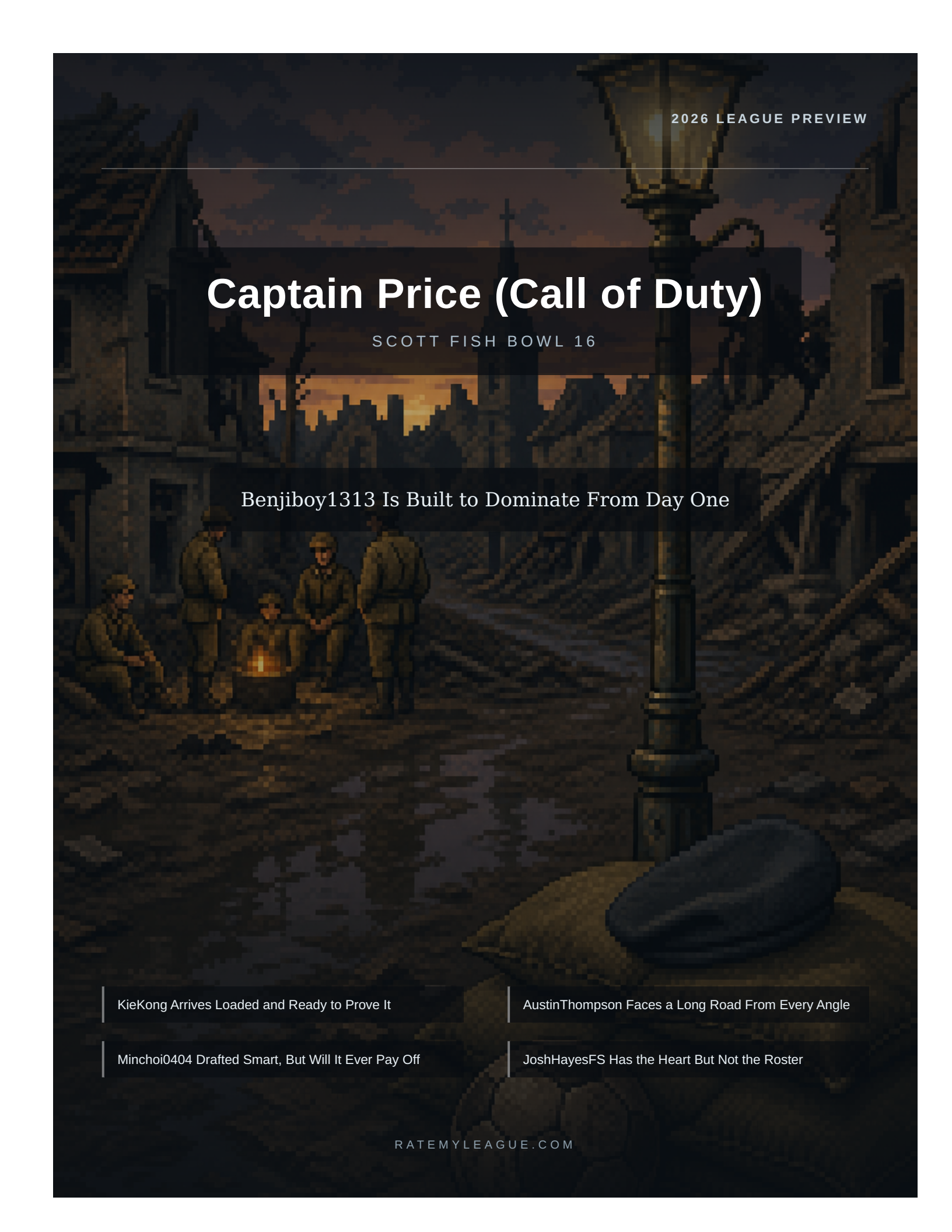

The numbers do not lie, and they do not flatter. AustinThompson landed in the 4th percentile of the field last season, 7-29 with 3484 points, and the 2026 draft did nothing to suggest that trajectory bends upward. Four major reaches define this roster before you even get to the talent level. Bo Nix, a QB15, was taken nearly three full rounds ahead of his ADP, which would be defensible if the payoff were a genuine difference-maker, but Nix is a QB15. Kirk Cousins, a QB35, was yanked off the board nine rounds early, burning capital on a back-of-the-rotation arm that should have been available for free. Those two decisions alone swallowed draft equity that could have shored up a receiver group whose weakest projected starter is Jalen Nailor at WR61. Christian McCaffrey and Kyle Pitts give this team a pulse, but when your draft chart reads zero steals, twelve chalk, and four major reaches, you are not building a contender. You are building a alibi.

