Bang Bang Niner Gang sits dead last in the Animal Crossing division, and the draft board explains exactly why. The defining move was David Njoku, a TE29 scooped nine full rounds before his ADP, which is the kind of swing that only makes sense if you genuinely believe everyone else in the room missed something, and they did not. That reach cascaded through the rest of the draft like a dropped tray in a cafeteria. The team burned a second-round pick on Brock Purdy, a QB13 taken 3.5 rounds early, then doubled down on Jared Goff, a QB16 taken 2.1 rounds early in the fourth, then tripled down on Fernando Mendoza, a QB27 taken 2.6 rounds early in the tenth. Six major reaches in a single draft is not a rounding error, it is a philosophy. Christian McCaffrey, projected RB3, gives this roster a genuine foundation, but one good player cannot paper over a draft strategy that consistently paid a premium to acquire players who were right there waiting.

There is pity, and then there is whatever you feel watching BoltzFanGirlie draft. The headline number is four major reaches, and two of them were at quarterback, which is a remarkable way to spend a third-round pick and a fifth-round pick in a positionless format where quarterback scarcity is not really a thing. Matthew Stafford at QB14 was gone by pick 3.11, nearly two and a half rounds before the board would have delivered him. Tyler Shough followed in round five, another 2.8 rounds ahead of schedule, and the charitable case for Shough, that he looked polished in year one and has real weapons around him in Chris Olave and Jordyn Tyson, still does not explain why anyone needed to sprint to the podium for a 27-year-old with a ceiling question attached to his name. Meanwhile, Keaton Mitchell went four rounds early and lands as the projected weakest starter on the roster. Four major reaches, zero steals, and an 11th-place division rank are not a rough patch. They are a verdict.

KellyInPhoenix finished 58th percentile in scoring last year, which is the kind of modest credibility that makes a draft collapse genuinely embarrassing. The 2026 board tells the story plainly: four major reaches, five minor reaches, zero steals, and a roster sitting dead last in the Animal Crossing division at the 3rd percentile of the field. The headlining catastrophe is the TE stack, where Travis Kelce, Mark Andrews, and Jake Ferguson were all taken a full two-plus rounds before their ADPs, soaking up capital that never came back. Trey McBride at TE2 is legitimately good, but the resources spent fortifying around him were resources stolen from everywhere else. Kirk Cousins projects as QB35. The top RB is Derrick Henry, also reached on, projecting at RB12. That is a shaky ceiling for a position that needed to carry more weight. The one bright spot is Rashee Rice projecting as a starter

at WR13, but one receiver does not redeem a draft that looks, start to finish, like someone panic-bought against every instinct telling them to stop.

There is a particular kind of exhaustion that comes not from catastrophe but from mediocrity with no obvious cure, and Vandals2s appears to be living inside it. The draft told most of the story: two major reaches, five minor ones, and zero steals across the board. Reaching nearly three full rounds early for Cam Ward, now projecting as a QB23 and the team's weakest projected starter, is the kind of move that quietly poisons a roster without leaving a single dramatic scar. The foundation is not without merit, James Cook projects as a top-five back and Nico Collins came in as genuine value after falling almost a full round past his ADP, but the tiers drop off quickly after that. Marvin Harrison Jr. projects at WR33 despite being pulled more than two rounds early, which means the draft capital spent on him bought a mid-range outcome. Sitting ninth in the Animal Crossing division and in the 9th percentile of the field, Vandals2s is not a roster waiting to turn a corner. It is a roster that has already seen the corner and found more road on the other side.

TurdFurgsonn sits at 8th in the Animal Crossing division and right at the tournament median, which sounds neutral until you realize there is almost no path upward from here. The draft tells the story: one major reach, two minor reaches, and zero steals across the board. The biggest offender is Kenneth Gainwell, taken at 9.01 against an ADP of 12.05, a three-round overpay for a player projecting as RB34. That kind of draft capital misalignment does not quietly fix itself. The roster does have a real foundation in Bijan Robinson (RB2) and De'Von Achane (RB6), and Patrick Mahomes slides in as a late value at QB12. But the projected starters thin out quickly after that. Mike Evans arrives in San Francisco carrying both an injury-shortened 2025 season and a new offense to learn, and he projects as WR27. Below him, Khalil Shakir grades out as the weakest projected starter at WR51. This team is not one move away from contention. It is one bad week away from irrelevance.

jukesonu didn't win the draft on one flashy pick. They won it on six of them. Six players came off the board later than their ADP suggested they should, and those discounts added up to something real: Zay Flowers at WR16 slipping nearly two rounds, DeVonta Smith at WR14 falling almost two rounds, D.J. Moore at WR26 drifting a round and a half past his number. None of those are consolation prizes. Those are projected starters who cost less than the market said they were worth. The two major reaches, Bo Nix and MarShawn Lloyd, are real, and a QB15 selected two-plus rounds early is a price worth scrutinizing. But Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and Justin Jefferson at WR6 anchor the starting lineup with the kind of top-end talent that absorbs a mistake or two. At 80th percentile in the field and sitting seventh in the Animal Crossing division, jukesonu is exactly where a team built on cumulative value should be: not loud, not flashy, but firmly in the conversation.

