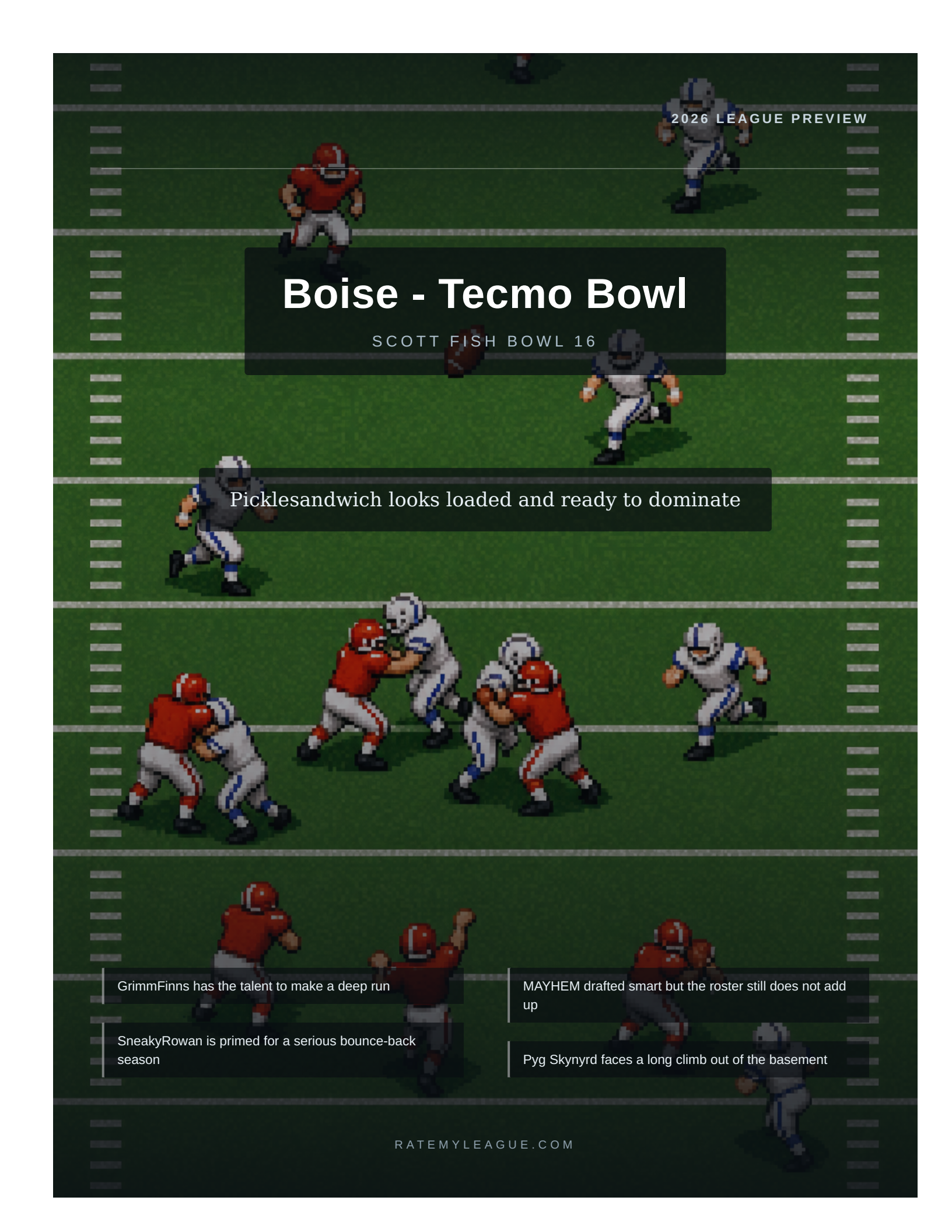

There is not much reason for optimism in the Tecmo Bowl if you are sweatingglitter247. Sitting third in the division and in just the 3rd percentile of the field, this roster is asking a lot of very little, and the draft did not generate the kind of surplus value that might paper over thin projections. The most glaring symptom is at quarterback, where Bo Nix cost a third-round pick for a QB15 projection, a reach of three full rounds that left real positional value on the table early. Brock Bowers at TE1 is a genuine anchor, and the stack with Nix and Jaylen Waddle at least gives the offense a thread of connective tissue, but when your stack's quarterback grades out QB15, that thread is not load-bearing. Derrick Henry at RB12 is real, but he was also pulled 1.2 rounds early, meaning sweatingglitter247 paid for upside that is already baked in. After a 25-percent win rate in 2025, the margin for error was already gone heading into this draft. It did not get smaller.

