Terrible Toad finished 14-22 last season and landed in the 39th percentile of scoring, and the 2026 projection offers little reason for optimism: the team sits 12th in the Super Mario Kart division and in just the 6th percentile of the entire field. The best player on the roster is A.J. Brown, a projected WR8 and a legitimate anchor, but the manager reached 1.1 rounds early to get him, meaning the cost of that anchor is already baked into the draft capital. Below Brown, the starter group grades out as average at best, with Quentin Johnston projecting as WR41 and slotting in as the weakest projected starter on the team. The quarterback situation is a quiet disaster, with Baker Mayfield checking in at QB18 and a Baker-Emeka Egbuka stack that looks more like a prayer than a plan. Colston Loveland at TE3 and Tucker Kraft at TE5 are genuinely strong, but in a positionless format, two excellent tight ends cannot carry a roster that grades out near the bottom. There is no obvious lever left to pull here.

LokiSleeper sits 11th in the Super Mario Kart division and in the 12th percentile of the field, and the roster tells you exactly why. The receiver group is legitimately strong, with Justin Jefferson (WR6), Drake London (WR7), and Chris Olave (WR11) headlining a starting corps that most managers would envy. But in a positionless format where total roster quality determines outcomes, that receiver strength has to carry almost everything, and the rest of the roster does not hold up its end. The quarterback options top out at Tyler Shough at QB20, and the backfield contributes Kyle Monangai at RB33 and Jacory Croskey-Merritt at RB40, both outside the range where you can expect consistent weekly impact. The draft offered no relief: fifteen chalk picks, zero steals, and a 2025 campaign that produced a 39 percent win rate tell the same story from different directions. Jefferson and company are working hard to keep this thing afloat, but the floor keeps rising to meet them.

BigRedFlink has bet the whole season on correlation, and that is either a masterstroke or a slow-motion disaster depending on which version of Matthew Stafford shows up in Los Angeles. The two stacks anchoring this roster, Jalen Hurts paired with DeVonta Smith and Stafford paired with Puka Nacua, are not supplemental upside, they are the architecture itself. Nacua projects as WR1, which means the ceiling here is genuinely terrifying, but it also means the floor depends entirely on Stafford, a QB14, holding up his end of a bargain he has not always honored. Smith at WR14 and Hurts at QB9 give the second pairing real teeth, but these two stacks live and die together, so a bad week from both quarterbacks does not just clip the score, it eviscerates it. Sitting at 10th in the Super Mario Kart division and 29th percentile in the field, BigRedFlink has constructed something that could genuinely threaten a deep run, or it could spend the summer as a cautionary tale about putting all of your correlation eggs in one very expensive basket.

WendiEarley enters 2026 sitting ninth in the Super Mario Kart division and in just the 43rd percentile of the field, and the roster does not offer many reasons to expect a climb. The draft tells the story as clearly as anything: two major reaches, including David Montgomery taken nearly two rounds before his ADP at RB23, and not a single steal on the board. Montgomery is the projected bell cow of this backfield, and his RB23 projection is a ceiling, not a floor. Trey McBride at TE2 is a genuine asset and Jayden Daniels at QB5 is legitimate upside, but this is a format where everyone has elite pieces, and WendiEarley's supporting cast grades out thin. CeeDee Lamb at WR5 is real, but the next projected starter at receiver is Rome Odunze at WR30, and the drop from there is steep. A 61 percent win rate in 2025 suggests this manager can compete, but last year's production does not fix this year's roster, and right now there are not enough levers left to pull.

SpaceGhostForce finished 26-10 last year, scored in the 73rd percentile, and landed at 54th percentile heading into 2026, which tells you everything about how the middle of the field works: good enough to beat bad teams, not good enough to scare good ones. Christian McCaffrey at RB3 is a genuine pillar, and Malik Nabers at WR12 gives the roster a second engine, but the margins start to show when you scroll further. Jordan Love projects as QB17, and the Packers context doesn't inspire confidence, since Love has never topped 35 touchdown passes in a season and Green Bay still lacks a true alpha receiver to push him into fantasy relevance. The draft was disciplined, twelve chalk picks with three values and zero major reaches, so SpaceGhostForce isn't carrying any catastrophic mistakes. What it is carrying is a roster where McCaffrey and Nabers need to perform, Love needs Green Bay to actually commit to the air, and the margin between 7th in the Super Mario Kart division and contention is thinner than it looks.

Brock2234 is the kind of team that finishes the Scott Fish Bowl with a winning record and a mild sense of dissatisfaction, which is perhaps the most honest outcome for a squad sitting at the 54th percentile. The foundation is genuinely good: Ashton Jeanty at RB7 and Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 give this roster a pair of top-end pieces that most managers would take without blinking, and Tyler Warren at TE4 means the position is essentially solved before the season starts. The margins, though, are where things get complicated. Brock Purdy arrives at QB13 with the San Francisco receiver room looking less like a weapon and more like a hospital waiting area, with injury questions surrounding nearly every option around him. Xavier Worthy projects as the weakest starter at WR49, and that number will matter in close weeks. Fourteen chalk picks and zero steals describe a draft that played it safe and got what it paid for, no more. This team can absolutely win the weeks it is supposed to win. Whether it wins the ones it is not is the entire question.

