There is no flattering angle on Catch723, and searching for one is a waste of everyone's time. The defining move of this draft was Mark Andrews at TE14, taken four and a half rounds before his average draft position, burning a fourth-round pick on a tight end that the market said could be had in the ninth. That kind of aggressive misjudgment did not stay contained to one pick. Dak Prescott came off the board at 2.05, a round and a half early. Breece Hall followed at 3.08, a round and a half ahead of consensus. Baker Mayfield landed in the fifth, two full rounds before the market expected. Six major reaches across a draft is not a coincidence or a cold streak, it is a philosophy, and the philosophy cost Catch723 dearly. The lone bright spot is Alvin Kamara falling a round past his ADP, but one value pick does not rehabilitate a draft sheet this damaged. First percentile in the tournament. Last in the Bubble Bobble division. The numbers are not being cruel, they are being accurate.

Last year, Jaxkelmonsta SmithNjigbub posted a 30-6 record and landed in the 95th percentile of scoring. This year, the projection is 14th percentile, and that is not a rounding error, that is a collapse. The reputation is real. The roster, unfortunately, is not living up to it. Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 is a genuine star, and Tyler Warren at TE4 anchors a strong group at tight end, but the draft tells a harder story: zero steals, two values, and two major reaches, including Bo Nix pulled nearly two rounds before his ADP at a position that projects him only as QB15. Harold Fannin at TE6 is a legitimate bright spot, a player who outperformed David Njoku last season and whose value ticks up now that Njoku is gone in Cleveland, even if the Browns' quarterback room remains a quiet disaster. The gap between who this manager was in 2025 and who this roster projects to be in 2026 is the whole season in miniature, and right now it is not a flattering portrait.

There is a version of this Doody11 roster that looks almost respectable on paper, and then you squint at the division standings and remember they are sitting tenth in Bubble Bobble with a 23rd-percentile grade dragging behind them like a bad carry-over contract. The top of the roster is genuinely fine: CeeDee Lamb at WR5 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 give this team a real foundation, and the Jayden Daniels and Terry McLaurin stack is one of the more coherent pairing decisions in the draft. But the draft board tells a sobering story. One major reach in Jaylen Warren, taken nearly two and a half rounds ahead of his ADP, burned a valuable mid-round slot on a RB27 projection that had no business going at pick 7.09. Zero steals across the entire draft means there is no late-round upside quietly waiting to break out. Last season's 44 percent win rate and 41st-percentile scoring already established the ceiling here, and nothing about this construction suggests 2026 rewrites that trajectory.

jescheel drafted like someone who panicked early and never recovered. The most damning evidence sits right there in the draft log: three major reaches, six minor reaches, and a single steal across 18 rounds of choices. C.J. Stroud, a QB22, was taken at pick 7.02, nearly two and a half rounds before anyone else wanted him, burning premium capital on a quarterback who projects as a borderline starter at best. Then, as if to double down on the philosophy of wanting players before the market does, Kayshon Boutte was hauled in 2.5 rounds early and projects as WR76, and Darnell Washington was grabbed 3.2 rounds ahead of schedule only to land at TE38. The team sits 9th in the Bubble Bobble division and in the 23rd percentile of the field, and that ranking feels honest rather than cruel. Caleb Williams and Luther Burden as a stack give jescheel something real to root for, but one functional pairing cannot paper over a draft that read more like a wish list than a strategy.

Montamara enters the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl sitting eighth in the Bubble Bobble division and hovering around the 40th percentile of the field, and the roster offers precious little reason for optimism. The QB group is legitimately elite, with Josh Allen (QB1) and Drake Maye (QB2) giving the manager a top-shelf foundation, but the rest of the roster fails to carry that energy forward. The receiver group is a slow fade into irrelevance, with Tetairoa McMillan (WR15) as a projected starter and then a cliff drop to Khalil Shakir (WR51) and a collection of names that belong on a depth-chart rumor, not a championship contender. The draft did not help matters: fifteen chalk picks and a major reach on Mac Jones (QB39), taken nearly nine rounds before his consensus ADP, is the kind of draft capital mismanagement that forecloses future flexibility. When your weakest projected starter is RJ Harvey (RB28) and the path to improvement runs through players ranked in the 80s and 90s, the math is stubborn. Allen and Maye are a strong hand, but this team is playing the wrong game with it.

CommishCasey sits at the 48th percentile and seventh in the Bubble Bobble division, and that kind of median existence lives or dies on the margins. The foundation is genuinely solid: Lamar Jackson (QB3) and Zay Flowers (WR16) form one of the better stacks in the field, and a starting group that also includes Jeremiyah Love (RB13), Cam Skattebo (RB20), Emeka Egbuka (WR18), and Jaylen Waddle (WR23) gives this roster a real ceiling. But the draft card raises an eyebrow. Jaydon Blue (RB70) was taken 8.5 rounds ahead of his ADP, and Demond Claiborne (RB63) went nearly three rounds early, meaning CommishCasey spent meaningful capital on players the consensus valued much later. Those are the kinds of decisions that don't hurt when everything breaks right and quietly sink a team when they don't. After a rough 2025 that landed in the 8th percentile of scoring, this roster is better constructed, but it is not built with the margin for error that forgives aggressive swings that miss.

