Sitting 12th in the Donkey Kong Division and buried in the 5th percentile of the field, 2ndXSucks is what happens when a manager mistakes aggression for acumen. The draft tells the story in four ugly words: zero steals, four major reaches. Tetairoa McMillan, a reasonable piece at WR15, cost a pick and a half of premium currency when the board would have delivered him two rounds later. Khalil Shakir at WR51 came nearly three rounds early, a price that makes sense only if you believe WR51 production deserves WR51 cost. And then, somehow, the exercise culminated in Skyler Bell, a WR103 gobbled up eight full rounds before his ADP, in a draft that had already demonstrated this manager cannot distinguish between conviction and panic. Brock Bowers at TE1 is real, and Kenneth Walker III at RB10 gives the roster a pulse, but those pieces were there for anyone willing to draft their position in the queue. Everything else confirms the name is autobiographical.

AnaMC99 sits 11th in the Donkey Kong Division and in the 7th percentile of the entire field, and the draft record explains exactly how it got there: zero steals, zero values, and seven reaches across 19 rounds. The major reaches tell the story most brutally. Nico Collins, a fine WR9, was taken nearly a full round early at 2.01, a price that would sting on its own, but Jalen Coker at WR55 went 2.6 rounds ahead of his ADP, and Dontayvion Wicks at WR96 was snatched 3.8 rounds early in Round 17, a feat of optimism that borders on performance art. The projected starter group does have legitimate pieces, Drake London at WR7 and Collins at WR9 are real, and Jalen Hurts, when healthy, is a QB9. But a roster is only as strong as its depth allows, and when your weakest projected starter is Coker, a player you already overpaid for, you have simply traded future flexibility for the privilege of reaching on him twice, once on draft day and once every week you start him.

There is a specific kind of fantasy fatigue that sets in when you look at a roster and realize the ceiling and the floor are basically the same room, and ajbarbados is living in that room in 2026. The team sits 10th in the Donkey Kong Division and in just the 17th percentile of the field, and the draft did not do much to change the trajectory: four major reaches, including Matthew Stafford burned at pick 2.09 when his ADP sat more than three rounds later, and Tre Tucker grabbed nearly two and a half rounds ahead of schedule. Those are the kinds of swings that compress a roster's upside before the season even starts. Puka Nacua projects as WR1 and is a genuine anchor, and the Stafford/Nacua stack gives the team a connected piece worth monitoring, but the supporting cast grades out thin. Travis Kelce projects as TE10, Javonte Williams as RB17, and after those names the depth fades quickly. Coming off a 44th-percentile scoring season in 2025, ajbarbados needed a reset draft. This was not one.

There is something almost poetic about how thoroughly MFRose11 has managed to play the draft correctly and still end up here, ninth in the Donkey Kong Division and projected in just the 26th percentile of the field. The value hunting was real. Brian Robinson fell nearly three full rounds before MFRose11 scooped him at 18.03, and Kyler Murray and Bryce Young both slid past their ADPs before landing on this roster. The problem is that accumulating five quarterbacks worth of patience and discipline at the position still leaves you with Murray at QB19 and Young at QB26 as your best options, and no amount of discount pricing makes that a comfortable situation. Meanwhile, the receiver group is genuinely excellent, Justin Jefferson at WR6 and George Pickens at WR10 headlining a group that goes seven deep with projected starters, but this is a positionless format, which means all that talent still has to coexist with a roster ceiling that the quarterback situation keeps pushing down. MFRose11 did the work. The math just did not cooperate.

SteveFOP did almost everything right on draft day. Fifteen chalk picks, two values, and one steal suggests a manager who understood the board and waited for the market to come to him. Colston Loveland fell to 2.12 despite an ADP of 2.08, and Marvin Harrison Jr. slipped a full round before getting scooped at 9.01, landing a projected TE3 and WR33 who are both projected starters. The tight end group alone would make most managers jealous. And yet here sits a team at 47th percentile, ranked eighth in the Donkey Kong division, with a positional floor propped up by Chris Rodriguez at RB48 and Xavier Worthy as the weakest projected starter at WR49. The one genuine mistake, reaching 3.4 rounds early for Cam Ward at a projected QB23, would be forgivable anywhere else on the roster, but it likely cost a pick that could have shored up exactly the thin spots that are now dragging the projections down. SteveFOP solved the draft puzzle correctly and still got the wrong answer.

TaylorFarmsPollardGreens sits at 63rd percentile and seventh in the Donkey Kong division, which is about as middle-of-the-road as a team can get without trying. The engine here is a genuinely impressive backfield, anchored by Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Jonathan Taylor at RB4, the latter a steal taken at 2.10 against an ADP of 2.01. That foundation gives this team a real ceiling. What keeps the ceiling from being higher is the receiver room, where Davante Adams at WR25 is the lone projected starter and was reached 1.6 rounds early to get there. Then there is the George Kittle situation. A projected TE9 when healthy, Kittle is coming off an Achilles tear and his Week 1 availability is genuinely uncertain, meaning the difference between Kittle being a weapon and Kittle being a roster entry could be the difference between winning the division and watching the playoffs from the outside. The margins are tight here, and the margins are exactly what will decide it.

