Furthermore, the gamble on Jacory Croskey-Merritt well ahead of his expected selection range may prove costly. Currently sitting at a precarious rank in both their

division and overall standings, DynastyCLE faces an uphill battle. It will take more than a few standout performances to climb the ranks and avoid languishing near the bottom.

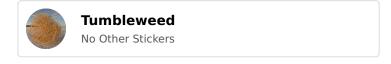
