There is no comfortable way to spin dono5641's outlook for 2026. The roster sits in the 9th percentile of the field, dead last in the You Don't Know Jack division, and the draft did almost nothing to change that trajectory: fifteen chalk picks, one major reach, and a grand total of zero steals. That major reach is the gut punch, Matthew Stafford burned at pick 2.04 despite an ADP of 6.02, a three-and-a-half-round overpay that sacrificed early-round equity on a QB14 projection. Christian McCaffrey, Chase Brown, and Breece Hall give the roster genuine top-end punch, and on a different team that trio would be the foundation of something dangerous. Here, it mostly papers over a lineup where Brenton Strange projects as the weakest starter at TE17 and the quarterback room peaks at Stafford. The 2025 season landed at .500 with a 68th-percentile scoring finish, which at least confirmed some upside exists. In 2026, dono5641 will need that upside to arrive all at once, because there is no obvious lever left to pull.

There is something almost sad about windycitywax in 2026, the way a championship photo looks when half the players have moved on. Last year's 94th-percentile scoring machine is now sitting at the 10th percentile of the field and ranked 11th in the You Don't Know Jack division, and the roster explains why. The receiver group is the quiet catastrophe here: Omar Cooper Jr. at WR60, Adonai Mitchell at WR67, Kayshon Boutte at WR76, and Malachi Fields at WR90 are not supporting cast, they are the cast. The backfield is genuinely strong, with De'Von Achane at RB6 and Derrick Henry at RB12 anchoring a deep group, but windycitywax paid a round early for both Achane and Dak Prescott, which is a curious way to build in a positionless format that rewards flexibility. Even the tight end depth has soft edges, with Oronde Gadsden now sharing the Chargers' target tree with a signed David Njoku. The 2025 version of this team earned its reputation. The 2026 version is living off it.

BearlyFantasy sits 10th in the You Don't Know Jack division and down in the 11th percentile of the field, and the roster makes it genuinely difficult to imagine a path out. The quarterback situation is the clearest signal of the trouble ahead: Daniel Jones projects as QB25 and Bryce Young as QB26, which means BearlyFantasy is essentially streaming the position in a format where everyone else has already made peace with that decision too. The draft did not help matters, producing three major reaches, including Jalen Nailor taken more than four rounds before his ADP and Jakobi Meyers taken more than two rounds early, burning capital on players who grade out as fringe contributors. Trey McBride, Harold Fannin, Travis Kelce, and Jake Ferguson give the team a genuinely strong tier of options at tight end, and CeeDee Lamb anchors the receiver group, but those bright spots feel less like a foundation and more like furniture left in a house that is already on the market. A middling 2025 offers no comfort. There is not much to pull on here.

MumpHarkfreeze sits ninth in the You Don't Know Jack division and at the 22nd percentile of the field, which is the kind of draft result you get when you spend five picks well ahead of consensus and finish with almost nothing to show for the aggression. The worst of it lands on the running back group, where Chuba Hubbard (RB29) was taken 2.2 rounds early and Jordan James (RB67) was drafted nearly 3.3 rounds before the market agreed he was worth touching, leaving a position group that projects as average despite the draft capital burned. D.J. Moore (WR26) cost a similar premium at 1.8 rounds over ADP in the fourth, a price that would sting less if the payoff were a WR10 rather than a WR26. The one genuine mercy is Dallas Goedert (TE15), who fell two full rounds past his ADP and brings real upside after quietly posting four touchdowns across three weeks during last year's fantasy playoffs. One steal does not rehabilitate a board where chalk dominated and reaches defined every other meaningful decision. This roster is not a work in progress. It is a verdict.

duggers27 sits eighth in the You Don't Know Jack division and checks in at the 23rd percentile of the field, and there is no obvious lifeline dangling from the roster. The foundation is real enough: Brock Bowers projects as TE1, A.J. Brown comes in at WR8, and a Jared Goff / Jameson Williams stack adds a ceiling play when things click. But beneath that top layer, the floor drops fast. Javonte Williams is the RB17, D'Andre Swift is the RB24, and Blake Corum slots in as the projected weakest starter at RB35, a number that quietly summarizes the problem. The draft offered almost no help on that front, producing zero steals and leaning heavily on chalk. Alec Pierce could have been a dart worth throwing, but he entered the season on the PUP list following ankle surgery, and if he does not clear it before late August cut-downs, he is gone for at least the first four games. When your most interesting gamble is a receiver recovering from surgery, the uphill road duggers27 faces is not a metaphor, it is the schedule.

SleeperChiefs10 finished 23rd percentile in scoring last season and the 2026 projections offer little reason for optimism, with the team sitting seventh in the You Don't Know Jack division and 43rd percentile across the field. The receiver corps is genuinely excellent, Justin Jefferson at WR6, Nico Collins at WR9, and Malik Nabers at WR12 forming a top-shelf group, but a positionless format rewards depth everywhere, and the rest of the roster forces a hard squint. Kenneth Walker III at RB10 is a legitimate asset, yet the backfield falls off sharply behind him, and the tight end situation, anchored by AJ Barner at TE24, is the kind of quiet drag that compounds over a long season. The draft did not help matters: three major reaches, including Elijah Sarratt taken four full rounds before his ADP and Ray Davis nearly three rounds early, suggest a manager who fell in love with upside that the projections do not share. Nabers landing at 6.03 against an ADP of 3.11 was a genuine win, but one steal does not restructure a roster that grades near the bottom of the field.

