There is no charitable read available for HawHaw, a team sitting dead last in the Donkey Kong Country division and at the 1st percentile of the entire field, and the draft board tells you exactly why. The signature move was spending a third-round pick on Jaxson Dart, a QB11 taken 2.2 rounds before his ADP, in a positionless format where quarterback scarcity simply does not punish you the way it would in a traditional league. That is not a bold bet, that is a panicked one. Meanwhile, Jeremiyah Love, projected RB13 and a legitimate piece, was yanked off the board nearly two rounds early when patience would have returned similar value later. The pattern holds everywhere: four major reaches, six minor ones, and a lone steal in Brian Robinson that arrived too late to redeem anything. Bhayshul Tuten has a real path to a starting role in Jacksonville with Travis Etienne gone, which gives this roster one genuine upside play, but one upside play surrounded by a draft conducted like someone was racing a clock that only they could hear is not a foundation. It is a eulogy.

There is a specific misery reserved for the manager who drafts well and still ends up here. Loveland 1.01 ! played the value game correctly, landing Tyler Warren at TE4 nearly two rounds after his ADP and Jakobi Meyers at WR45 almost three rounds late, and yet the team sits at 11th in the Donkey Kong Country division and the 11th percentile of the entire field. The problem is not the process, it is the foundation. Taking Colston Loveland at 1.01, a full 1.6 rounds before consensus, and Kyle Monangai 3.1 rounds early means the early capital that should have built a ceiling was spent buying into projections that have not paid off at the ranks that matter most. The late-round value adds up on paper and then evaporates in practice, because the players absorbing that value, Meyers at WR45, Khalil Shakir at WR51, are the projected starters keeping this roster afloat. Drafting correctly and still finishing this low is not bad luck. It is a structural bill coming due.

There is no elegant way to spin a 20th-percentile projection and a 10th-place divisional standing, so let's not try. bdorman10 enters 2026 as a team that got most of the important decisions right on paper and still landed near the bottom of Donkey Kong Country, which is its own kind of cruel. The receiver group is legitimately good, anchored by CeeDee Lamb (WR5), Drake London (WR7), and Rashee Rice (WR13), and London arriving as the draft's clearest steal only deepens the sting. The problem is that the rest of the roster doesn't hold up. Omarion Hampton (RB9) cost a full round of premium by going a round early at RB9, a price that made sense only if he was going to carry the backfield load alone, and behind him the depth grades out at RB47 and below. Matthew Stafford (QB14) and Baker Mayfield (QB18) offer passable quarterback insurance but nothing that changes the ceiling. When your receivers are this good and the math still doesn't work, the roster isn't missing a tweak. It's missing something harder to find.

The Blondie Kongs enter 2026 sitting ninth in the Donkey Kong Country division and in the bottom quarter of the tournament field, and the draft record explains a good chunk of why. The roster features five major reaches, and the worst offenders, Cooper Kupp at WR88 and Theo Johnson at TE37, were taken more than four and three rounds early respectively, eating premium draft capital on players projected well down their position's depth charts. Those missteps matter because the foundation underneath them is genuinely shaky. Puka Nacua projects as WR1, a legitimate centerpiece, and Breece Hall at RB14 is a real contributor, but outside that top tier the options thin out fast. Chris Olave at WR11 helps, though he cost second-round value on a third-round timeline. The projected starters grade out near the bottom of the field, the TE position is a liability with Dalton Schultz projecting

WR22, and after going 8-28 last season with 23rd-percentile scoring, this roster looks like one that needs a minor miracle rather than a minor improvement.

Peteradio1 sits eighth in the Donkey Kong Country division and at the 29th percentile of the field, and the draft chart does not offer much comfort. The receiving corps has genuine star power, Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 are legitimate difference-makers, but the rest of the roster leans heavily on hope. Lamar Jackson was a steal at QB3, falling more than a round past his ADP, yet the team surrounded him with Greg Dulcich at TE25, a player taken nearly three rounds early despite projecting as the weakest starter on the board. That kind of value mismatch is hard to overcome. De'Von Achane projects as a top-ten back at RB6, but behind him the depth falls off fast, and a 15-21 record last season suggests this manager already knows what it feels like to be competitive on paper and disappointing in practice. There is no obvious lever left to pull, just a lot of hoping the stars stay healthy while the margins quietly work against them.

LucMac83 is the team that shows up to every game with a real chance and leaves every game with a real argument for why things went sideways. The ceiling here is genuine: Justin Jefferson at WR6 and Malik Nabers at WR12 give this roster a top-end punch that most managers in Donkey Kong Country would envy, and landing Bucky Irving at RB21 a full round after his ADP suggests LucMac83 knows how to work a draft board. But the margins are where this season gets decided, and the margins are uneven. The Dak Prescott and George Pickens stack adds correlated upside, though Pickens arrived as the draft's clearest overpay, taken nearly a full round early at 2.05. Brock Purdy at QB13 looks like depth insurance until you account for San Francisco's receiving corps, which is a fog of injuries and question marks heading into the season. Nothing here collapses the roster, nothing elevates it out of the middle third of the field either. At 48th percentile, LucMac83 is precisely as dangerous as that sounds: dangerous enough to beat anyone on the right week, thin enough to lose to anyone on the wrong one.