JoshHayesFS sits 11th in the Captain Price division and in just the 9th percentile of the field, and the roster tells you exactly why. The receiver group grades out weak, with Mike Evans (WR27) as the top option and the depth falling off quickly to names like Denzel Boston (WR58) and Jerry Jeudy (WR66), neither of whom inspire much confidence as projected starters. That problem is partly self-inflicted: Caleb Williams (QB6) was the team's first-round pick despite an ADP sitting nearly two rounds later, a major reach that sacrificed early capital that could have addressed exactly the position that is now dragging the roster down. Brock Bowers (TE1) is a genuine anchor, and the backfield has usable depth with Jeremiyah Love (RB13) and Javonte Williams (RB17) in the mix, but this is a team treading water with a hole in the boat. Coming off a 42 percent win rate and 41st percentile scoring in 2025, JoshHayesFS needed a strong offseason. The draft did not deliver one.

heathkyser enters 2026 sitting 10th in the Captain Price division and in just the 14th percentile of the field, and the roster map does not offer much reason for optimism. The draft tells the story pretty clearly: two major reaches in the first eight rounds, headlined by Tyler Shough at QB20 burned in round five and Cam Ward at QB23 taken two full rounds ahead of his market value. Burning premium picks on quarterbacks ranked 20th and 23rd at their position is the kind of asset bleed that leaves a team scrambling everywhere else, and heathkyser never quite recovered from it. The bright spots exist, Chris Olave at WR11 and Tee Higgins at WR19 give the lineup a functional top end, and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 and Omarion Hampton at RB9 project as legitimate contributors. But the floor falls off fast after those names, and with a 36th-percentile scoring finish in 2025 already on the books, this roster looks less like a team on the rise and more like one still searching for the ladder.

There is no kind way to frame what dianalouise built here. The draft's defining move was treating quarterback like a position worth hoarding, burning a fourth-round pick on Patrick Mahomes at QB12 and then circling back in rounds 13 and 14 to grab J.J. McCarthy at QB37 and Ty Simpson at QB36, reaches of 7.2 and 5.1 rounds respectively. In a positionless format where you start your best ten players regardless of position, that is not depth-building, it is capital destruction. The ripple effect lands hardest in the middle of the roster, where Blake Corum projects as a WR35-equivalent drain on a starting lineup that needed a different kind of investment. Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and Trey McBride at TE2 are genuine pillars, and they are the reason this team projects anywhere near viable. But two good players carrying the weight of five major reaches is a structural problem, not a challenge, and a 15th-percentile projection for a team that finished 59th percentile last year reads less like regression and more like a self-inflicted wound.

Minchoi0404 ran a disciplined draft, collecting five values and letting the board come to them, which is exactly what the textbooks say to do and apparently what the textbooks forgot to finish writing. Saquon Barkley fell a full round past his ADP and landed as RB8, Jake Ferguson slipped nearly two rounds to become a starter at TE12, and Davante Adams drifted late enough to look like a gift. On paper, this is a drafter who did their homework. In practice, the starting lineup projects to 31st percentile in the tournament, because doing everything correctly is still not enough when the correct moves produce Adams at WR25 as the top receiver option on the roster. The Tony Pollard reach at nearly three rounds early is a minor sin in isolation, but it consumed capital that a receiver room this thin could not afford to lose. Minchoi0404 played the value game like a professional and finished with the kind of roster that makes you wonder whether the game was ever worth playing.

antagonist0815 sits seventh in the Captain Price division and checks in at just the 41st percentile of the field, and the path back to relevance is genuinely murky. The backfield is the one undeniable bright spot, with Bijan Robinson (RB2), Kenneth Walker III (RB10), and Breece Hall (RB14) forming a genuinely elite group at the top of the roster. The problem is that the production has to come from somewhere beyond that backfield, and the supporting cast keeps raising its hand with asterisks beside it. Marvin Harrison Jr. (WR33) is a name that should carry more weight than his rank suggests, but two seasons of underwhelming output and a quarterback situation in Arizona that currently points toward Jacoby Brissett make him a frustrating piece to rely on. Then there is Jordan Love (QB17), reached a punishing two and a half rounds early, projected as a middling signal-caller with no obvious path to outperforming that projection. The backfield is real. Everything around it is a prayer dressed up as a roster.

