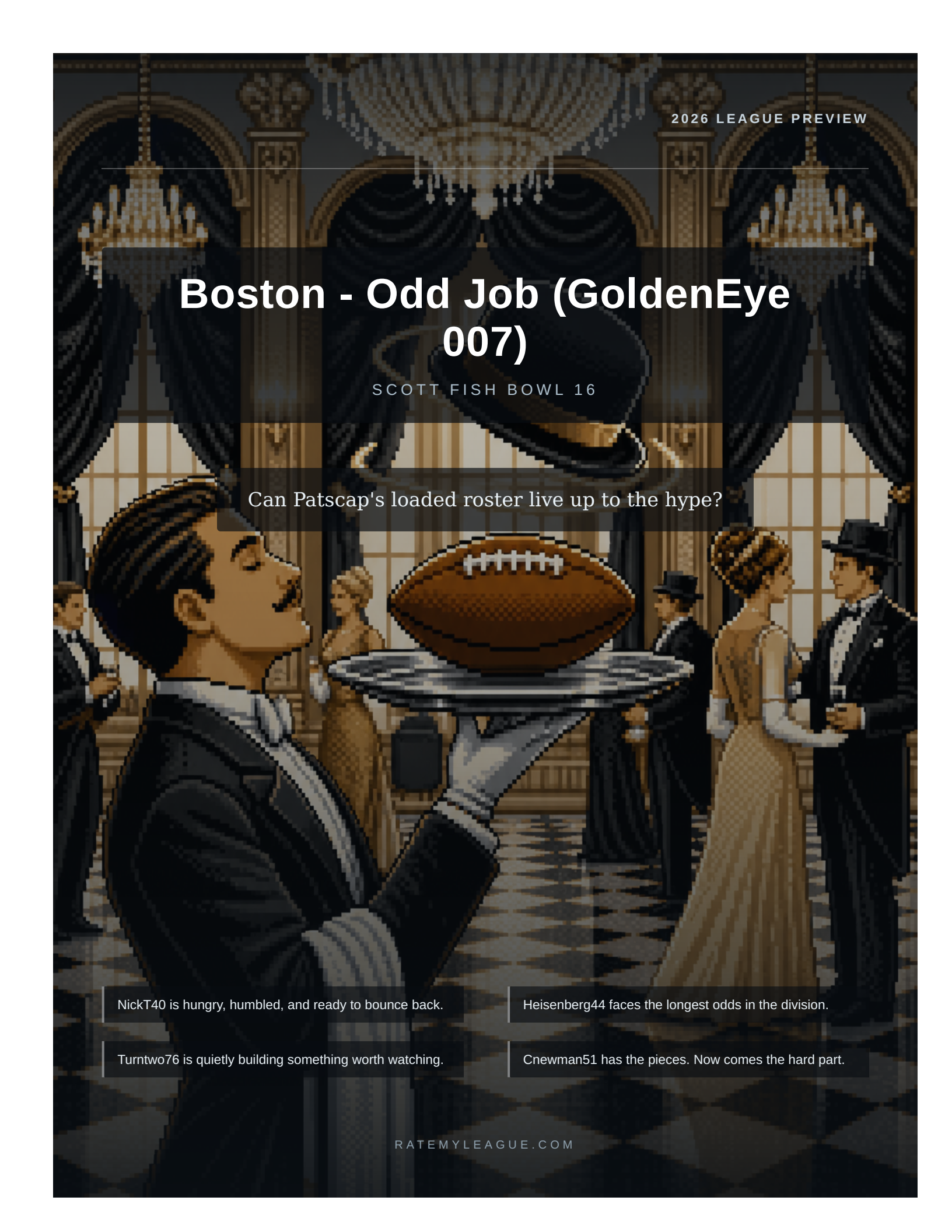

Heisenberg44 sits 12th in the Odd Job division and in just the 9th percentile of the entire field, and nothing about this roster suggests those numbers are about to move in the right direction. The foundation is real enough: Jonathan Taylor projects as RB4, and Chase Brown at RB11 gives the team genuine top-end talent to build around. But the draft process never found a way to capitalize on that base. Zero steals, zero values, fifteen chalk picks, and two major reaches tell the story of a manager who paid full price for everything and then overpaid for the rest, most painfully on Demond Claiborne, taken three full rounds before his ADP, and Kayshon Boutte, reached on by 3.4 rounds. Those are the kinds of gambles that need to hit to rescue a 9th-percentile roster, and historically they don't. Kyler Murray, dealing with a lisfranc injury that cost him most of last season and now fighting for a starting job in Minnesota, grades out as a QB19, which is not the steadying hand this team needs. After a 17-percent win rate in 2025, Heisenberg44 needed a different offseason. This wasn't it.

