Perhaps most concerning is the tight end slot, where Jonnu Smith's TE15 ranking underscores a lack of dependable options. Although some

draft strategies yielded unexpected value, such decisions were overshadowed by misguided reaches, particularly at tight end, which seem destined to anchor this team to the bottom of the pile. Entering the season at the lowest rank in their division and near the bottom in percentile standings, the Murta Rotos face what appears to be an uphill battle toward relevance.

While Puka Nacua offers a spark as WR5, the rest of the wide receiver lineup, including Tetairoa McMillan and Zay Flowers, struggles to inspire confidence. Draft strategies have been a mixed bag; while snagging Dak Prescott significantly later than his ADP was a victory, reaching for Jared Goff and TreVeyon

Henderson much earlier than necessary suggests a miscalculation that could haunt them. Even the small stack bonus from pairing Goff with LaPorta seems unlikely to salvage what looks to be a taxing season ahead for FelipeFelix.