After finishing 10-26 in 2025 and scraping the 12th percentile in scoring, jstlaf enters 2026 looking like a completely different operation. The foundation here is genuinely impressive: Lamar Jackson at QB3 and Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 give this roster a pair of top-tier anchors that last year's squad simply could not match, and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 and Jaylen Waddle at WR23 round out a receiving corps that projects to carry real weekly upside. The draft added some intelligent value along the way, most notably Cam Skattebo at RB20, snagged a full round after his ADP. The major concern is a pair of aggressive reaches in the later rounds, with Isaac TeSlaa taken more than four rounds before consensus and Jack Bech grabbed nearly three rounds early, which means the depth of this roster is banking on some optimistic projections materializing. Still, when your floor

in any given week includes Jackson and St. Brown, you are no longer the team bleeding out in the bottom 12 percent. The 61st-percentile projection feels like a conservative floor for a roster with this much upside at the top.

JPlaia17 didn't win the draft with one bold swing, they just kept winning the small battles, and the roster reflects it. The foundation is genuinely elite: Ja'Marr Chase projects as WR2, Saquon Barkley sits at RB8, and Rashee Rice, grabbed one round ahead of his ADP, comes in at WR13. That trio alone gives this team a ceiling most managers would envy. Below the headliners, Luther Burden at WR22 and Christian Watson at WR28 keep the quality humming without a significant dropoff. The draft was almost entirely chalk, which sounds boring until you realize chalk is just another word for right, and JPlaia17 was right fourteen times. Jaxson Dart falling nearly two rounds past his ADP and landing here qualifies as a quiet win, and the Dart-Isaiah Likely stack adds a connected scoring upside that could pay off in bunches. Coming off a 79th-percentile scoring season in 2025, this team projects as a legitimate contender in the Super Mario Kart division, not flashy, just built well.

ShawnFoss built this roster the way good drafters do: patient, precise, and almost never wrong about where value lives. The headliners are legitimately scary, with Brock Bowers checking in at TE1 and Jonathan Taylor coming off the board at 2.06 despite an ADP of 2.01, a small gap that still signals ShawnFoss was paying attention while others blinked. Harold Fannin at TE6 fell a full 1.2 rounds past his ADP, and Oronde Gadsden at TE16 slid 2.1 rounds before ShawnFoss scooped him up, which means the top of this roster was built on discipline as much as talent. Thirteen chalk picks keep the foundation sturdy, and the two steals and three values scattered throughout confirm this was not a lucky draft so much as a methodical one. The 2025 season backs the reputation, a 64-percent win rate and 70th-percentile scoring do not happen by accident. Fourth in the Super Mario Kart division at the 68th tournament percentile, ShawnFoss enters 2026 with the kind of roster that makes rival managers quietly nervous.

There are loud drafts and there are good drafts, and xylopolist quietly ran one of the good ones. Landing Joe Burrow at QB4 a full round after his average draft position, then pairing him with Tee Higgins in a live stack, then turning around and picking up Bo Nix at QB15 another round late, these are not accidents. They are the fingerprints of a manager who knew what the board owed them and waited to collect. Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Kyren Williams at RB15 anchor the top of the roster with the kind of projected production that makes a 71st-percentile finish feel conservative, and six total values across the draft with zero major reaches means the depth behind them was built at fair prices rather than panic premiums. xylopolist sits third in the division right now, which understates the case. This team did not make one spectacular move. It made twelve quiet correct ones, and in a long season, that tends to compound.

jayups34 didn't need a lottery ticket to build this roster, just good shopping habits. The foundation is Jahmyr Gibbs (RB1) and James Cook (RB5), a top-five pairing that gives this team a ceiling other managers will be chasing all season, and Cook came at a modest discount, slipping a few spots past his ADP at 2.09. From there, jayups34 kept finding edges in the middle rounds: Justin Herbert (QB8) fell a full round to 4.09, Jared Goff (QB16) followed a round later at 7.04, and Quinshon Judkins (RB22) slid into the eighth round when most drafters had moved on. Five values across the draft without a single steal sounds like a quiet haul, but that kind of sustained efficiency compounds. With a 72-percent win rate and a 74th percentile finish in 2025 providing real proof of concept, jayups34 arrives in the Super Mario Kart division as a legitimate second-place threat and a team that plays deeper into most weeks than the opposition expects.

Peanut Punch didn't win the draft with one flashy pick. They won it by consistently getting more than they paid for, and that kind of discipline compounds. Patrick Mahomes landing at QB12 nearly two full rounds after his ADP, TreVeyon Henderson sliding to RB19 more than a round and a half late, Daniel Jones tucked away in round 12 as a high-upside third option: none of those individually breaks the internet, but together they represent a draft that kept finding value in the middle and late rounds without ever swinging recklessly. The headliners hold up too. Josh Allen at QB1 anchors the roster and connects to a D.J. Moore stack that gives this team a legitimate ceiling boost on the right week. De'Von Achane at RB6 and Kenneth Walker III at RB10 give Peanut Punch projected starter quality deep into the lineup. The result is a team sitting first in the Super Mario Kart division and in the 88th percentile of the field, built not on luck but on a draft that simply kept coming out ahead.