HoodieAMB spent 2025 winning 81 percent of their games and scoring in the 79th percentile, which makes their current situation feel like a cruel joke. The 2026 projection has them sitting 11th in the Odd Job division and in just the 15th percentile of the field, and there is no obvious miscalculation to point to as the culprit. The receiver group is genuinely excellent, with Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, A.J. Brown at WR8, and DeVonta Smith at WR14 all projected as starters, but when the draft offers you 12 chalk picks, zero steals, and a major reach on Emmett Johnson taken nearly four rounds before his ADP, the ceiling gets quietly strangled before the season even starts. Johnson projects as RB54. That is the third running back on this roster. The quarterback situation is no better, with Jared Goff as the best option at QB16, and Greg Dulcich sitting at TE25 as the weakest projected starter. HoodieAMB is not a team that made one catastrophic mistake. It is a team that made many small ones, and now has nothing left to fix.

Fozberry64 sits 10th in the Odd Job division and in the 18th percentile of the field, and the draft did not do much to improve those odds. The roster has genuine anchors: Puka Nacua projects as WR1, Tyler Warren grades out as TE4, and Rashee Rice checks in at WR13, giving the team a legitimate top-end core to build around. The problem is that the floor drops off quickly from there, and the draft chart reads less like a strategy than a series of hunches that mostly did not pay off, with three major reaches and five minor ones against a single steal all tournament. C.J. Stroud cost a sixth-round pick on a QB22 projection, a transaction that would make an accountant wince. Rhamondre Stevenson projects as the weakest projected starter at RB31, and last season's 34th-percentile scoring output suggests the arrow was already pointing down before this draft began. There is no obvious lever left to pull, and at this point Fozberry64 may be hoping the projections are wrong more than trusting that the roster is right.

There is something quietly deflating about watching a 98th-percentile team try to defend its reputation on a completely different roster. Last year's version of asdfjkl was a points machine. This year's projection lands at the 18th percentile and ninth in the Odd Job division, and the gap between those two numbers is where all the interesting questions live. The tight end group, anchored by Trey McBride at TE2 and Colston Loveland at TE3 with Tucker Kraft at TE5 providing genuine depth, is legitimately elite and probably the only part of this roster that would have fit comfortably on last year's squad. Everything else feels borrowed. Saquon Barkley at RB8 is a real asset, but the projected starters at receiver top out at Parker Washington at WR35, and the quarterback situation, Jordan Love at QB17 and Baker Mayfield at QB18, required early capital to secure two middling options. The draft was almost entirely chalk, producing no steals and no leverage. Reputations are made on old results and broken on new projections, and right now this one is working through that transition the hard way.

Coledem sits at the 53rd percentile and ranks eighth in the Odd Job division, which is exactly the kind of résumé that keeps a manager refreshing the standings every Monday. The floor here is real: Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4), Justin Jefferson (WR6), and Tetairoa McMillan (WR15) form a receiving core that can carry a week on its own, and Travis Kelce (TE10), snagged 2.5 rounds past his ADP, looks like the kind of draft-day patience that separates contenders from pretenders. The ceiling, though, has its cracks. T.J. Hockenson (TE23) cost a four-round premium at pick 8.02, which is a steep price for a TE23, and Matthew Stafford, pitching what may be his final season while the Rams groom his replacement, is a fine QB14 right up until the moment he isn't. Jaylen Warren (RB27) anchors the backfield, and a weak RB group means the margin between a good week and a forgettable one is thinner than coledem would probably like. This roster wins when its stars deliver and loses when they merely play well.

NessyFFB finished 24-12 a season ago and landed at 55th percentile entering 2026, which is exactly the kind of profile that makes a team hard to read. The ceiling is real: Drake London at WR7, Brock Bowers at TE1, and a receiving corps that runs deep enough through Chris Olave (WR11), Zay Flowers (WR16), and Tee Higgins (WR19) that the top of this roster can genuinely beat anyone on a given week. The floor is where the questions live. Jacoby Brissett projects as a QB28, and in a positionless format where scoring volume matters at every slot, a quarterback that far down the rankings puts meaningful pressure on everyone else to carry the load. They can, most weeks. But 55th percentile is not a comfortable cushion, and seventh in the Odd Job division means NessyFFB is hunting points it has no margin to leave behind. London and Bowers have to hit, the middle tier of this

roster has to stay healthy, and Brissett has to be serviceable. None of those things are guaranteed, which is precisely what makes this team interesting and unsettling in equal measure.

After finishing in the bottom 20 percent of scoring in 2025, NickT40 has come back with something to prove, and this roster looks like a genuine answer. The foundation is hard to argue with: Jahmyr Gibbs projects as RB1, Omarion Hampton sits at RB9, and Bucky Irving checks in at RB21, giving this team a top-end punch that simply was not here a year ago. George Pickens at WR10 and Ladd McConkey at WR20 round out a starting core that belongs in the conversation, and the Justin Herbert-McConkey stack adds a bonus that could pay off in the big weeks that decide tournaments. Herbert himself was a draft-day value, sliding to a fifth-round pick despite projecting as QB8. The one place to watch is RJ Harvey, who enters a Denver backfield complicated by JK Dobbins and the addition of Jonah Coleman, making his RB28 projection feel optimistic at best. Still, when you climb from 20th percentile to 63rd on paper, the rebound is real. NickT40 just needs the floor to hold.

