BearfanPeteFF sits third in the Spyro division and in the 3rd percentile of the field, and the draft record explains both without much additional commentary: four major reaches, four minor reaches, and zero steals across the board. The most damning entry is Joe Burrow at QB4, taken 1.09 when his ADP sat at 2.05, which meant BearfanPeteFF burned a first-round pick on a quarterback in a positionless format where positional scarcity barely registers. That kind of decision cascades. The board punished the impatience immediately, pushing Christian McCaffrey past his ADP so that he landed at 2.04 as genuine value, but one good fall does not rehabilitate a strategy built on panic. Then came RJ Harvey, a projected RB28 snatched four full rounds ahead of consensus, now penciled in as the weakest projected starter on the roster. A team coming off a 19th-percentile scoring season in 2025 needed a draft that bought back credibility. This one spent it faster than it arrived.

JohnMcGlynn sits third in the Spyro division and in the third percentile of the field, and the draft record explains both of those numbers with brutal efficiency: zero steals, five major reaches, and a construction philosophy that prioritized tight ends so aggressively it left almost nothing standing at receiver. Colston Loveland and Tyler Warren are legitimately good players, projected TE3 and TE4 respectively, but reaching nearly a combined two rounds early to secure them set the cost for everything downstream. The receiver situation that followed is the receipt: Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 as the clear top option, and then Michael Pittman at WR44, a player now tasked with making sense of Aaron Rodgers at age 43 on a Pittsburgh offense still searching for an identity. That is not a supporting cast, that is a gap. Breece Hall projects as RB14 and gives the team a real anchor, but he was taken 1.2 rounds early himself, which is the JohnMcGlynn experience in miniature: always paying a little more than the market asked, and ending up with a little less than expected.

There is not much mystery to what ails footballwithchaw.com in the Spyro division. Sitting at 10th in the division and in just the 8th percentile of the field, the roster grades out as one of the tournament's more troubled builds, and the draft did not offer much relief: two major reaches and zero steals leave precious little margin for error. The Bo Nix reach at 3.11 is the one that stings most, a QB15 projection taken more than two rounds early when the position almost never justifies that kind of aggression. The Justin Jefferson situation carries some legitimate hope, with Kyler Murray's arrival in Minnesota offering a plausible explanation for why last year's struggles were quarterback-driven rather than Jefferson-driven, but hope is doing a lot of heavy lifting on a roster that needs production, not narratives. Omarion Hampton at RB9 gives the team a real anchor, but Hampton himself was a reach at 2.02. This is a team built on bets, and right now the house looks like it's winning.

Domoogion15 enters 2026 sitting ninth in the Spyro division and in just the 18th percentile of the field, and the draft record offers little reason for optimism. The most glaring issue is a reach pattern that bent the roster toward diminishing returns: Jake Ferguson (TE12), Brenton Strange (TE17), and AJ Barner (TE24) were all taken well before their ADPs, with Ferguson coming off the board a full three rounds early. Those are the kinds of commitments that quietly drain a draft of the capital needed to build depth at the top of the lineup. The headliners, A.J. Brown (WR8) and Trey McBride (TE2), are genuine assets, but the projected starters drop off quickly, with Matthew Golden (WR52) grading out as the weakest among them. Last season's 20th-percentile scoring finish already told part of this story, and nothing in the 2026 construction suggests the trajectory has changed. There is no obvious lever left to pull, only the slow arithmetic of a roster that gave too much to get too little.

yesterdaychef did almost everything right on draft day. The value game was largely respected, with Aaron Rodgers sliding to 15.10 despite an ADP nearly two rounds earlier and Chuba Hubbard falling into round 12 as a late gift. Fourteen picks landed at chalk, zero major reaches, and the draft still produced a team sitting 8th in the Spyro division and projected at just the 30th percentile. That is the cruelest math in fantasy football: discipline without reward. The backfield core of Jonathan Taylor at RB4 and Chase Brown at RB11 looks genuinely strong, but the receiver group tails off fast once you get past Terry McLaurin at WR24 and Marvin Harrison Jr. at WR33, with Travis Hunter, Cooper Kupp, and Rashod Bateman offering little projection upside beyond that. yesterdaychef came back from a 70th-percentile scoring season in 2025 with a cleaner draft and ended up in roughly the same place anyway, which suggests the problem is not process. It is just a roster that, on paper, does not quite get there.

bethanylpeters didn't make any splashy moves that will be remembered in highlight reels, but a 78th percentile finish doesn't happen by accident, and this roster has the DNA of a team that knows how it won. The foundation is a genuinely elite pairing of Drake Maye at QB2 and Brock Bowers at TE1, both projected starters acquired at or past their ADP, which is the quiet kind of winning that compounds over a full season. The Brock Purdy and Mike Evans stack adds another layer, though it comes with real uncertainty: Purdy's weapons in San Francisco are a mess of injuries and question marks, meaning Evans will need to carry more of that offense than anyone would like. George Pickens at WR10 anchors the skill group, and Derrick Henry and Kyren Williams give the lineup a pair of projected starters who can absorb volume. Four values drafted, zero major reaches, and last year's 88th percentile scoring line as proof of concept. This team didn't force anything. It just kept coming out ahead.

