SageBrown52 sits 12th in the Kirby Division and in the 11th percentile of the field, and the roster makes that standing feel about right. The tight end group is the one genuine bright spot, with Trey McBride, Tyler Warren, and Mark Andrews all projecting as starters, but a roster needs more than one good room to climb out of the basement. The wide receiver corps grades out average at best, and Garrett Wilson and Emeka Egbuka anchor it at WR17 and WR18 respectively before the drop to KC Concepcion, the projected weakest starter at WR50, arrives faster than you'd like. The quarterback situation offers little comfort either: Jordan Love checks in at QB17, Sam Darnold at QB21, and Darnold's own context is murky given that Seattle's passing game ran almost entirely through Jaxon Smith-Njigba last year and Kenneth Walker's departure may not free up enough volume to make Darnold a fantasy asset. The draft chart offered no steals, no values, and two major reaches. SageBrown52 went chalk, paid up in the wrong spots, and is now hoping the math works out differently than it looks.

The name says it all, and unfortunately so does the draft board. Cee Deez Nuts?Saquon Em! built a genuinely impressive receiver corps anchored by CeeDee Lamb (WR5) and A.J. Brown (WR8), but the manager spent so many picks chasing depth at running back that the draft devolved into a series of increasingly desperate gambles. Kaelon Black (RB71) was taken 8.4 rounds before his ADP. MarShawn Lloyd (RB66) went nearly four rounds early. Mike Washington Jr. (RB59) left the board three-plus rounds ahead of schedule. These are not bold contrarian calls, they are the draft-day equivalent of panic-buying, and they consumed real capital that could have shored up the quarterback position, which projects as the weakest in this lineup. C.J. Stroud sits at QB22 and is the projected starter, which is the kind of sentence that keeps managers awake at night. Saquon Barkley (RB8) and the receiver group give this roster a pulse, but an 11th-place division rank and a 13th-percentile tournament projection suggest the board already delivered its verdict.

Last year's 94th-percentile finish has a way of making a roster look better than it actually is in the present tense, and Kirbys Pinball Wizard is learning that lesson the hard way. The 2025 version of this team scored 5,075 points at an 83-percent clip. The 2026 version is projected 10th in the division and 13th percentile in the field, which is not a gentle correction, it is a cliff. The receiver group anchored by Justin Jefferson, Malik Nabers, and Zay Flowers still looks like real money, and the Lamar Jackson and Flowers stack gives the team a ceiling that projection models tend to undervalue. But Jackson's backfield support runs thin fast, Kyren Williams projects as a mid-tier RB15, and the tight end group tops out at AJ Barner at TE24, which is quietly where optimistic lineups go to die. The draft was overwhelmingly chalk with four minor reaches and zero steals, meaning the manager bet on the names rather than manufacturing edge. That bet worked brilliantly once. The 2026 schedule will tell us whether it was genius or just good timing.

bouchmaster2 didn't stumble into correlation, they engineered it. The spine of this roster is two of the cleanest pass-game stacks available: Joe Burrow paired with Ja'Marr Chase, and Jalen Hurts paired with DeVonta Smith. Burrow projects as QB4 and Chase as WR2, which means when Cincinnati is slinging it, bouchmaster2 is likely doubling up on the scoring. The Hurts-Smith pairing adds a second live fuse, with Hurts at QB9 and Smith at WR14. Neither stack was accidental, and neither was cheap, but the draft cost is at least defensible, with Burrow landing slightly past his ADP and Hurts falling nearly a full round. The problem is that a roster built on correlation lives and dies together. When both stacks hit, this team has a ceiling that can win a week outright. When they go cold in tandem, and they will on some weeks, the supporting cast ranked RB24 and lower offers limited rescue. bouchmaster2 is essentially betting that the math works out more often than it blows up. Sitting 9th in the Kirby division at the 48th percentile, that bet is currently a push.

afrojoe125 enters the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl sitting eighth in the Kirby division and at just the 52nd percentile of the field, and the roster does not offer much reason to expect a climb. The draft tells part of the story: zero steals, three modest values, and a major reach on Brian Robinson, taken 2.3 rounds before his ADP and projected at RB45. That is not a capital crime in isolation, but it stings more when the rest of the board graded out as mostly chalk. The one genuinely interesting subplot is David Montgomery, who fled Detroit's backfield after his carries cratered last season and landed in Houston, where he is now projected to battle Woody Marks for lead duties. Montgomery grades out at RB23 and is a projected starter, which is fine, but asking a committee back fighting for touches to anchor a roster that is already projecting near the bottom of the division is a thin thread to hang optimism on. There is no obvious lever left to pull here, just a long season and a lot of hope.

PastasFootball is the team that sits at 53rd percentile and dares you to tell it that means anything. The foundation is genuinely good: Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 give this roster a running back core that most managers in the Kirby division would trade their lunch for, and Tucker Kraft at TE5 slots in as a legitimate positional advantage, even if reaching 1.8 rounds past his ADP to get there suggests the manager saw something the room did not. The trouble is that everything beneath that top layer is aggressively median. Ladd McConkey at WR20 and Jameson Williams at WR21 are fine, the way a Tuesday afternoon is fine. Brock Purdy and Matthew Stafford both came as values, falling roughly a round past their ADPs, which is smart drafting, but QB13 and QB14 are not the kind of rankings that swing a week. This season lives or dies somewhere between Gibbs having a monster game and J.K. Dobbins, the projected weakest starter, quietly costing a point here and there until the margins add up to something painful.

