The draft strategy saw moments of shrewdness with Alvin Kamara and Brian Robinson picked up at great value, yet these successes are overshadowed by significant overreaches, such as the premature selection of Isaac Guerendo and Ladd McConkey. With a division rank of 9 and in the 25th percentile



overall, lhartman916 seems poised for another uphill battle, trapped in the familiar cycle of unfulfilled potential and frustrating mediocrity.

Their insistence on snagging Jared Goff earlier than necessary, despite the minor stack advantage with Jameson Williams, suggests that strategic missteps may

plague their campaign. With a tournament percentile languishing in the 28th, it seems PCBrev is set for a season marked by uphill battles and potential disappointments.