Year of the Fish didn't make headlines on draft day, and that's probably the point. The foundation is Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1, snagged at 1.08 when his ADP sat at 1.03, a modest slip that still puts a consensus top player in this roster's core. Amon-Ra St. Brown fell even further, a WR4 projection landing at 2.05 despite an ADP of 1.10, and those two quiet wins set the tone for how this draft unfolded: not a single blockbuster steal, but three genuine values and fourteen picks at chalk, the kind of steady accumulation that tends to look smarter as a season wears on. Add Saquon Barkley at RB8, Chris Olave at WR11, and Davante Adams at WR25 among the projected starters, and this team's best players are simply very good. The 2025 squad scored at the 88th percentile, and this one arrives with a comparable ceiling. Cautious optimism feels right here, not because anything went wrong, but because nothing needed to go spectacularly right either.

LCSchneeb34 didn't need a lottery ticket to build one of the better rosters in the Spyro division, just the discipline to keep winning small. The headliner is Puka Nacua at WR1, a genuinely elite projection anchoring a receiver group that keeps delivering: Nico Collins at WR9, Garrett Wilson at WR17, and Emeka Egbuka at WR18 all project as starters, and Brian Thomas Jr. at WR31 arrived two rounds late to his own party, taken at 8.11 against an ADP of 7.07. Makai Lemon at WR40 and Deebo Samuel at WR70 were both acquired well past their market price, adding genuine depth without forcing LCSchneeb34 to overpay. Jayden Daniels projects at QB5 and carries the quarterback room with authority. The one blemish is Justin Fields at QB38, taken nearly six rounds ahead of his ADP, though in a positionless format that kind of speculation barely registers against the overall quality here. A 2025 campaign that finished in the 59th percentile in scoring underrepresents what this roster is capable of projecting at the 83rd percentile in 2026.

obiwanoutlaw walked into the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl draft and simply did not make mistakes. The centerpiece is CeeDee Lamb, a WR5 projection taken at 2.08 when his ADP sat at 1.11, a full round of surplus value on one of the best receivers in the game. Pair that with Malik Nabers at WR12 and Bijan Robinson at RB2, and the floor on this starting lineup is legitimately difficult to find. The rest of the board followed the same pattern: disciplined, patient, and rewarded. Four additional values, including Nabers falling nearly a round past his price, add up to a team built on accumulation rather than luck. One minor reach on Kirk Cousins in the late rounds is the closest thing to a blemish, and calling that a blemish feels generous to the criticism. obiwanoutlaw finished last season at the 97th percentile in scoring, and the 2026 roster, sitting at the 86th tournament percentile, suggests that was not a fluke. This is what clean looks like.

vancheeser didn't need a lottery ticket to build something worth watching in the Spyro division. The foundation is genuinely strong: Jaxon Smith-Njigba projects as WR3, De'Von Achane as RB6, and Justin Herbert pairs with Ladd McConkey in a stack that gives the team a built-in multiplier every week McConkey gets involved. What separates this roster from a merely decent one is how consistently vancheeser came out ahead in the draft. Jameson Williams landed at WR21 while falling nearly a round and a half past his ADP, Matthew Stafford arrived as a perfectly priced QB14 fallback, and Jaylen Warren slid a similar distance in the late rounds. None of those are flashy moments, but four value acquisitions across a draft adds up to a meaningful edge when projected starters are hitting across the board. The two major reaches on Malachi Fields and Jack Bech in the back end represent real bets, but at that stage of a draft you're spending little to potentially gain a lot. This team sits third in the division and projects into the 87th percentile of the field, and the honest read is that both numbers feel about right.

There was no single moment where mrecord2121 won this draft, which is exactly the point. Round after round, the board simply kept falling the right way: Drake London slid to 2.10 despite projecting as WR7, Jalen Hurts was still sitting there at 4.10 when his ADP said he should have been gone a round earlier, and Michael Wilson fell a round and a half to land at 10.10. Seven values across the roster, zero steals, and that distinction matters because steals require luck while values require patience and board awareness. The result is a starting corps built around Ja'Marr Chase (WR2), Caleb Williams (QB6), and London that projects to finish second in the Spyro division and in the 92nd percentile of the field. Coming off a 2025 campaign that went 26-10 with 4807 points, this is a manager who knows how to construct a roster, and the 2026 version looks like more of the same, assembled one quietly correct pick at a time.

JimCoventryNFL enters 2026 sitting first in the Spyro division and in the 95th percentile of the entire field, and the reason is straightforward: the talent concentrated at the top of this roster is simply better than what most managers are working with. Josh Allen at QB1 anchors everything, stacked with Dalton Kincaid at TE11, and Jordan Love at QB17 runs his own pairing with Tucker Kraft at TE5, a player who fell two full rounds past his ADP and landed here as one of the draft's cleaner steals. Add James Cook at RB5, also taken past his ADP, alongside Ashton Jeanty at RB7 and Josh Jacobs at RB16, and the top of this lineup is the kind of collection that wins weeks before the other manager even checks the waiver wire. In a positionless format, quality is the only currency that matters, and JimCoventryNFL spent it wisely. A 20-16 finish last season suggests a team that already knows how to convert talent into points. The 2026 version looks sharper.