Minvike401 enters 2026 having built something quietly dangerous, a roster assembled without a single defining heist but with a consistency that adds up fast. The foundation starts at the top: Caleb Williams projects as QB6, and the stack with Luther Burden, a WR22, gives this team a ceiling that activates in bunches. James Cook at RB5 anchors the skill group, and the supporting cast behind him, Kyren Williams at RB15, David Montgomery at RB23, Bhayshul Tuten at RB25, keeps the quality from falling off a cliff. Where the draft got genuinely interesting was at tight end, where Minvike401 landed both Dalton Kincaid and Jake Ferguson well past their respective ADPs, picking up a projected TE11 and TE12 at discounts that quietly loaded the back end of the roster. The 2025 numbers back the instinct here: a 75 percent win rate and a 93rd percentile scoring season suggest a manager who knows how to translate paper value into actual points. Sitting fifth in the Odd Job division at the 64th tournament percentile feels like an undercount.

tshnizzle didn't win the draft with one thunderbolt pick. They won it the way a good poker player wins a session, by consistently getting more than they paid for. The foundation is genuinely strong: Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 give this roster a top-end that most managers in the field would trade for without blinking, and Kenneth Walker III at RB10 keeps the quality from dropping off a cliff behind them. Brian Thomas Jr. landing at WR31 while slipping a full round past his ADP is the kind of quiet draft-room win that compounds over a season. Then there is Jalen Hurts, a projected QB9 who has posted five consecutive top-10 fantasy finishes on the back of an extraordinary rushing touchdown pace, though the offseason departure of AJ Brown to New England introduces real uncertainty about whether that pace holds. If Hurts weathers that pressure cooker, tshnizzle's ceiling climbs considerably. The 72nd percentile projection and a fourth-place divisional standing are a fair floor for a team built this carefully, with room to go higher.

There was no single moment in turntwo76's draft where the room gasped, and that was entirely the point. This roster was built pick by pick, with the kind of quiet discipline that only shows up in the results column. Josh Allen at QB1 anchors the passing game, and the Jaxson Dart stacks with both Malik Nabers and Isaiah Likely give this team a secondary engine that could punch well above its cost. The real craftsmanship, though, is in how the values accumulated without the draft ever going sideways: Harold Fannin fell nearly two rounds past his ADP before turntwo76 scooped him up at TE6, and Oronde Gadsden slid a round and a half to land as a projected starter at TE16. The one blemish is Alvin Kamara, taken more than three rounds early and projected all the way down to RB50, but one miscalculation in a draft this steady barely dents the picture. At 73rd percentile and third in the Odd Job division, this team did not get here on luck.

Cnewman51 didn't need a miracle pick to build one of the better rosters in this field, just round after round of quiet, correct decisions. The foundation is genuinely elite: Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Lamar Jackson at QB3 give this team a ceiling that most managers in the 86th percentile can only approximate, and the Jackson/Mark Andrews stack adds a layer of correlation that pays dividends when Baltimore is cooking. Andrews, a TE14, fell more than a round past his ADP, which is the kind of patient draft execution that separates good managers from lucky ones. Jayden Daniels at QB5 was another draft-day winner, sliding nearly a full round and landing in a stack with Terry McLaurin, giving Cnewman51 two live quarterback options with built-in receiver upside. The one question worth watching is Alec Pierce, a projected WR32 starter who dealt with offseason ankle surgery and a PUP list designation. If Pierce misses the first four games, it costs this team some real upside, but the floor remains high enough that Cnewman51 is firmly in the division title conversation either way.

Patscap sits first in the Odd Job division and in the 92nd percentile of the entire field, and the draft sheet tells you exactly why. No major reaches, five values, one steal, and a clean foundation built around a Burrow-Chase stack that is as close to a cheat code as the Scott Fish Bowl allows. Joe Burrow lands as QB4 after slipping nearly a full round past his ADP, and Ja'Marr Chase checks in at WR2, meaning the most productive quarterback-receiver partnership in the sport arrives here at a discount. The receiver room deepens fast: Nico Collins at WR9, Jameson Williams at WR21, Jaylen Waddle at WR23, all projected starters, all providing the kind of week-to-week ceiling that keeps a tournament roster alive deep into the schedule. Kyle Pitts sliding to TE7 later than he should have adds another projected starter at value. Even the projected weakest starter, Quentin Johnston at WR41, represents a manageable floor. This roster was built with patience and precision, and it shows from top to bottom.