Underage Bijan exists in that merciless middle zone where every week feels like a coin flip and the coins are slightly bent. The foundation is real: Bijan Robinson projects as RB2, Nico Collins sits at WR9, and a Caleb Williams to Luther Burden stack gives this roster a ceiling that can compete with anyone in the Kirby division on a good Sunday. But the margins that decide a season like this tend to live in the supporting cast, and that is where the tension hides. Alec Pierce projects as WR32 and would be a useful depth piece, except he is sitting on the PUP list after ankle surgery, and if he does not clear by late August he misses the first four weeks entirely, which is exactly the kind of quiet disaster that turns a 54th-percentile roster into a 40th-percentile postmortem. Sam LaPorta was a reach at TE8, taken more than a round early, and Brenton Strange projects as the weakest starter on the board. Nothing is broken here. Nothing is safe, either.

Drake and Josh landed a genuinely good roster in the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl, and the draft log makes it look messier than the results suggest. The reaches are real: Ray Davis (RB62) went nearly five rounds early, and Jaylen Wright (RB68) went almost six rounds before his ADP. Both are depth pieces, not starters, which means the manager paid a premium to stockpile the back end of a position group rather than upgrade the top. And yet the top is legitimately strong. Josh Allen (QB1) slid to 1.12, Drake London (WR7) and Rashee Rice (WR13) anchor the receiving corps, and Tee Higgins (WR19) gives this lineup real starting-caliber depth. The one cloud hanging over that ceiling is Rice, who is dealing with a knee procedure, a probation violation, and a looming short jail stint before he ever takes a snap. If Rice is limited or unavailable, the floor drops fast. If he plays, this team competes. That is the whole bet, and someone here seems very willing to make it.

Cocaine Bear didn't win the draft on any single pick. They won it across nineteen rounds of consistent, unglamorous execution. The foundation is real: Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Jonathan Taylor at RB4 give this roster a ceiling that most managers in the Kirby division simply can't match. Kenneth Walker III, projected RB10, came to them a little later than he should have, and RJ Harvey fell far enough past his ADP that grabbing him at RB28 felt less like luck than like a manager paying attention. None of these were dramatic heists, just the steady accumulation of advantage that separates a thoughtful drafter from the field. Patrick Mahomes, projected QB12 and penciled in as a starter, keeps the floor elevated, and four total values on a roster with zero major reaches is the kind of quiet balance sheet that tends to look smarter by Week 8 than it does in August. Sitting 62nd percentile in the field at the moment, there's real upside here if the projections break right.

tvella didn't need a blockbuster pick to build one of the more quietly impressive rosters in the Kirby division. The foundation is a receiving corps that would make most managers envious: Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4, George Pickens at WR10, and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 give this team a top-end that rarely comes together without at least one uncomfortable reach, and Brian Thomas Jr. at WR31 and Parker Washington at WR35 keep the quality rolling well past the starters. At tight end, Colston Loveland at TE3 and Kyle Pitts at TE7 represent the kind of positional advantage that compounds quietly across a long season. Trevor Lawrence landing at QB10 six rounds past his ADP is the kind of efficient addition that separates a good draft from a great one. The draft was heavy on chalk, but chalk with a purpose, and the two genuine values came at positions where the upside actually matters. Sitting third in the division and in the 68th tournament percentile, tvella has a roster built to climb.

gmdoyle9 didn't win the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl draft in a single flashy moment, and that's precisely the point. This is a roster built the way a good poker player builds a stack, not by chasing pots but by consistently extracting small edges until the math becomes undeniable. Drake Maye at QB2 slid past ADP at 2.07, Chris Olave arrived nearly a full round late as WR11, and Jordyn Tyson fell more than a round to become a projected starter at WR34. That's three values across the board, zero major reaches, and a starting corps that includes Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Travis Etienne and TreVeyon Henderson projecting as contributors alongside them. The one genuine cloud hanging over this roster is Josh Jacobs, a projected starter who remains in legal limbo following an offseason arrest, with charges still unresolved and fantasy implications genuinely secondary to the broader situation. But even accounting for that uncertainty, a team sitting second in the Kirby Division at the 79th tournament percentile earned that standing the quiet, correct way.

There was no single jaw-dropping move that defined dpokorski12's draft, just round after round of quiet, compounding correctness, and that is exactly how you end up sitting atop the Kirby division at the 95th tournament percentile. The foundation is undeniable: James Cook at RB5 and De'Von Achane at RB6 give this team two projected elite contributors, and Achane himself was a genuine value, slipping a full round past his ADP. Brock Bowers at TE1 is the kind of anchor that makes a manager's decisions easier all season, and Harold Fannin at TE6 arrived with a similar discount, falling 1.2 rounds before dpokorski12 scooped him up. Jeremiyah Love at RB13 was another patient reward, taken 1.2 rounds after consensus expected him to go. That is not luck, that is a manager who knew his board and trusted it. Five values against zero major reaches is a draft that won its battles in the margins, and in a format this competitive, the margins are where championships are decided.
