AndrewTuxLupole sits 12th in the Pokmon Red and Blue division and projects in just the 8th percentile of the field, and the roster tells you exactly why. The receiver corps looks genuinely dangerous on paper, with Nico Collins, George Pickens, and Zay Flowers all projecting as starters and Colston Loveland grading as TE3, but the quarterback situation threatens to drain the value from all of it. Kyler Murray is coming off a lisfranc injury that ended his Arizona tenure after just five games, and now he is in a competition with JJ McCarthy in Minnesota, his ceiling dependent on a front office actually handing the keys to a quarterback who has spent the last year rehabbing a foot. Geno Smith sitting at QB30 is the contingency plan, which is really no plan at all. This team drafted 13 chalk plays and found zero steals, which means there is no late-round lottery ticket quietly waiting to save the season. The floor and the ceiling feel uncomfortably close together, and neither one is high enough.

There is a particular kind of exhaustion that comes not from losing but from running out of ideas, and Ash Draftum looks to have arrived there before the season even begins. Sitting 11th in the Pokémon Red and Blue division and in just the 9th percentile of the field, the roster grades out as a team that drafted aggressively and got burned for it, burning the first overall pick on Caleb Williams at QB6 when the field let him slide a full 2.4 rounds, and then doing it again with Luther Burden at WR22, taken 2.2 rounds early. Those are the kinds of swings you make when you believe you have an edge, and they need to hit to justify the cost. The saving grace is that Ashton Jeanty grounds the lineup as a legitimate RB7, and the Williams-Burden stack at least offers a ceiling if everything breaks right. But Oronde Gadsden, a projected starter at TE16, now shares the Chargers' target tree with David Njoku, which is the sort of quiet bad news this team could not afford to absorb.

The Celadon City Charizards enter 2026 sitting at the bottom of the Pokmon Red and Blue division, and the draft record explains exactly how they got there: zero steals, four major reaches, and a 2025 finish in the 19th percentile of scoring that apparently taught nothing. The single most damning line item is Jalen Hurts, a QB9 taken at pick 2.11, more than a full round before his ADP, in a positionless format where burning a second-overall pick on a quarterback is the kind of decision that echoes for sixteen weeks. Rico Dowdle and Woody Marks were then reached on by 2.7 and 2.2 rounds respectively, which means the manager burned three of their first twelve picks chasing running backs at prices the market had already declined to pay. Dallas Goedert, reached 2.1 rounds early, at least offers a Hurts stack that has some logic to it, but logic applied to a structurally compromised roster is just rearranging the problem. The projected weakest starter is Khalil Shakir at WR51. That is where this draft landed.

Last year abehrens53 went 27-9 and scored in the 82nd percentile, which is the kind of résumé that earns a manager a reputation they may spend all of 2026 paying down. This year's roster is sitting at the 30th percentile and ninth in the Pokémon Red and Blue division, and the gap between those two data points is the whole story. The engine of this team is a legitimately elite tight end group anchored by Tyler Warren (TE4), Tucker Kraft (TE5), and Travis Kelce (TE10), and Kraft in particular is worth watching closely: he was pacing toward 1,000 yards before a November ACL injury, came off the preseason PUP list before August, and returns to a Packers receiving corps that lost more than it added, which sets up a potential starring role if he recaptures his pre-injury form. Ja'Marr Chase (WR2) gives the roster a legitimate top-end anchor on the outside. The problem is that the depth behind those names thins fast, three major reaches on draft day suggest the manager felt it too, and ninth in the division is not where 82nd-percentile reputations are supposed to live.

Kerty enters 2026 sitting eighth in the Pokmon Red and Blue division and in the 39th tournament percentile, and the roster math does not offer much reason for optimism. The receiver group is genuinely elite, anchored by Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4), CeeDee Lamb (WR5), and A.J. Brown (WR8), and landing Lamb at 2.03 when his ADP sat at 1.11 was a legitimate draft win. But that receiver strength is doing a lot of heavy lifting for a squad that has no real answers elsewhere. Cam Ward projects as a QB23, Malik Willis sits at QB24, and Deshaun Watson at QB34 rounds out a quarterback room that looks like a waiting room nobody wants to leave. In a positionless format where you simply start your best players, having three quarterbacks projected this far down the board is a meaningful drag on the weekly ceiling. The 2025 campaign ended at 39 percent wins, and nothing about this construction suggests the trajectory is pointing upward.

Mike Ekans enters 2026 sitting seventh in the Pokmon Red and Blue division and projected at just the 42nd percentile of the field, and nothing about this roster suggests a dramatic reversal is coming. The foundation looks fine on paper: Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Lamar Jackson at QB3 give the team a genuinely elite core, and Kenneth Walker III at RB10 and Javonte Williams at RB17 round out a respectable group behind them. But the receiver corps is where this roster quietly bleeds out. The best projected starter at the position is D.J. Moore at WR26, and the group bottoms out with Jakobi Meyers at WR45 as the weakest projected starter on the entire team. A draft that produced zero steals and fifteen chalk picks did nothing to address the imbalance, and the one legitimate value, RJ Harvey at RB28, only deepens a position that was already well-stocked. Ekans needed to find an edge somewhere and never did. The ceiling here is real but narrow, and the floor is closer than the standings suggest.

