WinkyLIVE enters 2026 sitting 12th in the Call of Duty: Modern Warfare 2 division and in just the 20th percentile of the field, and the roster offers precious little reason for optimism. The headliners are legitimately good: Lamar Jackson projects as QB3, Christian McCaffrey as RB3, and together they form the kind of top-end anchor that should keep this team competitive on any given week. The problem is that the floor drops off fast. The wide receiver group is graded weak, and the weakest projected starter, Wan'Dale Robinson, carries real questions heading into 2026. Robinson cracked 1,000 yards for the first time last season, then watched Tennessee spend the 4th overall pick on Wan'Dale Robinson's new target competition, meaning the Titans did not exactly secure his role before the ink dried on his relocation. Meanwhile, the draft offered no relief: zero steals, zero values, and a Jake Ferguson reach that cost two rounds of capital. Jackson and McCaffrey are a genuine foundation, but when the draft produces nothing and the supporting cast is this thin, a foundation is just the thing that gets buried.

There is no kind way to frame where YerocFBG stands heading into 2026. Sitting 11th in the Call of Duty: Modern Warfare 2 division and projected in just the 21st percentile of the field, this roster is asking a lot of very little. The headliner is A.J. Brown at WR8, but reaching 0.7 rounds early to land him suggests YerocFBG saw the ceiling and paid above market to touch it, which rarely ends well when the floor underneath is this soft. Trey McBride at TE2 and Kyle Pitts at TE7 are genuine assets, and the Jared Goff and Jameson Williams stack gives the lineup a pulse on good Lions days, but Goff grades out as a QB16 and Williams as a WR21, which is a fine supporting cast for a great team and a thin lifeline for a struggling one. When your weakest projected starter is Jayden Reed at WR48, you are not one breakout game away from turning things around. The lever does not exist. YerocFBG is simply hoping the projections are wrong.

There is a specific kind of fantasy heartbreak reserved for the manager who does everything right procedurally and still ends up here, and @benkain7 has earned it. The draft was disciplined. Jayden Daniels landed at 4.06 when his ADP sat at 2.12, a genuine steal at QB5. The receiver corps looks the part on paper, with Jaxon Smith-Njigba projecting as WR3 and Malik Nabers as WR12 anchoring a group that could carry a roster. But the overall shape of this team keeps sliding sideways. Nabers was a 1.4-round reach, the 2025 campaign produced a 25 percent win rate and 19th-percentile scoring, and the division rank sits at tenth. The roster reads like a highlights reel that never quite assembles into a film. Daniels and the receiver core give this team a real ceiling, but a 28th-percentile projection suggests the floor is uncomfortably close to the ceiling, and @benkain7 somehow drafted efficiently into that outcome.

abombdiggity sits ninth in the Call of Duty: Modern Warfare 2 division and in the 29th percentile of the field, and nothing in this roster profile suggests that number is about to move in the right direction. The running back group looks like the obvious saving grace, with Bijan Robinson projecting as RB2 and Omarion Hampton at RB9 offering genuine top-end value, but the supporting cast thins out fast. Jeremiyah Love grades out at RB13 and was the team's most aggressive early-round swing, taken more than a round ahead of his ADP, which means that production has to materialize or the whole house of cards wobbles. At receiver, the picture is murkier: Garrett Wilson leads the group at WR17 but the next wave clusters in the WR30s and lower, and Elijah Sarratt, taken nearly three full rounds early, is more of a hope than a plan. The quarterback situation, anchored by Trevor Lawrence at QB10, is fine without being exciting. There is no hidden lever here. This is a team that came in 32nd percentile in scoring last year and does not look meaningfully upgraded.

BMF sits eighth in the Call of Duty: Modern Warfare 2 division and projects at just the 32nd percentile of the field, and the draft chart does not offer much comfort. Three major reaches and zero steals in the same draft is a rough combination, and two of those reaches came in the late rounds on Emmett Johnson and Mike Washington Jr., a pair of depth backs whose early selections will look even worse if they never crack the projected lineup. The one area where BMF genuinely has something is the backfield, with Ashton Jeanty, Kenneth Walker III, Kyren Williams, and Javonte Williams all projecting as starters. But that foundation gets undermined by a receiver group so thin that David Njoku at TE29 is essentially a featured piece of the passing game attack. Drake Maye lands here as the headliner, and the Patriots adding AJ Brown this offseason gives Maye a legitimate alpha target for the first time, which matters. The problem is that even an optimistic outcome at quarterback cannot paper over a roster that grades out near the bottom of this field with nowhere obvious left to improve.

AaronWilcox86FF sits seventh in the Call of Duty: Modern Warfare 2 division and at just the 33rd percentile tournament-wide, and the roster does not hide why. The receiver group is legitimately good, headlined by CeeDee Lamb (WR5) and Chris Olave (WR11) with Tetairoa McMillan (WR15) and Terry McLaurin (WR24) adding real depth, but the quarterback situation undercuts all of it. Sam Darnold (QB21) is the nominal top option, yet even he arrives with an asterisk: the Seattle passing game leaned heavily on Jaxon Smith-Njigba last season, and with Kenneth Walker gone, Darnold needs to carry more of the offensive load before his fantasy value actually catches up to his job security. The fallback is C.J. Stroud (QB22), projected as the team's weakest starter. Meanwhile, the draft offered no relief, producing zero steals and zero values against 15 chalk picks and a major reach on Elic Ayomanor (WR95) taken nearly four rounds early. Last year's 42 percent win rate already told this story. The 2026 version does not look like a plot twist.

