As the 2025 season kicks off, the JoeMoye fantasy football team finds itself at the bottom of the California Golden Bears division, ranked 12th, and languishing in the disappointing 7th percentile overall. Despite boasting the strongest quarterback duo in the division with Josh Allen, controversially taken first overall, and Joe Burrow, who was a savvy pick slightly below his average draft position, the rest of the roster struggles to keep pace. The running back corps, featuring Cam Skattebo, Jaydon Blue, Tyrone Tracy, and Austin Ekeler, lacks the punch needed for competitive play. Wide receiver depth is solid but not stellar, headlined by Tee Higgins, taken earlier than expected, and supported by Tetairoa McMillan and DeVonta Smith, each battling for consistent production. Unfortunately, tight end Jonnu Smith offers little relief as the weakest starter on the team, though drafted well beyond his perceived value. As the season unfolds, JoeMoye faces an uphill battle,

reliant on its potent quarterback pairing and hoping for unexpected performances from its supporting cast to claw back standing in their division and overall rankings.

As the 2025 fantasy football season looms, JMoyerFB finds itself in a precarious position, clinging to faint hopes of redemption. Despite a commendable effort in assembling a powerhouse of wide receivers like Ja'Marr Chase and Brian Thomas Jr., and bolstering their tight end arsenal with stalwarts Travis Kelce and Mark Andrews, the specter of last year's dismal performance in points scored and win percentage still casts a long shadow. The backfield remains a glaring weakness, with Kenneth Walker III as the only reliable option while Najee Harris and Zach Charbonnet leave much to be desired in terms of consistent production. Even with strategic drafting coups by nabbing Zach Charbonnet late and securing Pat Freiermuth at a steal, JMoyerFB's potential remains hampered by questionable decisions, such as reaching for Rome Odunze far earlier than necessary. Hovering near

the basement of the California Golden Bears division, and with their tournament standing lagging in the 22nd percentile, the path ahead appears daunting. As the season unfolds, it seems this team may once again grapple with the formidable challenge of translating its scattered strengths into tangible success on the fantasy battlefield.

Their tight ends shine brightly, boasting Trey McBride, David Njoku, and Tucker Kraft as the division's premier trio—a crucial advantage in this TE Premium setup. However, the team's wide receiver lineup, featuring Rashee Rice, Courtland Sutton, and Jerry Jeudy, leaves much to be desired. Their performance will need to defy expectations if JaEisenberg is to rise through the ranks. Meanwhile, Tyjae Spears holds a pivotal role in the backfield; his ability to exceed his RB41 rank could make or break the season. The team managed to secure some players at bargain prices, notably snagging David Njoku and Tyjae Spears later than projected, while also capitalizing on Jordan Love's slide past his ADP. However, reaching for Darnell Mooney has cost them valuable potential. With a strategic

gamble on Joe Flacco and the synergy between Kyler Murray and Trey McBride, JaEisenberg hopes to leverage these advantages to climb the ranks and make a significant impact this season.
