The running back situation is shaky at best, with Javonte Williams as a projected starter despite being ranked RB35, further highlighting the depth issues. Questionable draft decisions have compounded these problems, as reaching early for Kyler Murray and Kyren Williams means missed opportunities for more impactful players. Even the potential synergy between Kyler Murray and Trey McBride feels like a small consolation in the face of

broader challenges. As it stands, bird\_law is poised to struggle against both divisional rivals and the wider competition, with few signs pointing to a successful turnaround.