LeonRedzone didn't make any splashy moves, and that's exactly the point. This roster was built the way a good poker player builds a chip stack: quietly, consistently, one good decision at a time. The foundation is legitimate, with Jonathan Taylor (RB4) and Saquon Barkley (RB8) anchoring a group that gives this team a high floor every single week, and Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4) adding a genuine top-end weapon at his position. What makes the draft work is that none of those names came at a premium. Barkley slid nearly a full round past his ADP, and St. Brown was still available at 2.02 despite carrying a 1.10 ADP. Travis Etienne (RB18) and TreVeyon Henderson (RB19) push the depth further. The one blemish is MarShawn Lloyd, reached nearly four rounds early, but one aggressive late-round swing doesn't undo a draft that otherwise kept coming out ahead. Sitting 58th percentile in the field, LeonRedzone has the talent to climb.

MightytoSave didn't win the draft with one thunderbolt pick. They won it by coming out ahead on play after play. Joe Burrow at QB4 slipped just enough past his ADP to count as found money, and he arrives pre-loaded with a Tee Higgins stack that makes both players more valuable than their individual ranks suggest. Bijan Robinson projects as RB2, which is the kind of anchor that lets a manager absorb uncertainty everywhere else on the roster. After that, the receiver group does the quiet work: Luther Burden at WR22, Christian Watson at WR28, and Michael Pittman at WR44 were each drafted near or past their ADP, meaning the market essentially handed the manager fair-to-favorable prices on three projected starters in a row. Tyler Warren at TE4 and Mark Andrews at TE14 round out a roster that simply does not have a soft underbelly to exploit. The result is a team sitting at 59th percentile in the field, but built with the kind of structural soundness that tends to outperform projections as a long season does its sorting.

rcamp21 finished last season in the 15th percentile and came back swinging, so the conviction argument carries at least some weight here. The draft board will tell you this manager reached on five players, including Tyjae Spears and Theo Johnson by nearly three rounds apiece, and that the whole operation produced zero steals. The roster will tell you something different. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and Drake London at WR7 headline a receiver group that is genuinely difficult to argue with, and London himself came as a value, falling past his ADP to round two. Patrick Mahomes arrived late and cheap as well, a quiet win buried under the louder decisions. The Tucker Kraft stack with Jordan Love is the bet that requires the most faith, since Kraft is returning from a November ACL tear, but the Packers shed receivers this offseason without replacing them, which means his path back to a starring role is cleaner than the injury history alone would suggest. Sitting fourth in the You Don't Know Jack division and in the 65th percentile, rcamp21 is not the story of a perfect process. It might be the story of a correct one anyway.

Marvin Harrison Jr. fell nearly two full rounds before andrew89876 grabbed him at WR33, Bucky Irving slid a round past his ADP to land at RB21, and Jerry Jeudy came at pick 17.08 despite carrying a mid-15th-round price tag from the rest of the room. None of these are lottery-ticket fliers, they are legitimate projected starters or high-upside depth acquired at a persistent discount. Layer in Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Lamar Jackson at QB3 anchoring the top of the roster, and this is a team built the way a good contractor builds a house: no single flashy moment, just sound work at every station. The floor is high, the ceiling is real, and the draft process earned both.

Seven value picks, zero reaches, and not a single moment of panic buying, this is a manager who knew the board and let it come to them. Puka Nacua at WR1 was taken at 1.06 when the ADP had him going 1.01, a minor slip that WDennison caught cleanly. Drake Maye at QB2 slid to 2.07 and got scooped there too. The receiver group is the engine: Nacua, Rashee Rice at WR13, Carnell Tate at WR29, and DK Metcalf at WR36 all project as starters, and even with Rice's suspension history, probation trouble, and a knee procedure pushing him toward a delayed start, a healthy Rice is still a WR13 talent worth the wait. George Kittle falling a full round past his ADP is the kind of quiet win that separates disciplined drafters from lucky ones. There is very little to argue with here.

rosspreston enters 2026 sitting first in the You Don't Know Jack division and in the 98th percentile of the entire field, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. This was not a roster built on one transcendent pick or a single lucky fall. It was constructed pick after pick by a manager who kept finding players slightly past where they should have been. Jalen Hurts landed at 5.01 despite an ADP of 3.12, pairing neatly with DeVonta Smith, who slid to 4.12, giving the team a functional stack at a discount. James Cook arrived at 2.12 as a projected RB5, and Kyren Williams materialized in the sixth round as a projected RB15. David Montgomery added further depth in the ninth. The 2025 season, 14 wins and a 25th-percentile scoring finish, is the one blemish worth acknowledging, but the roster construction in 2026 looks categorically different. When a manager collects four good values and a steal without surrendering meaningful ground elsewhere, the outcome tends to take care of itself.
