Last year MRoseAceto finished in the 82nd percentile, and that reputation is now doing a lot of heavy lifting, because the 2026 roster projects 22nd percentile and sits 12th in the Minecraft division. The gap between those two numbers is where this preview lives. The core is genuinely interesting: Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and Jonathan Taylor at RB4 are legitimate anchors, and Tucker Kraft at TE5 alongside Sam LaPorta at TE8 and Dallas Goedert at TE15 gives the roster real depth at the position. But the draft decisions that built around that core are harder to love. Jared Goff was taken 2.2 rounds ahead of his QB16 projection, Mac Jones was grabbed 5.1 rounds early at QB39, and Mike Gesicki was reached 3.2 rounds early at TE33. Three major reaches in one draft is not a philosophy, it is a pattern, and when the reaches cluster at quarterback and late tight end, they suggest capital spent propping up the bottom of the roster rather than reinforcing the top. The 82nd percentile was real. The 22nd percentile is what the numbers see now.

There is no elegant way to dress up an 11th-place division rank and a 29th-percentile tournament projection, so let's not try. Abacab40 built a backfield worth admiring, with Ashton Jeanty, Saquon Barkley, Breece Hall, Travis Etienne, and Bucky Irving all projected starters, and Josh Allen anchoring the whole operation as a QB1. The problem is that the receiver group is genuinely thin at the top, and the draft did little to address it: Tre Harris comes in at WR72 and was taken four rounds before his ADP suggested anyone else valued him there, which is the kind of conviction that looks either visionary or stubborn, and WR72 doesn't argue for visionary. Rhamondre Stevenson, the projected weakest starter at RB31, was also grabbed two full rounds early. The backfield talent is real, but in a positionless format, elite running backs don't insulate you from weak projection ceilings elsewhere, and right now Abacab40 is projecting like a team that has already pulled every lever it had.

There is no easy way to spin desibuf69's situation in the Minecraft division. Sitting 10th in the division and in just the 34th percentile of the field, this roster is short on the kind of top-end firepower that wins weeks in the Scott Fish Bowl. The receiving corps has real names, Nico Collins at WR9 and Chris Olave at WR11 headline a group with genuine depth, but the draft capital spent to get them tells a harder story: Collins was a major reach taken nearly a full round early, and the draft as a whole logged three major reaches against just two steals. Trey McBride at TE2 is a legitimate anchor, and Drake Maye projects as a QB2 after falling nearly two rounds past his ADP, so there are pieces here. The problem is that the backfield grades out weak, with David Montgomery at RB23 as the best option, and the roster's ceiling keeps bumping into its own draft inefficiencies. McBride and Maye can carry a week, but they cannot carry a season.

Gregobomb finished 2025 as one of the most dominant scoring teams in the entire field, a 98th-percentile machine that went 29-7 and looked untouchable. The 2026 version sits at the 35th percentile and ranks ninth in the Minecraft division, which means the name carries more weight than the roster right now. The WR group has genuine upside, with Rashee Rice (WR13), DeVonta Smith (WR14), and Emeka Egbuka (WR18) all projected to start, and the Jalen Hurts and Smith stack gives the team a real ceiling on big weeks. Brock Bowers (TE1) is the kind of foundational piece that quietly holds a team together while everything else sorts itself out. The problem is that the running game is thin at the top, with Kenneth Gainwell (RB34) projecting as the weakest starter on the roster, and Hurts was taken nearly a round past his ADP, suggesting the draft leaned on good fortune to land its best pieces. The reputation from 2025 is real. The roster is being asked to honor it on credit.

Fresh525 sits at 38th percentile in the field and eighth in the Minecraft Division, and the roster does not offer much reason for optimism. The backfield is genuinely elite, anchored by Christian McCaffrey (RB3), De'Von Achane (RB6), and Derrick Henry (RB12), but the receiver corps projects as one of the weakest in the tournament, with Jakobi Meyers (WR45) and Xavier Worthy (WR49) slated as starters. That would be survivable if the draft had at least stocked the cupboard with upside, but the draft chart tells a different story: three major reaches, including Alvin Kamara (RB50) taken nearly three full rounds early and Dalton Schultz (TE22) grabbed two rounds ahead of schedule, suggest a manager who kept forcing value that was not really there. Patrick Mahomes (QB12) arriving past his ADP is a silver lining, but one good value does not offset a draft philosophy that consistently overpaid. This roster looks like a team that ran out of levers before the season even started.

JimNastic played the draft about as cleanly as anyone in the Minecraft division could reasonably hope. Thirteen chalk picks, a handful of genuine values, and a steal in RJ Harvey, plucked at pick 12.10 despite an ADP of 10.05. The process was sound. The product is a 40th-percentile team sitting seventh in the division, which is the kind of result that makes you question everything you thought you knew about draft theory. The top of the roster is legitimately exciting: Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and Colston Loveland at TE3 give JimNastic two projected studs to build around. But the receiving corps fades fast, with Ladd McConkey at WR20 representing the best of a group that bottoms out at Tyquan Thornton at WR97. The one real misstep was Khalil Shakir, reached 2.7 rounds early to land a WR51. JimNastic did almost everything right and still ended up with a roster that projects as solidly mediocre, which is not a referendum on effort, just a cruel reminder that the draft does not grade on a curve.

