Kaitou's 2026 draft reads like a cautionary tale told in real time, and the final roster does nothing to soften the lesson. The headliners are real: Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Joe Burrow at QB4 give this team a legitimate foundation. But from there, Kaitou spent the rest of the draft chasing a vision only they could see. Harold Fannin, a TE6 projection, was pulled nearly two rounds early. Kenyon Sadiq, projected TE21, was yanked almost four rounds before the market would have demanded it, and he projects as the weakest starter on the roster. Four major reaches across the draft, zero steals, and a receiver group headlined by Carnell Tate at WR29 who cost a fourth-round pick when the sixth round would have done the same work. The 2025 season ended at the 19th percentile in scoring, and nothing about this construction suggests the math improves. McCaffrey deserves better teammates. What he got was a draft board that clearly had other ideas.

NC_Jets_Fan checks in at 4th percentile in the field and sits 11th in the Resident Evil division, and the roster tells you exactly why. The drafting pattern is the cleanest summary of the problem: four major reaches against zero minor ones, which means this manager consistently paid a premium to get their guys rather than letting value come to them. Bucky Irving was taken 2.6 rounds before his ADP, and Elic Ayomanor got scooped nearly three rounds early at WR95, a player who may not even crack the projected starting lineup. Meanwhile, the wide receiver group grades out weak across the board, with Josh Downs sitting at WR46 as the projected top option at the position. Lamar Jackson and Tucker Kraft are legitimate stars, and the running back corps has some depth worth respecting, but in a positionless format you need your ceiling to be high enough to carry you through a brutal schedule, and the receiver grades drag that ceiling down hard. There is no obvious trade chip here, no sleeper to bet on, and no draft inefficiency left to exploit.

The most generous thing you can say about skreem77's draft is that they did show up. Beyond that, charity runs dry fast. Four major reaches in a single draft is not bad luck, it is a philosophy, and it is a bad one. Christian Watson was pulled two-plus rounds ahead of his ADP at WR28, which is a steep price for a receiver who isn't even a top-25 projection. Tyler Shough got yanked two full rounds early as well, landing as the QB20 on a roster that needed that pick to do real work. The cumulative effect is a team that paid early-round premiums for middling outcomes and ended up with zero steals across the entire board to compensate. Bijan Robinson at RB2 is legitimately excellent, and Nico Collins projects as a real contributor at WR9, but when your draft philosophy is to reach aggressively and never get paid back on the other end, the good picks start to look like accidents. Division rank of 10 and a 7th-percentile tournament standing suggest the market agrees.

LoveTaylorStoryTime enters 2026 sitting ninth in the Resident Evil division and in just the 32nd percentile of the field, and the draft record offers little reason for optimism. The most glaring issue is a pattern of reaching at quarterback: Jayden Daniels cost a first-round pick at 1.11 despite an ADP of 2.12, and the manager then doubled down by taking Malik Willis in round eight and Michael Penix Jr. in round fourteen, both well ahead of market. Those three picks represent three of the roster's four major or significant reaches, meaning premium draft capital was steered toward a position where the returns are shakiest. Daniels projects as QB5 and is a legitimate asset, but Willis at QB24 and Penix at QB33 are speculative depth at a price the roster could not afford. The skilled-position talent is real, Saquon Barkley and CeeDee Lamb anchor the lineup, but with Xavier Worthy projected at

WR49 as the third receiver starter and the draft currency already spent, there is no obvious move left to close the gap on the division's upper tier.

Blutarsky enters 2026 sitting eighth in the Resident Evil division and hovering around the 44th percentile of the field, and the draft record does not offer much reason for optimism. The manager drafted 10 players at chalk, added two major reaches in Sean Tucker (RB65) and Kayshon Boutte (WR76), and found only three genuine values across the entire board. The core is real enough: Jonathan Taylor (RB4) and Omarion Hampton (RB9) give this team a puncher's chance any given week, and Drake Maye (QB2) projects as one of the better signal-callers in the tournament. But the supporting cast falls off sharply, with Matthew Golden (WR52) projecting as the weakest starter on the roster, and Jared Goff (QB16) as the backup option, a safe weekly producer with a firmly established ceiling. Goff is the template for this team, actually: competent, consistent, unlikely to win you anything big. When your best-case scenario at multiple spots is "fine," you are not building toward a title, you are hoping someone above you stumbles.

jonredcorn08 is the team that belongs exactly where the standings put it, 7th in the Resident Evil division and right at the 51st percentile of the field, and the frustrating thing is that feels both fair and fragile. The receiver group is genuinely impressive: Drake London (WR7), Chris Olave (WR11), and Tetairoa McMillan (WR15) are all projected starters, and Trey McBride (TE2) anchors the tight end spot as one of the best at his position in the tournament. But Baker Mayfield (QB18) is a real ceiling question at the position that still matters most on any given week, and the margins this roster operates in are thin enough that "projected starter" Wan'Dale Robinson (WR47) could be the difference between winning and watching. The draft was largely chalk, with 15 picks near ADP and no true steals, which means jonredcorn08 gets exactly what it paid for, nothing more. After a 58-percent win rate in 2025, this is a team that knows how to hang around. Whether hanging around is enough is the whole question.