DraftBuddy did not try to be clever. Round after round, this team simply came out ahead, and the cumulative effect is hard to argue with. Five values against zero major reaches is the kind of draft profile that wins over the long haul, and the headliners more than justify the optimism. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and Saquon Barkley at RB8 give the lineup a ceiling that most managers in the Bubble Bobble division would envy, and Derrick Henry at RB12, nabbed nearly a full round after his ADP, shows that DraftBuddy was patient enough to let the board come to them. Then there is Kyle Pitts, projected TE7 and taken a round and a half after his ADP, quietly becoming one of the better value picks in this draft. The Atlanta quarterback situation is genuinely murky with Tua Tagovailoa entering the picture, but Pitts proved last season he can produce regardless of who is taking snaps. Sitting at 61st percentile in the field, this roster has the upside to climb considerably higher.

KKspesh didn't build this roster with a single flashy move. They built it pick by pick, quietly coming out ahead on value again and again. Chase Brown lands as a projected RB11 and was still sitting there in the fourth round, falling nearly a full round past his ADP. Trey McBride at TE2 and Colston Loveland at TE3 give this lineup a ceiling that most managers would trade a kidney for, and Tucker Kraft at TE5 keeps the quality from dropping off. The receiver group, rated weak by projection, is where KKspesh did the steadiest work: Makai Lemon fell more than two rounds before being scooped up, Michael Wilson and KC Concepcion each came at a meaningful discount, and Carnell Tate and Rome Odunze round out a projected starting group. The Daniel Jones reach in round eight is the one moment where the draft got ahead of itself, but one blemish on a sheet this clean reads more like a footnote than a flaw. After a 95th-percentile scoring season in 2025, sitting 73rd percentile entering 2026 feels less like a ceiling and more like a floor.

Smokin Darts finished 2026 at the 75th percentile, which is a genuinely good place to end up, and the draft tape makes that result feel almost defiant. The board was not kind to this roster on paper: two major reaches, three minor reaches, and exactly zero steals across the whole draft. And yet here stands a receiving corps that would make most managers weep with envy, anchored by Puka Nacua at WR1 and Drake London at WR7, the latter arriving at pick 2.10 as a modest value despite the reach-heavy pattern surrounding him. The great philosophical question hanging over Smokin Darts is whether Jaxson Dart, hauled in 2.2 rounds ahead of his WR11 projection, is the visionary centerpiece of this roster or simply the most expensive gamble on it. If Dart becomes the player this manager clearly believes he is, the draft grades evaporate and the results speak for themselves. If he does

not, this roster still has enough firepower elsewhere to survive. Conviction or luck, the wins were real last year, and there is enough here to believe they will be again.

After finishing 2025 in the bottom 12 percent of the field in scoring, Jello424 has rebuilt into something that looks nothing like that wreckage, and the numbers back it up: a projected 93rd percentile finish and third in the Bubble Bobble division. The engine driving that leap is a backfield headlined by Jahmyr Gibbs (RB1) and James Cook (RB5), two projected starters who give this roster a ceiling most managers in this tournament would envy. Cook arrived as a mild value, slipping past his ADP to land at 2.08, which is the kind of quiet draft-room patience that separates competent managers from lucky ones. Layer in Travis Etienne (RB18) as additional depth, Nico Collins (WR9) and Ladd McConkey (WR20) as legitimate receiving weapons, and Trevor Lawrence (QB10) managing the passing game, and the picture is clear: this is not a team papering over last year's problems with optimism. It is a materially better roster, built to score, and the rebound feels earned.

There is not much to argue with here. The 2022 Champions sit second in the Bubble Bobble division and check in at the 96th percentile of the entire field, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. Five values and a steal in a single draft is not luck, it is discipline, and the steal is a good one: De'Von Achane, a projected RB6 starter, slid a full round and a half past his ADP and landed at 3.11. The receiver corps is where the discipline really compounds. George Pickens, DeVonta Smith, and Jameson Williams all fell past their ADPs, giving this team three projected starters at WR10, WR14, and WR21 for prices that belonged a round earlier. Then there is Justin Jefferson, a projected WR6 who arrives with something to prove after a rough stretch with J.J. McCarthy in Minnesota. Kyler Murray is now the favorite to start for the Vikings, and Jefferson's fantasy projections reflect the belief that last year was about the quarterback, not him. A Murray-Jefferson stack sweetens that bet considerably. The weakest projected starter is Tony Pollard at RB30. That is the critique. It is a short one.

AbsoluteX didn't just build a good team, they built a disciplined one, and in the Scott Fish Bowl those two things are not always the same. Sitting first in the Bubble Bobble division and in the 97th percentile of the field, this roster is what happens when a manager stays patient and lets the board come to them. The headliners are hard to argue with: Brock Bowers projects as TE1, Jonathan Taylor as RB4, and a receiving corps anchored by A.J. Brown (WR8), Rashee Rice (WR13), and Tee Higgins (WR19) gives this lineup a ceiling most managers would trade half their roster to reach. What makes it truly clean is how those names were acquired. Brown fell a full round past his ADP, Higgins fell a round and a half, and Marvin Harrison Jr. slipped nearly two rounds before AbsoluteX pounced at WR33. Five values and a steal, with just one meaningful reach on the board. The Matthew Stafford and Davante Adams stack adds a bonus wrinkle. There is very little to pick apart here.