First & Golem is the kind of team that makes you squint at the projections and still not know what to think. The ceiling is real: Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, James Cook at RB5, Saquon Barkley at RB8, and a tight end duo in Kyle Pitts and George Kittle that would make most managers envious. That is genuine top-end talent, and in a positionless format, you field your best players in almost any mix, so those names matter. The floor, though, is where the uncertainty lives. The quarterback situation is fragile in ways that go beyond a single ranking. Daniel Jones is the projected starter, and his 2025 renaissance with the Colts was genuinely surprising, top-10 fantasy production through Week 13 before a ruptured Achilles ended it. He re-signed, the reports sound optimistic, and yet here we are, projecting him at QB25, still recovering from a significant injury. If Jones holds up, this roster can beat anyone in the Pokmon Red and Blue division. If he does not, the margins tighten fast, and sixth place starts to feel less like a floor and more like a forecast.

Last year was a disaster for ChrisJoelSmith, a 4-32 record and a finish in the sixth percentile of scoring that left very little to feel good about. The 2026 roster reads like a deliberate answer to that misery. The foundation starts at the top, where Joe Burrow at QB4 and Brock Bowers at TE1 give this team a pair of elite anchors that simply did not exist a year ago, and Harold Fannin at TE6 adds a second premium option at the position even if it cost a reach of over two rounds. The running back group threads together Kyren Williams at RB15, Josh Jacobs at RB16, and D'Andre Swift at RB24 as projected starters, giving ChrisJoelSmith genuine depth at a position where depth pays dividends across a long tournament schedule. The wide receiver group is the thinner part of the picture, with Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 as the clear headliner, but in a positionless format the rest of this roster has enough talent to compensate. A 51st-percentile projection is modest, but after last season, modest is a starting point, not a ceiling.

Just Gengar didn't win the draft on one flashy pick. They won it on the accumulation of small advantages, and that's a harder thing to replicate than it looks. The foundation is genuinely strong: Jayden Daniels at QB5 and Trey McBride at TE2 anchor a lineup that starts from a position of real strength, and Drake London at WR7 keeps the ceiling elevated. What separates this roster, though, is how the draft unfolded in the middle and late rounds. Justin Herbert landed at QB8 when his ADP suggested he'd be gone nearly a full round earlier. Josh Downs fell over a round past his expected price. Ryan Flounoy and Omar Cooper Jr. each slipped further than they should have. None of those picks individually changes a season, but four of them landing on the same team does. The weakest projected starter, Jaylen Warren at RB27, is a reasonable concern, but a roster sitting at the 66th percentile with this kind of draft efficiency has room to absorb it. Fourth in the division for now, but this team is built to move.

hutch91 sits third in the Pokmon Red and Blue division and at the 84th percentile tournament-wide, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. This is a clean build, the kind where the board did the work and the manager simply refused to panic. Josh Allen at QB1 sliding to the 2.01 when his ADP sat at 1.05 is the kind of gift that sets a foundation, and hutch91 collected it without flinching. Justin Jefferson at WR6 anchors the receiving corps, and the Murray-in-Minnesota situation gives that projection real teeth, with the sense that Jefferson's rough 2025 was a McCarthy problem more than a Jefferson problem. Pair Allen with Dalton Kincaid as a stack bonus and DeVonta Smith at WR14 and Emeka Egbuka at WR18 filling out the projected starters, and the top of this roster is genuinely difficult to attack. Five additional values scattered across the draft mean the depth was built on discipline too, not just fortune. There is almost nothing to pick apart here, and that is the whole point.

Hydro Pumped Up did not need a lottery ticket to build a contender. They needed a draft, and they ran one. The foundation is unmistakable: Bijan Robinson at RB2 lands at pick 1.09 while his average draft position sat at 1.04, a negligible gap that still represents getting one of the best players in the field a half-step late while everyone else was still arguing about him. From there the team stacked value without drama, landing Tyler Shough at QB20 a full round after his ADP and pairing him with Chris Olave in a stack that gives the lineup a built-in multiplier. Jonathan Taylor at RB4, Omarion Hampton at RB9, Travis Etienne at RB18, and Bucky Irving at RB21 give this roster the kind of depth where the weakest projected starter is Jordan Addison at WR43, a player most managers would celebrate owning. That is not an accident. That is a draft where almost every pick landed at chalk or better, sixteen times by chalk alone, and the result is a team sitting second in the Pokmon Red and Blue division and in the 85th percentile of the field heading into 2026.

Team Rocket drafts like they had a plan written down before the clock started. The centerpiece is Drake Maye, taken at 3.07 when the field had him priced at 2.02, a QB2 projection landed at a discount that rarely survives a careful room. The Maye situation is worth lingering on: New England quietly added AJ Brown in the offseason, giving Maye the alpha target he was never supposed to need but always deserved, and now the ceiling on that investment looks even higher than the pick price suggested. Around him, the draft board kept delivering. Chase Brown, Breece Hall, and Courtland Sutton all fell past their ADP, and Puka Nacua, the WR1 projection in this field, arrived half a round late. Eight values across the roster, one steal, zero reaches. That is not luck shopping at the margins, that is consistent discipline over fifteen-plus rounds. Team Rocket sits first in the Pokmon Red and Blue division and at the 100th percentile of the entire field, and honestly, looking at this sheet, it is hard to argue with either number.
