As the 2025 fantasy football season approaches, No Beans, No Rice, Meat is staring down the barrel of what could be a long and arduous journey. Currently sitting dead last in their division at rank 12 and languishing in the bottom 3 percentile overall, the team faces an uphill battle. The roster is riddled with questionable choices and missed opportunities. The team's quarterbacks are their only glimmer of hope, with Jayden Daniels ranked highly, but Bryce Young's disappointing QB22 status means he's far from a reliable starter. The wide receiver corps seems somewhat promising with Rashee Rice and Marvin Harrison Jr., but they lack depth and consistency, with Khalil Shakir and Michael Pittman trailing behind in ranks. The selection of Derrick Henry might have added some immediate power, but it came at the cost of reaching early, as did several other picks like Tank Bigsby and Braelon Allen. This strategy has left the team with significant holes and limited flexibility.

Without any viable tight end options to speak of, the team's vulnerabilities are likely to be exploited throughout the season. With such a shaky foundation, it's hard to be optimistic about their chances of climbing out of the basement of their division or making any significant tournament impact this year.

The 2025 fantasy football season looks bleak for Gooberr13, which finds itself languishing near the bottom of both its division and overall standings. Despite boasting the strongest wide receiver corps in the Chicago Blackhawks division, led by CeeDee Lamb, A.J. Brown, and Jaxon Smith-Njigba, the team is undermined by a feeble running back lineup featuring Javonte Williams and Tyler Allgeier. This glaring weakness leaves Gooberr13 struggling to keep pace with more balanced competitors. The decision to gamble on Jordan Addison and Keon Coleman significantly earlier than their projected draft positions has backfired, providing little return on investment. Even the savvy lateround quarterback picks such as Cam Ward and Sam Darnold fail to offset the team's deficiencies. Moreover, the unfortunate reliance on Jayden Higgins as a starter further compounds the issues,

offering little reassurance for a turnaround. All these factors contribute to Gooberr13's disheartening placement at 10th in the division and a meager 8th percentile in the tournament.

Although they managed to snag Kareem Hunt and Dalton Schultz below their average draft positions, these minor victories are overshadowed by the overzealous reaches for Kendre Miller and Jonnu Smith, which have already cost them valuable momentum.

Unless dramatic improvements occur, cowhitchurch's season appears destined for disappointment, with any aspirations of competing at the top slipping further out of reach.

Stroud and Theo Johnson were snagged at great value, while Pat Freiermuth and Justin Herbert, whose pairing with McConkey offers a stack bonus, perhaps cost more than they should

have. Jerome Ford was a steal, potentially providing depth and value in later stages. Yet, the team also gambled on players like Tyler Warren and Terrance Ferguson earlier than consensus. As the season unfolds, ConnorAllenNFL needs strategic play and perhaps a bit of luck to ascend from its current standings, especially as it navigates the fierce competition within its division.

However, some early-round reaches, particularly Jayden Reed, may offset these gains. The

receiver lineup, featuring Garrett Wilson (WR14) and Tyreek Hill (WR17), holds promise, but it's the balance of these strategic selections and risks that will define larsonaa's journey this season. As they navigate the challenges ahead, maintaining a focus on maximizing the potential of their top-tier tight ends and finding consistency at wide receiver will be key to surpassing expectations.