DroppinBombs88 didn't need a heist to build this roster, just a steady hand and a good eye. The foundation is obvious: Brock Bowers at TE1 fell half a round past his ADP at pick 2.01, meaning this team secured the top tight end in the format without even paying full price. From there, the picks just kept landing. Amon-Ra St. Brown projects as WR4, Zay Flowers and Garrett Wilson both project as starters, and the whole group was assembled with 14 chalk picks and three genuine values, a draft that suggests discipline over desperation. The one blemish is Darnell Washington, a four-round reach who projects as TE38, but in a positionless format that kind of late-draft gamble barely registers. What registers is 2025's 81 percent win rate and a 95th-percentile scoring season, proof that DroppinBombs88 knows how to turn a well-constructed roster into actual points. Sitting 73rd percentile entering 2026, this team isn't sneaking up on anyone, and it doesn't need to.

Wide Receiver U didn't build this roster with one flashy swing. They built it by being right, consistently, all the way through the draft. Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, Justin Jefferson at WR6, Malik Nabers at WR12, Rashee Rice at WR13 — that is a projected starting group that would make most managers in the field genuinely uncomfortable. Jefferson is the clearest example of the approach paying off: taken at 2.05 against an ADP of 1.12, he was value hiding in plain sight while other rooms let him slip. Tyrone Tracy fell nearly two rounds past his ADP and landed as a useful contributor. The team sits 75th percentile in the field heading into 2026, and last year's 56 percent win rate suggests this is not a squad that got lucky and arrived here. The ceiling is real. Ladd McConkey at WR20 and DK Metcalf at WR36 are projected starters who would anchor lesser rosters. Wide Receiver U came out ahead on pick after pick, and that is usually what winning looks like before the season starts.

Strommer02 didn't need a blockbuster to build something worth watching in the Resident Evil division. The fingerprints of a disciplined draft are all over this roster, starting with a receiving corps that quietly stacks up as one of the deeper in the field. George Pickens at WR10, Tee Higgins at WR19, Davante Adams at WR25, and Mike Evans at WR27 are all projected starters, and none of them required reaching early to acquire. George Kittle fell nearly two full rounds past his ADP before Strommer02 scooped him at TE9, and Quentin Johnston arrived more than a round late at WR41, giving this team legitimate depth without burning premium capital to get it. Layered over all of it is a Dak Prescott and Pickens stack that creates the kind of ceiling correlation other managers will be chasing. Sitting at the 78th percentile and fourth in the division, Strommer02 looks like a team that won the draft by simply refusing to lose it, pick after pick after pick.

Dmiller10nc didn't manufacture a flashy draft narrative, just turned in one correct decision after another until the board looked like this: Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 slipping to pick 1.06 when his ADP sat at 1.02, Colston Loveland at TE3 still on the board at 3.06 despite an ADP nearly a round earlier, Jordan Love at QB17 falling a full round past where the field expected him to go. Five values, zero major reaches, and a roster that finished 2025 in the 83rd percentile in scoring suggests this wasn't luck. The wide receiver group is the engine, with Chase, A.J. Brown at WR8, DeVonta Smith at WR14, and Jameson Williams at WR21 all projecting as starters, and Loveland anchoring the tight end group alongside Isaiah Likely at TE13. The minor reaches on Courtland Sutton and Jalen Nailor are the only blemishes, and neither one is alarming. Third in the Resident Evil division and sitting in the 87th percentile tournament-wide, this roster earned every bit of where it stands.

jayb46 didn't make any single move that will have people talking, but when you add it all up, this roster landed in the 93rd percentile of the field, and that doesn't happen by accident. The foundation is genuinely strong: Puka Nacua projects as WR1, Caleb Williams sits at QB6, and Ashton Jeanty checks in at RB7, a trio that would be the envy of most managers in this tournament. What makes the draft especially impressive is how jayb46 kept finding value after those early picks were locked in. Justin Herbert fell more than a round past his ADP and arrived as a QB8, Cam Skattebo slipped nearly two rounds to land at RB20, and Marvin Harrison Jr. came down more than a round to fill out a receiver group that already featured Emeka Egbuka and Rome Odunze. The Williams and Odunze stack adds another layer of upside. There were a couple of reaches late, but by then the roster was already built. This is what a clean, disciplined draft looks like.

phileyoung didn't build this roster with one thunderbolt pick. They built it by winning the small negotiations, over and over again. James Cook at RB5 slipped almost a full round past his ADP. De'Von Achane came at a discount. Derrick Henry fell nearly a round late. Kyren Williams dropped a round and a half. Travis Kelce, projected TE10, landed nearly two rounds after the market said he should. That is not luck compounding, that is a manager who came to the table with a clear price for every player and had the discipline to wait. The result is a starting core that reads like a greatest-hits of the position-rank charts: Cook, Achane, Henry, and Williams all project inside RB15, with Kelce and Sam LaPorta anchoring the TE group. The WR side is thin by projected rank, but in a positionless format that barely registers when your non-receiver options look like this. Sitting first in the Resident Evil division and in the 96th percentile of the field, phileyoung is the quiet team everyone will notice by October.
