There is no charitable read available for rickrassidy1, and the draft sheet confirms it with brutal efficiency. The team landed at the 12th percentile in the tournament and sits last in the Brawl Stars division, and the draft itself explains exactly why: zero steals, zero values, and eight reaches across 18 rounds, including three that qualify as genuinely damaging. The crown jewel of the roster is Lamar Jackson at QB3, a fine player taken at 1.05 when his ADP sat at 2.03, which means rickrassidy1 burned a top-five pick to secure a player who would have been available a full round later. Then, seemingly committed to the bit, this manager turned around and took Christian Kirk, a WR100, nearly four and a half rounds before anyone else in the field considered him worth selecting. The projected weakest starter is Aaron Jones at RB38, which tells you everything about the floor here. When your draft philosophy produces no upside and your depth is built on late reaches, the math does not get kinder as the season progresses.

There is not much to sugarcoat here for cables336, who sits 11th in the Brawl Stars division and in just the 13th percentile of the field heading into 2026. The draft tells a familiar story of a team that reached when it mattered most and found value in places that could not compensate. Drake Maye, taken nearly a full round ahead of his ADP, grades out as QB2, which sounds fine until you remember that this is a positionless format and burning a first-round pick early on a quarterback is a bet that has to pay off everywhere else. It mostly did not. RJ Harvey, the projected weakest starter at RB28, was also taken ahead of his ADP, meaning cables336 paid a premium for a player who projects as a liability in the starting lineup. Chris Olave at WR11 is a genuine bright spot, arriving as real value, but one good draft decision is a life raft, not a rescue boat. The math here is unforgiving, and there is no obvious move left to change it.

RandleRant enters 2026 sitting 10th in the Brawl Stars division and in just the 27th percentile of the field, and the draft didn't do much to improve the outlook. The roster carries a legitimate ace in Ja'Marr Chase at WR2, and James Cook grading out as RB5 gives the team a second credible pillar, but the supporting cast fades fast and the draft board made things worse. Three major reaches dot the sheet, most damning among them Bo Nix pulled nearly two rounds ahead of his QB15 projection and Jaylen Warren grabbed nearly three rounds early for an RB27. Those aren't calculated gambles on upside, they're the kind of draft-capital erosion that leaves a team scrambling at the margins. The margins here are already thin, with Rhamondre Stevenson projected as the weakest starter at RB31. Chase and Cook are real, but in a positionless format where depth compounds, leaning on two stars surrounded by reaches and chalk is a precarious construction. The lever doesn't exist. RandleRant may simply be outgunned.

Fspallone did almost everything right in the draft room and still landed at ninth in the Brawl Stars division, which is the kind of outcome that makes you question whether process matters at all. Rome Odunze fell 1.1 rounds before Fspallone grabbed him at WR30, KC Concepcion slipped 2.2 rounds to WR50, and the only real blemish was Brock Purdy at QB13, reached 1.7 rounds early in round four when the rest of the board still had value sitting on it. The frustrating part is that the individual pieces do not look broken: Jonathan Taylor projects at RB4, Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4, Harold Fannin at TE6. On paper those are pillars. But the roster thins out quickly after that top tier, and a 2025 campaign that produced a 17 percent win rate and a 13th-percentile scoring finish suggests the foundation has cracked before. Fspallone played the patience game correctly, collected values, and still sits in the bottom third of the tournament field. Some drafts just refuse to pay you what you are owed.

GorrellFam lands at 35th percentile in the field and eighth in the Brawl Stars division, and the roster grade makes that ranking feel generous rather than cruel. The core is real: Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and CeeDee Lamb at WR5 give this team a legitimate foundation, and Tyler Warren falling to GorrellFam at 4.02 when his ADP sat at 3.04 was the one moment the draft board smiled in their direction. But beyond that trio, the margin for error evaporates quickly. Malik Nabers is projected WR12 and theoretically a difference-maker, but he is coming off an ACL that his own head coach described as "not simple," and his Week 1 availability alongside Jaxson Dart remains an open question, which is not the kind of uncertainty a team in this position can absorb comfortably. Meanwhile, the QB situation with Baker Mayfield at QB18 and Tyler Shough at QB20 offers no upside at a position where upside matters. GorrellFam is not without talent, but the levers that could flip this season are few, and most of them are already pulled.

ChrisBeck5 sits at the 55th percentile of the field, and that number tells the whole story: good enough to be dangerous on a given week, not good enough to feel safe in any of them. The foundation is real. Jahmyr Gibbs projects as the RB1, Rashee Rice lands at WR13, DeVonta Smith at WR14, and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15, a trio of receivers projected so tightly together they could share a bus route. Colston Loveland at TE3 adds genuine upside at a position where most managers are scrambling. But the margins that will define this season live in the uncomfortable middle of the roster. Twelve chalk picks and two major reaches, J.J. McCarthy at QB37 and David Njoku at QB29, suggest a drafter who got conservative early and then chased conviction late without the market agreeing. Kyle Monangai projects as the weakest starter at RB33, and in a format where every point counts, that is exactly the kind of drag that turns 55th percentile into a first-round exit rather than a deep run.

