There is no flattering way to frame what mikeiliu did in this draft. Seven major reaches across the board, zero steals, and a final product that sits dead last in the Super Mario Bros. division heading into 2026. The signature crime is the tight end haul, where mikeiliu spent round after round reaching for players like Tyler Warren, Harold Fannin, Mark Andrews, and Kenyon Sadiq well before the market demanded it, stockpiling projected starters at the position while the rest of the roster quietly collapsed. Warren at TE4 and Fannin at TE6 are genuinely good players, but you do not win a positionless format by cornering one position while your quarterback situation bottoms out at Kyler Murray, Sam Darnold, and Tua Tagovailoa, none of whom projects above QB19. CeeDee Lamb at WR5 is real, but mikeiliu then burned picks on Carnell Tate, Malachi Fields, and Jack Bech at a combined cost of nearly nine rounds of draft capital above their ADPs. Last in the division, first percentile in the field. The draft said everything.

There is a particular kind of draft heartbreak reserved for managers who do everything right and still end up here. kalebatwell2 played the value game almost flawlessly, landing 16 picks at chalk and finding genuine surplus with Jayden Daniels at QB5 a full round after his ADP. The backfield looks like the engine of a contender, with Jonathan Taylor at RB4, Chase Brown at RB11, Travis Etienne at RB18, and Cam Skattebo at RB20 all projecting as starters. But this is a positionless format, and when you scroll past those names the roster gets thin in a way that cannot be wished away. The projected starter opposite that backfield group is Jayden Reed at WR48, which is not a supporting cast, it is a confession. Sitting 11th in the Super Mario Bros. division and in just the 21st percentile of the field, kalebatwell2 is the cautionary tale that no draft manual prepares you for: the one where the process was sound, the outcomes were reasonable, and the team still does not clear the bar.

There is a particular kind of exhaustion that comes not from a catastrophic collapse but from a slow, grinding realization that the math just does not add up, and EvoHammerDrew is living that realization in real time. The roster sits at the 22nd percentile tournament-wide and tenth in the Super Mario Bros. division, and the draft did not do much to improve the outlook, producing thirteen chalk picks and four reaches against a single genuine steal. Christian McCaffrey (RB3) and Saquon Barkley (RB8) are legitimate stars at the top of the lineup, and Drake London (WR7) gives the manager a third projected starter worth respecting, but below that tier the production drops off fast. Baker Mayfield (QB18) was the draft's best find, sliding more than two rounds past his ADP, yet QB18 is the ceiling at the position, not a trump card. Tony Pollard projects as the weakest projected starter at RB30, and the manager arrives at that slot without an obvious upgrade waiting in reserve. Last season's 65th-

percentile scoring suggests the roster can outperform its grades, but in a field this competitive, hoping for overperformance is not a strategy, it is a prayer.

TheEasterDude sits ninth in the Super Mario Bros. division and projects out at the 27th percentile of the field, and the draft record does little to suggest a turnaround is coming. The roster has genuine anchors in Josh Allen and Justin Jefferson, but the draft surrounding them was riddled with the kind of optimism that costs teams. Four major reaches on the board include Josh Jacobs taken nearly two rounds early, Troy Franklin grabbed almost five rounds before consensus had him available, and Fernando Mendoza burned a tenth-round pick on a QB27 projection that will almost never see a starting lineup. Those are not bold swings that happen to miss, they are drafting on hope where precision was required. The result is a roster that grades average across the board, with no obvious depth piece threatening to break out and compensate. Allen and Jefferson are real, but they can only carry so much weight when the construction around them suggests the manager trusted instinct over the market at exactly the wrong moments.

Colt drafted with admirable patience, landing Matthew Stafford six picks after his ADP and collecting value after value across eighteen rounds, yet the roster sits at the 35th percentile and eighth in the Super Mario Bros. division, which is exactly the kind of outcome that makes you question whether the draft even matters. The problem is not the process, it is the ceiling. Brock Bowers at TE1 and Kyle Pitts at TE7 form a genuinely elite top of the roster, and Omarion Hampton at RB9 and DeVonta Smith at WR14 give Colt a credible core. But the depth that was supposed to follow never quite arrives. Jordan Addison projects as the weakest starter at WR43, and the players drafted to provide upside, Jordyn Tyson, Antonio Williams, Cooper Kupp, are all long shots to deliver meaningful weeks. Colt bought every item on sale and still came home without enough for dinner. The value was real. The team just was not.

edkreager sits at 58th percentile in the Scott Fish Bowl field, which sounds fine until you realize that in a tournament decided by razor-thin margins, "fine" is a synonym for "going home early." The backbone of this roster is genuinely impressive: Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, A.J. Brown at WR8, and Chris Olave at WR11 give edkreager a starting core that can trade punches with anyone in the Super Mario Bros. division. But the draft tells a more complicated story. Elijah Sarratt, taken nearly five rounds ahead of his ADP, and Jalen Coker, grabbed over two rounds early, are the kinds of aggressive swings that either look prescient in October or haunt a manager all season. Those reaches didn't come cheap in a draft where every pick compounds. Dalton Schultz projects as the weakest projected starter at TE22, which won't sink anyone, but it won't carry a close week either. This is a roster that wins the weeks it's supposed to win and loses the weeks it shouldn't, a profile that lands you right at the bubble every single time.