There is no flattering spin on what Kirstenc built in Tecmo Bowl, and the numbers make no effort to provide one. The foundation is real: Christian McCaffrey falling to 2.06 when his ADP sat at 1.09 is the kind of gift that sets a draft up, and De'Von Achane at RB6 arriving a full round late only adds to it. But then something broke. Kyler Murray, a QB19, was taken four rounds ahead of his ADP. Keon Coleman, projected WR91, was snatched eight and a half rounds early. Five major reaches in a single draft is not bad luck, it is a philosophy, and this one cost Kirstenc dearly. The squad lands 11th in the division and in just the 13th percentile of the field, a result that traces almost directly to burning mid-draft capital on quarterbacks and late-round receivers that the board would have happily delivered much later. McCaffrey and Achane were handed to this roster. Everything after that was given away.

MAYHEM did almost everything right at the draft table and landed in the bottom fifth of the tournament anyway, which is the kind of outcome that makes you question the whole enterprise. The value was real: Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 slipped past his ADP, Tony Pollard fell a full round, and the roster is littered with names taken at or after their going price. And yet when you stack it all up, the projected starters top out at a weakest link in Pollard at RB30, the quarterback investments in Joe Burrow and Trevor Lawrence cost early capital as minor reaches, and Khalil Shakir at WR51 absorbed a ninth-round pick two rounds before the market would have demanded it. The receivers are genuinely good, Burrow is a real asset at QB4, but the floor never got shored up the way the surplus at the top suggested it would. MAYHEM played the value game with discipline and still sits 10th in the Tecmo Bowl division. Drafting correctly is necessary. It turns out it is not sufficient.

Shraderbru sits ninth in the Tecmo Bowl division and projects at just the 32nd percentile of the field, and the draft record doesn't offer much cover for that standing. Four major reaches dot the board, including Jayden Daniels pulled at 2.04 against an ADP of 2.12, a move that cost real capital on a QB5 projection that could have been had later. The receiving corps does feature legitimate upside, with Nico Collins, George Pickens, and Malik Nabers all projecting as starters at WR9, WR10, and WR12 respectively, and all three were acquired at genuine value relative to ADP. But good value on good players only carries a roster so far when the surrounding cast grades out this thin, and KC Concepcion, the projected weakest starter at WR50, is the floor this lineup has to build from on a given week. There is no high-upside handcuff waiting in the wings, no undervalued steal to point to as a potential season-saver. Shraderbru drafted some real receivers and then ran out of runway before finding the rest of a contender.

The Powderpuffs enter 2026 sitting eighth in the Tecmo Bowl division and projecting at just the 37th percentile of the field, and the roster construction explains exactly how they got there. The real damage shows up in the draft log: four major reaches across the board, including Jaxson Dart taken 2.5 rounds ahead of his ADP and Sam Darnold pulled off the board 2.2 rounds early, meaning a team that needed elite talent at the top of its roster instead burned premium picks on QB11 and QB21. Jahmyr Gibbs as RB1 is a genuine asset, and Saquon Barkley adds real depth behind him, but the rest of the projected starters thin out quickly, with Chuba Hubbard grading out as the weakest projected starter at RB29. The three values on the draft sheet, including Kyle Pitts falling 1.5 rounds to grab at TE7, are nice finds, but they are rounding errors when the top of the draft already misfired this badly. There is no obvious lever left to pull here.

Pyg Skynyrd enters 2026 sitting seventh in the Tecmo Bowl division and projected at just the 41st percentile of the field, and the draft sheet does not offer much reason for optimism. The manager reached on four players by major margins, spending a fourth-round pick on Patrick Mahomes (QB12) when the market had him going in the fifth, and burning an eighth-round selection on Cam Ward (QB23) more than two rounds ahead of schedule, only to project Ward as the weakest starter on the roster. Those are real costs. Kenneth Walker III (RB10) and Chase Brown (RB11) both fell beautifully, landing nearly three rounds past their respective ADPs, and that is genuinely good drafting. The problem is that the receiver group grades out weak across the board, with Makai Lemon (WR40) and Jayden Reed (WR48) as the projected starters, and no clear upside piece waiting behind them. The top-end talent exists in pockets, but with four major reaches already burning capital and no obvious leverage point remaining, this roster feels like it has already played its best cards.

gfrank6 sits at 48th percentile and sixth in the Tecmo Bowl division, and that is exactly where the roster looks. The ceiling is real: Josh Allen at QB1 and Justin Jefferson at WR6 give this team a legitimate top end, and Jefferson arriving at pick 2.05 when his ADP sat at 1.12 qualifies as the kind of draft-room fortune that can carry a season. But the floor keeps creeping up to meet the ceiling. Three major reaches, including RJ Harvey pulled nearly three rounds early and James Conner grabbed almost four rounds ahead of his number, mean gfrank6 spent real draft capital chasing certainty where the market said to wait. Kenyon Sadiq projects as the weakest starter on the roster at TE21, and the rest of the supporting cast sits comfortably, almost stubbornly, in the average range. Nothing here collapses the bracket, and nothing here clears the field. When Allen is cooking and Jefferson is doing Jefferson things, this team competes. When the margin calls come due, the reaches start to matter.

