paired with Drake Maye in a stack that gives the offense a genuine ceiling, and both were essentially gifts from a field that apparently forgot about them. Beyond that headlining duo, the roster is stacked with good value from top to bottom, Jonathan Taylor at RB4 and De'Von Achane at RB6 among the projected starters setting a tone that carries all the way into the late rounds. The Maye reach in round one is the one move that invites second-guessing, but when the rest of the board looks this clean, one aggressive call at quarterback is a price worth paying.

raka18 is sitting at 99th percentile in the field, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. The value column reads like a highlight reel: Amon-Ra St. Brown, a projected WR4, slid nearly a full round past his ADP and landed at 2.09; Garrett Wilson fell almost three rounds to 7.04; Tyler Warren dropped a round and a half to give this team a projected TE4. That is not luck, that is a manager who came in with a board and the patience to trust it. The one blemish is Sam Darnold, reached 2.4 rounds early at 6.09, which makes him the weakest projected starter on the sheet. But when your skill position core includes St. Brown, Wilson, Josh Allen, and Warren all starting, Darnold's ceiling matters far less than his floor. Saquon Barkley carries real 2026 question marks, with the Eagles reportedly looking to protect him from the workloads that defined his peak, but this roster has enough proven production around him that a lighter Barkley is an inconvenience, not a crisis. Clean draft, legitimate ceiling, division rival better be ready.

SJO Broncos sit at the top of the Legend of Zelda division and in the 99th percentile of the entire field, and neither number is an accident. The blueprint here is straightforward: find value, accumulate talent, repeat. Cam Skattebo fell more than two full rounds past his ADP before landing at pick 9.05, giving this roster an RB20 at a serious discount. Drake London, Chris Olave, Jameson Williams, and Terry McLaurin all came in late relative to their ADPs, and every single one of them projects as a starter. That is not luck, that is discipline applied consistently across fifteen rounds. The one legitimate question mark is Caleb Williams, taken 0.8 rounds ahead of ADP at 2.08, which is the kind of reach that raises an eyebrow. But Williams projects as QB6, so if the price was slightly steep, the goods delivered. His backup situation is where things get genuinely interesting: Kyler Murray, coming off a Lisfranc injury that ended his Arizona tenure, now sits in a Vikings quarterback competition that most observers believe is already his to lose, making him a compelling QB19 dart with real upside.