cory78 didn't build this roster by swinging for the fences on any single pick. The draft just kept coming out ahead, pick after pick, round after round. Puka Nacua landing as the WR1 projection is the headliner, but the deeper story is how the value accumulated quietly in the middle and late rounds. Jordan Love fell nearly two rounds past his ADP, C.J. Stroud fell over three, and both Rodriguez and Jonathon Brooks slid into the back half of the draft at prices well below market. Meanwhile the projected starters hold up top to bottom, with Ashton Jeanty at RB7, Garrett Wilson at WR17, and Sam LaPorta and Travis Kelce both cracking the top ten at tight end. The two minor reaches, Jalen Hurts and Khalil Shakir, are easy to forgive when the rest of the board went this consistently well. The 62nd percentile projection and a 56 percent win rate last season say the same thing: not a threat to run away with anything, but a team that earns everything it gets.

TheFFGenius didn't swing for the fences and miss. They just kept connecting, round after round, building a roster that sits at the 63rd percentile and looks poised to climb. The engine is Bijan Robinson at RB2, a genuinely elite piece, and Kenneth Walker III at RB10 gives this lineup a second projected starter worth deploying without apology. The draft process itself deserves credit: five values against zero steals is a portrait of a manager who let the board come to them. Justin Herbert at QB8 is the most interesting piece of that group, acquired a full round after his ADP suggested he'd be gone, and with Mike McDaniel now running the Chargers' offense, there's a real case that Herbert's ceiling ticks up from where it spent the Harbaugh era. Quinshon Judkins at RB22 fell nearly a round and a half into TheFFGenius's lap as well. No single pick defines this team, which is exactly the point. Consistent execution compounds quietly, and this roster is what that looks like.

kartn43 didn't build this roster around a single blockbuster swing. The draft just kept quietly winning, round after round, until the cumulative effect became impossible to ignore. The headliner is a backfield anchored by James Cook (RB5), Derrick Henry (RB12), and Kyren Williams (RB15), three projected starters who each carry legitimate weekly upside on their own. Trey McBride (TE2) adds an elite anchor at a position where most rosters are scrambling for scraps. Then there's Brock Purdy (QB13), who fell nearly three full rounds past his ADP of 5.09 before kartn43 scooped him at 8.06, and the fact that he's stacked with Mike Evans (WR27) gives that late-round steal some genuine connective tissue. One steal, eighteen chalk picks, and almost nothing in the reaches column tells the story: this manager didn't need to gamble. The 2025 finish of 83rd percentile in scoring provides real backing for the idea that this roster belongs in the conversation, sitting fourth in the Super Mario Bros. division and projecting at the 73rd percentile entering 2026.

KingChirp did not stumble into correlation, they engineered it. The twin stacks anchoring this roster, Caleb Williams paired with Colston Loveland and Jaxson Dart paired with Malik Nabers, are not hedges or happy accidents but the entire architectural logic of the team. Williams lands as QB6 despite falling nearly three full rounds past his ADP, and Loveland checks in as TE3, meaning when that Chicago connection fires, KingChirp is not picking up points in drips but flooding the scoreboard from a single game script. The Dart-Nabers pairing offers a second detonator: Dart at QB11 and Nabers at WR12, both acquired well below their expected cost, both capable of detonating in tandem on the right Sunday. The ceiling here is genuinely elite, good enough to park this roster at the 87th percentile of the field. The floor, though, is honest about the risk: last season's 22nd-percentile finish is a reminder that correlated rosters do not quietly grind out wins, they either explode or they don't.

Nobleg711 finished 2025 in the 4th percentile and came back to this draft swinging with conviction, which is either the definition of growth or a very bold response to a 5-31 record. The results suggest growth. Sitting at 92nd percentile and second in the Super Mario Bros. division, this roster was built on a draft that looked chaotic on paper and reads like a masterplan in hindsight. The foundation is legitimate: Joe Burrow at QB4 paired with Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 is as good a stack as exists in this tournament, and Nobleg711 got Burrow nearly a full round after his ADP suggested he'd be gone. Trevor Lawrence, the draft's most significant value, fell nearly two and a half rounds before landing here at QB10. The board flagged five minor reaches and two major ones, and yes, pulling Ryan Flounoy nearly three rounds early and Jaylen Wright seven rounds early will raise eyebrows. But when your starting corps is anchored by Burrow and Chase with De'Von Achane at RB6 running alongside them, you can afford to have convictions in the late rounds and let the argument sort itself out on the field.

Jordan Woodson did not come to the Scott Fish Bowl to guess. Sitting first in the Super Mario Bros. division and in the 95th percentile of the entire field, this roster reads like a masterclass in patience and board awareness. The foundation is Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1, a genuinely elite projection, and the discipline to wait until the third round to land Drake Maye at QB2 while the rest of the field overpaid early. Then, somehow, Patrick Mahomes sat on the board until 8.12 despite projecting as QB12, a gift Woodson accepted without blinking and the clearest sign that this draft had its eyes open all night. The result is a starting lineup anchored by Gibbs, Maye, and Mahomes, with George Pickens at WR10 and Tucker Kraft at TE5 giving the roster legitimate upside at every level. Sixteen chalk picks keep the foundation sensible. Three good values and a Mahomes-sized steal keep it dangerous. After a 29th percentile finish in 2025, Woodson has built something that looks like the corrected version.