PaulRyan15 didn't build this roster with one blockbuster move. They built it by consistently drafting players who slid past their ADP, round after round, until the advantages quietly stacked up. Justin Jefferson, a WR6 projection, was still sitting there at pick 2.05 when his ADP had him going nearly a full round earlier. Marvin Harrison Jr. fell nearly two rounds before PaulRyan15 grabbed him at 9.08, and Isaiah Likely dropped a round and a half before landing at TE13 on this roster. Add Brock Bowers at TE1 and you have a tight end group that most managers in the Brawl Stars division would happily trade their draft capital to match. The one blemish is a Deshaun Watson situation at QB that projects him as a QB34, which is genuinely difficult to paper over in any format. But in a positionless lineup, a manager leans on what they have, and what PaulRyan15 has from Jefferson through Bowers is enough to keep them in the 58th percentile conversation and push higher if a few of those value picks hit.

Knuttles didn't win the draft with one flashy pick. They won it by repeatedly coming out ahead on value, and the cumulative effect is a roster sitting comfortably at the 59th percentile with room to climb. The foundation is legitimate: Josh Allen at QB1 anchors the passing game, Saquon Barkley and Omarion Hampton form a projected-starter backfield duo that most managers would take in a heartbeat, and Dallas Goedert at TE15 was quietly scooped two full rounds after his ADP, which is the kind of quiet draft moment that shows up loud in the standings. Kyle Pitts at TE7 came nearly two rounds late as well, giving Knuttles another projected starter at real positional value. The one genuine cloud hanging over this roster is Josh Jacobs, a projected starter whose off-field situation following an offseason arrest adds meaningful uncertainty to his availability, and that is not a minor asterisk on an RB16 projection. If Jacobs is a full participant, this team looks like a real contender in the Brawl Stars. If not, Knuttles is still viable, just thinner at the margin than the draft sheet suggests.

nraducanu didn't win the draft on one big swing, they just kept coming out ahead pick after pick. The clearest example is at tight end, where Trey McBride at TE2 and George Kittle at TE9 anchor a positional group that reads like a manager who refused to let value walk past them. Then in the middle rounds, Zay Flowers and Jameson Williams both slipped past their ADPs by more than a round apiece, landing as projected starters at WR16 and WR21 respectively. Yes, Jayden Daniels and Jaxson Dart were taken ahead of consensus, but Daniels projects as a QB5 and Dart as a QB11, so the early investment looks far more defensible in hindsight than it did on draft night. The result is a team sitting fourth in the Brawl Stars division and in the 64th percentile of the field, not a flashy number, but one built on a draft that repeatedly extracted more than it gave away. There's a foundation here worth watching.

Davenport35 finished 2026 sitting third in the Brawl Stars division and in the 69th percentile of the field, numbers that feel almost deliberately modest given what this roster actually looks like. The draft board will tell you this manager reached repeatedly, four minor reaches and two major ones against zero steals, and yet the finished product features Puka Nacua at WR1, A.J. Brown at WR8, George Pickens at WR10, and Garrett Wilson at WR17 all projecting as starters. That is not a portfolio assembled by someone who got lucky on the board, that is someone who knew exactly which players they wanted and paid the price without flinching. Brandon Aiyuk, taken 3.8 rounds before his ADP, and Jalen Tolbert, snagged 5.4 rounds early, are the two picks the analytics crowd will circle in red ink, and they may yet prove the critics right. But Davenport35 went into this draft with a plan, executed it with conviction rather than patience, and walked out with one of the most imposing collections of receivers in the

tournament. Whether the reaches at the margins matter depends entirely on whether the top end delivers, and that top end is genuinely hard to argue with.

hohwieler5 didn't swing for the fences and miss, they just kept connecting. The foundation is Bijan Robinson (RB2) and Ashton Jeanty (RB7) at the top of the board, and from there the draft was a steady accumulation of surplus value. Tucker Kraft (TE5) slid nearly two rounds past his ADP, and Mark Andrews (TE14) fell more than two full rounds before hohwieler5 quietly picked him up at 11.04, a steal that would have looked like good fortune if the rest of the board hadn't followed the same pattern. Quinshon Judkins (RB22) and Derrick Henry (RB12) both came in below their expected price, and the Jordan Love (QB17) and Kraft stack gives the roster a multiplier on scoring nights when that connection is humming. Yes, Love was taken 2.2 rounds early, and the receiver group is thinner than the rest of the roster, but neither concern derails what is otherwise a well-constructed team sitting second in the Brawl Stars division and comfortably in the 69th percentile of the field.

JimMcCormick sits first in the Brawl Stars division and at the 94th percentile of the field, and the draft record tells you exactly why: five values, fourteen chalk, and one reach, which is about as clean a sheet as you will find in this tournament. The engine here is a receiver group headlined by Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Nico Collins at WR9, both projected starters, with Collins arriving as a value after sliding nearly a full round past his ADP. Dak Prescott similarly fell almost a full round, giving McCormick a QB7 at a QB30 price, and that kind of quiet arithmetic repeated across the board is how a roster reaches the top five percent without a single dramatic swing. The one honest question mark is Oronde Gadsden at TE16, where the Chargers' late signing of David Njoku introduces real competition for targets that Gadsden was counting on. It is a legitimate cloud, but one soft spot on a roster this deep is a problem most managers in this field would happily accept.
