

The questionable draft decisions don't end there; the team's misguided reach for Joe Mixon and Darius Slayton suggests a strategy plagued by overestimation and miscalculations. Unlike the few instances where they capitalized on value with Jayden Daniels and Javonte Williams, these errors

may prove costly. Even with a minor stack bonus from pairing McLaurin with Daniels, it's hard to see BigBen27 making significant strides this season amidst such formidable competition.

As TheFFGenius heads into the 2025 season, the outlook seems rather bleak. With a lackluster ranking at 10th in their division and a disappointing 23rd percentile overall, the team appears to have an uphill battle ahead. The quarterback situation is particularly concerning, with Jared Goff and Michael Penix Jr. barely making a mark at QB17 and QB21, respectively. Starting Penix Jr., the weakest link in an already fragile chain, doesn't inspire confidence. Although the tight end duo of Sam LaPorta and Tucker Kraft provides a glimmer of hope in this TE Premium format, it's not enough to counterbalance the team's glaring deficiencies. The wide receiver core, anchored by Brian Thomas Jr. and Drake London, sits at a middling 7th in the division, leaving much to be desired. Despite finding some value late with picks like Najee Harris and Tucker Kraft, costly early reaches, particularly on Derrick Henry, could haunt them throughout the season. Without more firepower or strategic foresight, TheFFGenius may struggle to rise from the depths of mediocrity this year.