T-Bone (3andOut) didn't force anything in this draft, and the roster shows it. The foundation is built on a run of tight end value that is genuinely difficult to replicate: Brock Bowers at TE1, Colston Loveland at TE3 taken nearly a round after his ADP, George Kittle at TE9 grabbed a round and a half late, and Dallas Goedert at TE15 sliding even further. Yes, Kittle's Achilles recovery introduces real uncertainty at the top of that group, but even if he takes time to round into form, this team absorbs that hit without flinching. Meanwhile, Saquon Barkley anchors the backfield at RB8, and Quinshon Judkins at RB22 came in almost two rounds after the market said he should. The draft sheet reads like someone who did their homework and then let the board come to them: five values, twelve chalk, one minor reach, and barely a wasted pick in the building. At 82nd percentile in the field, T-Bone is exactly the kind of team that sneaks into conversations it was never supposed to be part of.

Spudkenzie didn't chase splashes. They just kept coming out ahead, pick after pick, and the cumulative effect is a roster that sits at the 83rd percentile in the field. The anchor is Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, a legitimate top-of-the-board asset, but the real story is how much Spudkenzie squeezed out of the middle rounds. George Pickens slipped a full round past his ADP and landed at WR10. Terry McLaurin fell nearly two rounds before Spudkenzie scooped him up at WR24. Brian Thomas Jr. tumbled more than two rounds past his price and became the clearest steal on the board at WR31. Stack those three values on top of each other and you start to understand why this team projects the way it does. Justin Herbert carries some uncertainty given that Mike McDaniel's arrival in Los Angeles is a new variable, but Herbert still profiles as a QB8 and pairs with Lamar Jackson to give Spudkenzie real quarterback upside. There are no defining weaknesses here, just a draft that kept winning small and ended up winning big.

Wild & Crazy Guys sit at 89th percentile in the field, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. The headliner is Ja'Marr Chase at WR2, paired in a live Burrow-Chase stack that gives this roster a genuine weekly ceiling others are chasing. But what separates a good draft from a clean one is what happens in the middle rounds, and this manager kept finding value long after the easy picks dried up: A.J. Brown fell nearly two full rounds to pick 4.09, Alec Pierce slid a round and a half, and Quentin Johnston and Jordan Addison both came in noticeably under their ADPs. Eight values across the board, and almost no overpaying to show for it. The two major reaches, Chuba Hubbard and Ted Hurst, are real, but they barely dent a card this tidy. Joe Burrow anchors the QB room at QB4, Baker Mayfield sits in reserve, and Tyler Warren at TE4 rounds out a starting group with very little soft tissue. Fourth in the Animal Crossing division is the current projection, but the draft process here earned something better.

OGDaveFantasy didn't win the draft with one flashy pick. They won it by never losing a round. The clearest evidence is the running back group, where Jahmyr Gibbs (RB1), Ashton Jeanty (RB7), Omarion Hampton (RB9), and Chase Brown (RB11) all project as starters, and Brown himself was a value, sliding nearly two rounds past his ADP before OGDave scooped him at 5.06. Tee Higgins (WR19) arrived the same way, falling almost two full rounds before landing here at 6.07. That kind of patient accumulation compounds over a roster, and it shows up in the bottom line: this team sits at the 92nd percentile in the field and third in the Animal Crossing division. Even the so-called weak spot, Daniel Jones (QB25), carries real upside given what he showed with Indianapolis in 2025 before his season ended prematurely. The projection here is not a ceiling, it is a floor, and that is exactly what steady, disciplined drafting tends to build.

SneakyMaisy didn't win the draft on one flashy move. They won it by consistently getting more than they paid for, round after round. Breece Hall at RB14 fell two full rounds past his ADP, and DK Metcalf at WR36 slid more than two rounds before landing here. Neither pick looks like a lottery ticket, just a manager paying attention while others looked elsewhere. Chris Olave and Jaylen Waddle each fell more than a round, giving this roster a projected WR11 and WR23 in the starting mix. Waddle is the especially interesting piece: after grinding through one of the league's more dysfunctional passing offenses in Miami, he lands in Denver alongside a quarterback who led the league in pass attempts. That is not a lateral move. Stack Josh Allen with Dalton Kincaid on top of all of it, and SneakyMaisy sits second in the Animal Crossing division and in the 95th percentile of the field, which is exactly where a team built on quiet, repeatable advantages tends to end up.

They just kept winning the small arguments, round after round, until the draft sheet read like a quiet indictment of everyone else in the room. Puka Nacua at WR1, taken nearly a full round after his ADP. CeeDee Lamb at WR5, also slipping past his market value. Tetairoa McMillan at WR15, another round and a half of free equity. And then, six picks into the sixth round, Jeremiyah Love at RB13 landed two full rounds past where the field had him priced. That is not luck. That is a manager who knew what things were worth and waited. The wild card in all of this is Malik Nabers, who flashed his devastating quick-twitch ability in training camp after a serious ACL scare had dynasty managers in a cold sweat all offseason. If Nabers is fully himself, this roster looks elite. If he is not, it is still sitting at 98th percentile and first in the division. That tells you everything.