Jdabss finished 61st percentile in scoring last year and sits 43rd percentile entering 2026, which tells you everything about where this team lives: close enough to matter, not good enough to assume anything. The ceiling is real. Josh Allen is a QB1, George Pickens projects as WR10, and the Allen/D.J. Moore stack adds the kind of correlated upside that can torch a weekly matchup in a hurry. Harold Fannin at TE6 is a legitimate weapon, though the Browns' quarterback situation means every week with him feels like reading weather forecasts in a city famous for surprises. What keeps this from being a confident team is the drafting pattern. Two major reaches, both at quarterback, spent real capital on Jaxson Dart at QB11 and Justin Fields at QB38 when the board likely had better options available. Dart and Fields serve as Allen insurance, but the cost of that peace of mind is felt elsewhere. Sixth in the division is not a disaster, but it is a number that demands things break right. In this format, they often do not.

egilman6999 didn't build this roster with one flashy move. They built it by consistently getting more than they paid for. James Cook at RB5 slipping to the 2.09 when his ADP sat at 2.04 is a small thing, but small things compound, and this draft had a lot of them. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 anchors the receiving corps, and Rashee Rice at WR13 gives the lineup a genuine second weapon. The dart throws landed, too: Makai Lemon at WR40 fell more than a round past his ADP, and Stefon Diggs at WR56 came even cheaper than that. The one area worth watching is quarterback. Sam Darnold led Seattle to a Super Bowl but his fantasy upside depends heavily on whether the offense diversifies beyond Jaxon Smith-Njigba with Kenneth Walker now gone, and reaching two rounds early for Bryce Young at QB26 suggests the staff was nervous enough about the position to overpay anyway. A 48th-percentile tournament standing undersells a roster that consistently drafted ahead of the market.

There are clean drafts, and then there are statements. @clutchfantasy made a statement. The foundation is unmistakable: CeeDee Lamb at WR5 and Justin Jefferson at WR6 give this roster two of the best receivers in the field, both secured at value, Jefferson sliding a full round past his ADP. From there, the discipline compounds. Travis Kelce fell more than two rounds before @clutchfantasy collected him at TE10, George Kittle came a round late at TE9, and Zay Flowers and Jameson Williams each slipped over a round before landing here. Nine values and a steal across the full draft, against a single major reach in Brock Purdy, who at least arrives paired with Kittle in a stack. This is not a roster assembled by accident. The 2025 campaign already validated the approach, a 30-6 record and a 99th percentile scoring season, and the 2026 build looks, if anything, sharper. Sitting at the 92nd percentile of the field entering the season, @clutchfantasy has the kind of roster that does not need luck to be dangerous.

KieKong sits third in the Captain Price division and at the 93rd percentile of the entire field, and the draft board tells you exactly why. The foundation is elite: Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and De'Von Achane at RB6 give this team a ceiling most managers would trade their entire bench to reach. But what separates a good SFB team from a great one is what you do in the middle and late rounds, and that is where KieKong made its money. A.J. Brown fell nearly two full rounds past his ADP and landed at pick 4.07, Tucker Kraft slid two and a half rounds before KieKong scooped him at TE5, and Michael Wilson quietly dropped over two rounds before getting claimed at WR39. Four steals against a single major reach on Tyreek Hill is a ledger most managers would sign without blinking. The 2025 squad went 25-11 and finished in the 94th percentile in scoring, so the discipline on display here is not new. This is a roster built by someone who knows exactly what they are doing.

lilvoltron didn't build this roster by swinging for fences and missing. They built it by winning the small battles, over and over. Jaylen Waddle at WR23 slid two full rounds past his ADP before lilvoltron scooped him at 7.05, a quiet heist that would anchor lesser teams' entire drafts. DeVonta Smith at WR14 fell a round and change, Brian Thomas Jr. at WR31 fell another round, and Jaxon Smith-Njigba arrives as a projected WR3 after being drafted on chalk. None of those picks made headlines in the room. Together they form something genuinely difficult to beat. Joe Burrow at QB4 and Justin Herbert at QB8 give the team insurance at the position most managers treat as an afterthought until it isn't. The ADP sheet tells the story plainly: one major reach against seven picks that came in late or very late. That ratio doesn't happen by accident. It happens when a manager knows what they're doing and

stays patient enough to let the draft come to them. Second in the Captain Price division and sitting at the 96th percentile says the results agree.

Benjiboy1313 sits at the top of the Captain Price division and ranks in the 97th percentile of the entire field, and the draft record explains exactly why. With 2 steals, 6 values, and only 1 minor reach across the whole roster, this is the kind of board that looks inevitable in hindsight but requires genuine discipline to execute in real time. The foundation starts at the top, where Puka Nacua projects as WR1 and Drake London checks in at WR7, London himself landing nearly two rounds after his ADP. Malik Nabers at WR12 adds another projected starter who slid almost a full round, and the value didn't stop there. Isaiah Likely at TE3 fell more than two full rounds past his ADP before Benjiboy1313 scooped him up at pick 11.03. That is not luck, that is patience rewarded. Coming off a 2025 campaign that finished in the 99th percentile in scoring, there is no reason to think the approach changes, and every reason to think the results won't either.
