As the 2025 fantasy football season unfolds, PrimeTime faces a daunting uphill battle, struggling to make any meaningful impact amidst considerable adversity. Despite securing Jerome Ford at a bargain draft position, the team's decision-making has been questionable, with reaching early for players like Baker Mayfield and

Woody Marks, and an underwhelming stack bonus from pairing Evans with Mayfield not paying dividends. Unfortunately, the team's investment in Luther Burden and others has yet to yield the anticipated payoff, leaving PrimeTime's potential success this season looking bleak and overshadowed by strategic missteps.