Ijones7200 sits at 40th percentile and sixth in the Minecraft Division, which is a very specific kind of mediocrity: good enough to feel hopeful, not good enough to feel safe. The foundation is real. Justin Jefferson at WR6 and Drake London at WR7 give this roster two legitimate difference-makers, and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 pushes the top end even further. The margins, though, are where this season gets decided. Parker Washington is a fascinating case in point: a player who somehow led Jacksonville in targets, receptions, and receiving yards last year despite every reasonable expectation pointing elsewhere, yet the ceiling concerns remain, because whether the Jaguars actually want Washington running their receiving corps is an open question. He's a weak starter, and weak starters at WR35 are exactly the kind of player who swings a season one direction or the other. Caleb Williams at QB6 anchors the position ably, but Sam Darnold at QB21 lurks as the contingency plan, and contingency plans have a way of becoming reality at the worst possible moment.

AntonioDonisiFF sits at 44th percentile, fifth in the Minecraft Division, and that is not an accident. This is a team assembled with reasonable care and punished by reasonable variance, the kind of roster that goes 15-21 and finishes 32nd percentile in scoring and leaves you with nothing dramatic to say about it. The ceiling lives in a genuinely elite receiver group: Ja'Marr Chase at WR2, Malik Nabers at WR12, Garrett Wilson at WR17, and Luther Burden at WR22 give this team as much firepower at the top as anyone in the field. The floor lives elsewhere. Brock Purdy at QB13 and Kyler Murray at QB19 were both drafted past their ADPs, which looks clever until you remember that quarterback efficiency at those ranks rarely separates winners in a field this competitive. Omarion Hampton at RB9 carries real upside, but the supporting depth behind him is thin by any measure. The margins will decide this. Chase and Nabers either deliver the kind of weeks that cover for quiet performances everywhere else, or this team finishes exactly where it started.

KotchFF didn't build this roster with one flashy move. They built it by being right, over and over. The headliner is Jayden Daniels, a QB5 projection who fell to them more than two and a half rounds past his ADP, a gift the market handed over and KotchFF had the sense to accept. Justin Herbert, projected QB8, slid nearly a round past his number as well, and suddenly the quarterback room went from serviceable to genuinely strong. But the real texture of this draft is the running back depth. James Cook at RB5 anchors the group, Jeremiyah Love at RB13 was a slight early reach that looks defensible given the upside, and Quinshon Judkins, coming back from a late-season fractured fibula with reports indicating he'll be ready for Cleveland's training camp, slots in at RB22 as a meaningful contributor once healthy. Fourteen chalk picks and only four minor reaches rounds out a draft profile that reads less like a gamble and more like a well-executed plan. That kind of consistent execution earns a seat at the table.

cwild85 didn't swing for the fences and miss, or load up on upside plays that might not pan out. This roster was built on consistent, repeatable edges. The headliner is Bo Nix, landed at pick 10.12 despite an ADP of 6.03, a nearly five-round gift that projects as a QB15 starter. Pair him with Jaylen Waddle in a genuine stack and that value compounds. At the top of the receiving corps, A.J. Brown at WR8 and George Pickens at WR10 give cwild85 a projected starting duo that most managers would be thrilled to build around, and they were both taken at or near consensus, meaning no lottery tickets were cashed to get them. Baker Mayfield carries some real uncertainty after a 2025 step back and questions about his supporting cast in Tampa, but he was acquired late enough at 9.01 that the risk is priced in. The one blemish is Keon Coleman, taken five full rounds ahead of ADP, but one reach doesn't unwind a draft this disciplined. Third in the Minecraft division, 66th percentile overall, cwild85 quietly did the work.

sarbchaggar did not come to the Scott Fish Bowl to make a statement pick. They came to win, and the draft reflects exactly that kind of disciplined, unflashy confidence. Puka Nacua at WR1 fell to pick 1.06, a full five spots past his ADP, and sarbchaggar was simply there to collect. Tee Higgins at WR19 pairs with Joe Burrow in a stack that is not a gimmick but a structural advantage, two players whose production is literally intertwined. The roster sits at 78th percentile and second in the Minecraft division not because any single moment defined the draft, but because sarbchaggar consistently let the board come to them, logging three values against zero major reaches across twenty picks. Even the minor reach on Mike Evans, who arrives in San Francisco with something to prove after injuries ended his 11-year consecutive 1,000-yard streak and his time in Tampa, reads more like conviction than impatience. This is a team built without drama and built to last.

andre78m didn't make any single move that blew up Draft Twitter, but pick by pick, this roster accumulated an edge that compounds into something formidable. Landing Tyler Warren at TE4 a full round after his ADP suggested everyone else blinked first, and walking away with Jaxson Dart at QB11 two-plus rounds late means the quarterback room carries genuine upside at a price that left resources for the rest of the board. Those savings get reinvested in a starting corps anchored by Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Lamar Jackson at QB3, two players whose projections sit near the very top of their positions. The draft ledger tells the story cleanly: four good values, one major value, against only one major reach in Isiah Pacheco. That is not a flashy portfolio, but it is a profitable one, and profit is what lands a team at the top of the Minecraft division and in the 96th percentile of the field. andre78m simply drafted better than nearly everyone else, and that tends to matter.