vikstryker did not reshuffled the board in one dramatic moment, but pick after pick came out just a little bit ahead, and that adds up. Jonathan Taylor landing at RB4 a full half-round past his ADP was the kind of quiet win that sets a roster's ceiling, and Colston Loveland sliding to RB3 equivalent territory at TE3 while falling nearly a round past his price tag was the same trick pulled twice. The headliner is Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, who gives the lineup a genuine top-end anchor. Carnell Tate at WR29 carries real upside if the Cam Ward connection in Tennessee develops into what both sides need it to be, and a projected starting corps that also includes Bucky Irving at RB21 and Travis Etienne at RB18 keeps the floor from caving in. The one blemish is Matthew Stafford, a reach of nearly a round and a half at QB14. But with Purdy also projected as a starter, Stafford is insurance rather than a cornerstone. A 73rd-percentile projection and fifth in the Tecmo Bowl division reflects a team built without flash and priced accordingly.

FFPilmer did not win the draft with a single thunderclap moment. Instead, pick after pick landed in the right place, and the cumulative effect is a roster sitting at the 79th percentile of the field. The foundation is legitimately impressive: Trey McBride at TE2 fell nearly a full round past his ADP at the back of the first, Tucker Kraft at TE5 slipped another round in the sixth, and Omarion Hampton at RB9 quietly dropped almost a full round before FFPilmer grabbed him in the third. That is three projected starters collected at a discount without mortgaging a single early selection to do it. Drake Maye projects as a QB2, and Emeka Egbuka, Brian Thomas Jr., and Jordan Addison round out a starting corps with real upside. The one blemish is Rashid Shaheed, reached three full rounds ahead of his ADP, though at that point in the draft the cost is limited. Fourth in the Tecmo Bowl division is a fine place to sleep on, but the talent here says that number should move.

Last year SneakyRowan posted a 3-33 record and landed in the first percentile in scoring, which is the kind of season that makes a manager question their life choices. The 2026 roster reads like a direct, pointed response. Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Jeremiyah Love at RB13 give this team a backfield foundation most managers would trade a kidney for, and the depth behind them, Jeremiyah Love aside, Josh Jacobs at RB16 and David Montgomery at RB23, means quality options are everywhere when projections inevitably go sideways. Caleb Williams at QB6 anchors the passing game, and while reaching nearly a round early for him suggests genuine conviction, the SFB format rewards managers who trust their reads. Chris Olave falling nearly a full round past his ADP is the kind of patient drafting that separates rebound seasons from repeat disasters. Sitting third in the division and in the 82nd percentile, SneakyRowan has built something that looks less like a lucky bounce and more like a deliberate climb back to relevance.

GrimmFinns sit second in the Tecmo Bowl division and in the 83rd percentile of the field, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. This is a roster built with patience and precision: five values and a steal across the board, only three minor reaches, and zero major reaches. The foundation is Ja'Marr Chase, a WR2 projection landed at pick 1.06 when his ADP sat at 1.02, a small gap that still represents a clean win at the top of a draft. From there, the value compounds. Harold Fannin at TE6 fell over a round past his ADP, and Zay Flowers at WR16 slipped a full round before GrimmFinns pounced. The projected starting group also includes A.J. Brown at WR8, Rashee Rice at WR13, and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15, names that simply do not need to be dressed up with narrative. Some teams look good on paper and unravel under scrutiny. This one holds up. GrimmFinns drafted like someone who came in with a plan and never panicked off it.

Picklesandwich is not an accident. Sitting first in the Tecmo Bowl division and at the 97th tournament percentile, this roster was built with the kind of disciplined, value-hunting precision that makes other managers stare at their draft boards and wonder where it all went wrong. The foundation is genuinely formidable: Puka Nacua at WR1 and Drake London at WR7 anchor a receiving corps that should produce at an elite level all season, and London himself was scooped up more than a round after consensus said he would go. That patience and positioning define this entire build. Eight values and two steals across the roster is not luck, it is method. Alec Pierce came in as a steal at WR32, taken more than three rounds after his ADP, and his big-play pedigree adds a boom-shot upside that fits perfectly alongside the reliable starters above him. The one genuine blemish is Baker Mayfield, reached nearly three full rounds early, but a QB18 projection softens that concern considerably. This is a 97th-percentile roster because it was drafted like one.