ThUnderDogs finished 2026 at 35th percentile and sixth in the Call of Duty: Modern Warfare 2 division, which puts them exactly where their roster suggests they belong: functional, watchable, and perpetually one bad week from irrelevance. Jahmyr Gibbs anchors the lineup as a projected RB1, and Derrick Henry at RB12 was the one moment the draft rewarded patience, sliding four spots past his ADP like a running back finding a crease nobody else saw. That backfield foundation is real. The problem is the margins. George Kittle projects as TE9 when healthy, but after an Achilles tear to close the 2025 NFL season, "when healthy" is doing a lot of work in that sentence, and a TE20 in Juwan Johnson is a shaky fallback if Kittle misses time. Meanwhile, Keenan Allen at WR99 was reached nearly six rounds early, the kind of swing that looks bold in April and costs a lineup spot in October. ThUnderDogs are not the worst team in the field and not the best. They are the team that wins nine and wonders what could have been.

RyanNewby didn't swing for the fences and miss, didn't chase upside at the cost of a roster foundation. This team was built pick by pick, and the cumulative effect is a squad sitting at 62nd percentile with genuine room to climb. The anchor is obvious: Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and Justin Jefferson at WR6 form a top-end core that most managers in this field would trade their lunch money for. Tyler Warren at TE4 arriving at pick 3.12 when his ADP sat at 3.04 is a minor win that quietly reinforces the theme, a manager who let the draft come to him rather than forcing it. Chase Brown projects as RB11 and TreVeyon Henderson as RB19, two projected starters who give RyanNewby a sturdy floor week to week. The reaches on MarShawn Lloyd and Jalen Nailor are the one wrinkle, four rounds and two rounds early respectively, but late-round gambles rarely sink a ship when the top of the roster looks like this. Fifth in the division for now, but this team belongs in the conversation.

Tight End University did not win this draft on one flashy pick. They won it by coming out ahead on deal after deal, round after round. The tight end group anchors everything: Colston Loveland (TE3), Tucker Kraft (TE5), Sam LaPorta (TE8), Dalton Kincaid (TE11), and Dallas Goedert (TE15) are all projected starters, and that kind of positional depth gives the manager flexibility that compounds as the season progresses. Layer in Josh Allen (QB1) stacked with Kincaid, and the team has a live correlation play baked into the core. Then consider Hunter Henry (TE18), taken at 13.03 when ADP had him closer to round ten, a steal that added a TE18 projection at a significant discount. The WR group is the thinnest tier here, with Carnell Tate (WR29) as the headliner in a Titans offense that needs the Allen-to-Ward connection to develop fast, but in a positionless format that concern barely registers. Fourth in the division at the 71st percentile, this team was built to grind, and the draft tape suggests it will.

mbabs10 didn't swing for the fences and whiff, didn't trade future picks for a splash, just quietly built something that holds up at every level. The clearest evidence is at the top: Puka Nacua lands as WR1 and was somehow still sitting there at pick 1.06, nearly a full round past where the field expected him to go. That's not luck, that's patience rewarded. Justin Herbert comes in as QB8 after sliding almost a full round past his ADP, giving the lineup a legitimate quarterback anchor without paying a premium. George Pickens at WR10 cost a half-round premium, the lone minor reach on a draft that otherwise refused to panic. Third in the division and in the 73rd tournament percentile, this roster carries real weight behind Nacua, with Saquon Barkley at RB8 and Davante Adams at WR25 rounding out a starting group that was built through consistent discipline rather than any single inspired gamble. mbabs10 just kept coming out ahead, pick after pick, and the standings reflect it.

Last year, brandondcarney finished in the 17th percentile with a record that could generously be described as character-building. The 2026 version of this roster reads like a direct response to that misery. The foundation starts at tight end, where Brock Bowers projects as TE1, and the receiver group is anchored by a genuine Bengals stack: Joe Burrow at QB4 throwing to Tee Higgins, who projects at WR19. Jaylen Waddle slots in at WR23, and DeVonta Smith at WR14 gives this team legitimate weapons throughout the lineup. The draft was efficient, with Breece Hall and Cam Skattebo both sliding past their ADPs by over a round each. David Montgomery's move to Houston, where he projects to compete for a starting role after watching carries slip away in Detroit, adds depth that actually has upside. The result is a team sitting second in the Call of Duty: Modern Warfare 2 division and in the 78th

percentile of the field. Bouncing back was the goal. This roster suggests brandondcarney built something capable of doing exactly that.

DTC_IzzyE didn't need a single home-run swing to land in the 95th percentile of the field and claim the top spot in the Call of Duty: Modern Warfare 2 division. This roster was built on consistency, not luck. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 is the kind of anchor that makes every decision downstream easier, and Drake London at WR7 and Ladd McConkey at WR20 keep the quality from falling off a cliff behind him. What makes the draft genuinely impressive is that five players came to IzzyE at better prices than the market expected, including James Cook sliding a full round past his ADP to land at RB5 and Jaxson Dart arriving late enough to qualify as a gift at QB11. Then there is Luther Burden, projected WR22, who spent last year being carefully managed before finishing the season on a trajectory that had Ben Johnson comparing him to Amon-Ra St. Brown in training camp. If Burden delivers on that hype, this lineup gets scarier. The floor here is already high. The ceiling might be higher than anyone is admitting.