Rayzor2020 lands at 65th percentile and sixth in the Donkey Kong Division, which looks modest until you examine how the roster was actually built. The headline is Pat Bryant, a WR86 projection taken six full rounds before his ADP, the single most aggressive reach in the draft. That is the kind of move that gets a manager roasted on draft recap threads, and yet the surrounding context makes it harder to dismiss: this team also holds Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, De'Von Achane at RB6, and Caleb Williams stacked with Luther Burden, a combination that gives the passing game a natural multiplier effect. The foundation was assembled largely at chalk, with Herbert sliding in as a genuine value, and then Rayzor2020 spent the back end of the draft swinging at upside rather than grinding for safety. Some of those swings, like Bryant and Ted Hurst, may never connect. But a roster that projects a WR3 and an RB6 as starters can afford a few late-round misses, and the conviction threading through this draft, right or wrong, at least tells you exactly who is steering the ship.

Britesmith Brewing isn't the flashiest team in the Donkey Kong Division, but flash is overrated when the draft board keeps falling your way. The foundation is legitimate: Lamar Jackson at QB3, Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4, and Omarion Hampton at RB9 form a core that most managers would trade their last round picks to own, and Hampton himself arrived a full round later than his ADP suggested he should have. Then the mid-rounds kept delivering. Bhayshul Tuten landed at RB25 in the tenth round when his ADP said eighth, and Malik Nabers at WR12 gives the lineup a second receiver worth building around. The team grades out at the 71st percentile of the field, which reflects a roster that won more exchanges than it lost, quietly and consistently. The two major reaches, Jauan Jennings and Ja'Kobi Lane, are real question marks at WR63 and WR89, but in a format this deep, late-round swings are the cost of doing business. Britesmith didn't reinvent anything. They just kept coming out ahead.

The Receivers sit at 79th percentile in this field and fourth in the Donkey Kong Division, and the draft sheet that got them there is genuinely strange to look at. Four major reaches, one minor reach, and yet here they are with CeeDee Lamb (WR5), Rashee Rice (WR13), DeVonta Smith (WR14), and Trey McBride (TE2) anchoring the starting lineup, a group that would make most managers in this tournament quietly jealous. The reaches did not happen at the top of the draft where they might have cost something real. They happened in the back half, on names like Jaylin Noel (WR83) and Chris Brazzell II (WR101), players the manager clearly wanted badly enough to stop waiting. Maybe those calls are wrong. Maybe they are right and the rest of the field simply did not see what this manager saw. What is not in question is that while other managers were following the board, this one was drafting with conviction, and the top of this roster reflects it completely.

Joe_FOP walked into the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl looking like someone who had done the homework before everyone else showed up, and the results speak with quiet authority: 81st percentile overall, third in the Donkey Kong division, and a draft sheet that reads more like a curator's checklist than a gamble. The foundation is genuinely staggering, with Christian McCaffrey at RB3, James Cook at RB5, and Saquon Barkley at RB8 projecting as three of the most valuable players in the field, and that is before you reach Breece Hall at RB14 and Chase Brown at RB11, the latter a legitimate value taken nearly a full round after his ADP. What separates a good draft from a great one is often what happens in the late rounds, and Joe_FOP found it twice: Malik Willis at QB24 fell more than three rounds past his ADP, and Tyrone Tracy at RB43 slipped nearly four rounds before this roster scooped him up. Two steals, two values, zero major reaches. That is not luck. That is process.

Sand99 is not hedging. This roster is built around a single conviction: Joe Burrow and Ja'Marr Chase go off together, or they go down together. With Burrow projecting as QB4 and Chase as WR2, the ceiling on this team is legitimately stratospheric, and the correlation stack means those ceilings are tied to the same game script, the same weather, the same everything. That is a high-wire act by design, and Sand99 walked right onto it on purpose. Supporting that core is a receiver group that would make most managers blush, with Jaylen Waddle at WR23, Garrett Wilson at WR17, and A.J. Brown at WR8 all projecting as starters. Dallas Goedert quietly anchors the tight end spot, a player who was one of the few reliable pieces in Philadelphia's passing game last year and is back for another run on a short-term deal. The path to winning the Donkey Kong division, where Sand99 currently sits second and in the 85th percentile of the field, runs straight through whether Burrow and Chase can deliver on their shared promise.

Fishing for TDs sits first in the Donkey Kong Division and in the 86th percentile of the field, and the draft record tells you exactly why: one steal, four values, and only two major reaches against a backdrop of mostly disciplined, forward-leaning decisions. The RB group is where that discipline shows up loudest, with Jahmyr Gibbs projected at RB1, Ashton Jeanty at RB7, and Josh Jacobs at RB16 all slotted as projected starters. Jeanty came at a modest discount, sliding nearly a full round past his ADP, while Gibbs was simply the right pick at the right time. Drake Maye, projected QB2, arrived at a small but real discount as well, giving this team a reliable foundation at the position. The one true steal was Greg Dulcich, a TE25 projection snagged more than three rounds after his ADP suggested he would go. None of these moves were lottery tickets; they were the product of a manager who stayed patient, trusted the board, and kept coming out ahead of it.