Lyons Township Lions sit at the 65th percentile heading into 2026, and the draft record tells you exactly why: no flashy heist, just a team that kept coming out ahead on value. The headliner is Jayden Daniels, a QB5 projection snagged nearly two full rounds after his market price, which is the kind of quietly larcenous pick that wins leagues in November while nobody noticed it in April. The backfield is the engine here, with Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and Kenneth Walker III at RB10 giving the Lions a top-tier foundation, and Chase Brown at RB11 adding genuine upside even if taking him at 2.10 cost a slight premium over ADP. The weak spot is receiver depth beyond Emeka Egbuka and Christian Watson, but in a positionless format those concerns fade quickly when your top players are this good. Sixth in the Donkey Kong Country division is a reasonable projection, but the Daniels value alone gives this roster a ceiling that the standings don't fully capture.

Blitzlink didn't go hunting for lottery tickets and didn't swing for the fences on a single splashy pick. They just kept coming out ahead, round after round. The anchor of the whole thing is Brock Bowers, the TE1, paired with A.J. Brown, who landed at WR8 nearly a full round past his ADP. The Brown situation carries real upside: traded to New England in the offseason, he now lines up alongside Drake Maye, who just put together an MVP runner-up season, and that pairing is the kind of connection that can carry a fantasy roster through a long tournament. Maye himself checks in as a QB2, so the stack isn't built on hope, it's built on two genuinely elite projections reinforcing each other. Add Rachaad White falling more than three rounds past his ADP to give the roster another late-round win, and the draft-day ledger reads cleanly: five picks that beat the market, zero reaches. A 74th percentile tournament finish is a reasonable expectation for a team this consistently constructed, and fifth in Donkey Kong Country feels like a floor, not a ceiling.

RyanAlexanderW finished 25-11 last season and now sits at the 88th percentile heading into 2026, and the draft tape is a genuine puzzle: four major reaches, one steal, and somehow a roster that looks legitimate. The reaches tell the story most vividly. Kyren Williams went nearly two rounds early, and Emanuel Wilson went a staggering six rounds before his ADP, a number that reads less like conviction and more like a dare. Yet the foundation those reaches sit on is real. Josh Allen came in half a round past his ADP, Trey McBride slipped nearly half a round as well, and both project as pillars of this lineup, Allen as QB1 and McBride as TE2. Garrett Wilson, Jameson Williams, and Brian Thomas Jr. round out a projected starting group that would make any manager in Donkey Kong Country nervous. The question RyanAlexanderW cannot answer until the season plays out is whether the reaches were vision or variance. The roster is good enough that it may not matter.

The Uncs did not build this roster on one thunderbolt move. They built it the way a good card player wins, by consistently getting slightly more than they paid for, hand after hand. Christian McCaffrey (RB3), Jonathan Taylor (RB4), Saquon Barkley (RB8), and Derrick Henry (RB12) form a projected starting group that is simply hard to argue with, and the fact that Barkley arrived a little past his ADP means the manager was not just accumulating talent but accumulating it efficiently. DeVonta Smith (WR14) and Tucker Kraft (TE5) came off the board late relative to their ADP as well, and Kraft slides neatly into a stack with Jordan Love (QB17) that gives the team a built-in correlation bonus. Five values against zero major reaches across the entire draft is the kind of quiet, unsexy process that lands you in the 88th percentile of the field, which is exactly where The Uncs sit heading into 2026. Third in Donkey Kong Country is the current address, but this roster looks like it is auditioning for a better neighborhood.

Beardude didn't stumble into correlation by accident, and the 92nd percentile tournament standing reflects a roster built with genuine intentionality. The centerpiece is the Joe Burrow / Ja'Marr Chase stack, two projected starters ranked QB4 and WR2 respectively, a pairing where every Chase touchdown is a Burrow touchdown and every big Burrow game runs directly through Chase. That's not a hedge, that's a philosophy. Beardude then doubled down with a second correlated stack, pairing Justin Herbert (QB8) with Ladd McConkey (WR20), giving the team a fallback that mirrors the same logic rather than abandoning it. When both stacks are humming, the ceiling here is genuinely stratospheric. The risk, of course, is the inverse: correlation cuts both ways, and a cold week from Burrow doesn't just cost you a QB score, it likely costs you a Chase score too. Beardude accepted that volatility on purpose, betting that the upside of synchronized explosions outweighs the downside of synchronized duds. After a 21st percentile finish in 2025, this is the right kind of swing.

StatGuy P sits at the top of Donkey Kong Country and in the 96th percentile of the entire field, and the draft record explains exactly why: disciplined, patient, and ruthless when the board gave an inch. The crown jewels are a pair of steals so clean they almost feel like a clerical error, Chris Godwin at WR38 sliding two and a half rounds past his ADP, and Michael Pittman at WR44 falling two and a half rounds as well, both scooped up in the back half of the draft for prices that belong in a clearance bin. Layer that onto a backfield headlined by Bijan Robinson at RB2 and James Cook at RB5, with Ashton Jeanty at RB7 adding a third projected starter who himself fell nearly a full round below his ADP, and the value accumulation becomes almost comical in its consistency. Thirteen chalk picks kept the foundation sturdy while the steals built the ceiling. The one blemish, Elijah Sarratt taken nearly four rounds early, is a footnote on an otherwise immaculate sheet.
