The 2026 draft for DadChairSports reads like a case study in what happens when a manager falls in love with a position and panics everywhere else. The reach on Bucky Irving at pick 3.06, nearly four rounds ahead of his ADP, set the tone, and the board never recovered. Josh Jacobs followed at 4.07, Rico Dowdle at 9.06, six of the team's eighteen picks qualify as major reaches, and the net result is a receiving corps anchored by DJ Moore at WR26 and Michael Pittman at WR44, both of whom were also taken ahead of their ADP. Brock Bowers at TE1 and Tyler Warren at TE4 are genuinely excellent, but reaching for Warren in round two only sharpened the pain elsewhere. Baker Mayfield sits at QB18. The team ranks last in the Contra division and sits at the 1st percentile of the entire field. DadChairSports ran it back in 2026 with a draft that asked the wrong questions and answered them confidently.

There is no charitable read available for FREEDUKEJOHNSON, and the draft board confirms it. Zero steals, zero values, and seven reaches across 18 picks tells you everything about how this room operated, but the real indictment is in the details: Tyquan Thornton, projected WR97, was taken six full rounds before his ADP, which is less a draft pick than a confession. The foundation is real enough, Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and A.J. Brown at WR8 give this team a legitimate top end, but Brown was still a minor reach at pick 2.05, and the manager spent the rest of the draft paying premium prices for declining returns, arriving at Jayden Higgins as the projected weakest starter at WR54. That is not a depth problem, that is a ceiling problem dressed up as one. The 2025 season landed in the 26th percentile of scoring, and nothing in this draft suggests the trajectory changes.

FREEDUKEJOHNSON sits 11th in the Contra division and in the 4th percentile of the field, and at this point the numbers are just being honest about what the draft already said.

Last year SBFFC finished in the 84th percentile, and the roster they're running into 2026 is projected to land in the 28th. That is not a slump, that is a cliff. The foundation looks fine on its face: Josh Allen is the QB1, Drake London projects as WR7, Chris Olave as WR11, and Tucker Kraft slots in at TE5, all projected starters. The problem is that the supporting cast collapses fast and the draft did not fix it. The two major reaches, Trey Benson at RB64 and Chimere Dike at WR84, were each taken more than three rounds ahead of consensus, which means this manager paid premium capital for players the market considered late-round fliers. The two genuine values, Allen and Eli Stowers, are fine finds, but Allen was always going near the top and Stowers ranks TE32. The gap between what SBFFC was in 2025 and what the projections say they are now is the entire story of this team, and reputation is a poor substitute for depth when the standings get sorted.

Catch 22 finds itself in a familiar position for teams sitting ninth in the Contra Division and at just the 38th tournament percentile: knowing exactly what the problem is and having very little left to fix it. The receiver group has some genuine shine, Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 giving the team a legitimate top-end punch, but the drafting decisions upstream muddy that optimism. McMillan was reached on by nearly a full round, and the Sam LaPorta reach at pick 4.08 for a TE8 is the kind of move that costs a manager flexibility precisely when they need it most. Jaxson Dart at QB11 is a reasonable centerpiece and his connection with Isaiah Likely provides at least one working stack, but Dart's ceiling may not be high enough to carry a roster this far back in the standings. Xavier Worthy, projected at WR49, is the weakest starter, and that is not a position you want your margin to live in. The math here is unkind, and the draft did not add much cushion.

Bradys Deflation Needle did nearly everything right on draft day. Sixteen chalk picks, no major reaches, and a handful of genuine finds, including Jalen Hurts at QB9 taken nearly two rounds late and Chris Godwin at WR38 snagged a round past his ADP. The problem is that doing everything right still only gets you to 47th percentile, which is the draft equivalent of solving every step of the math problem and arriving at the wrong answer. Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Hurts anchor a genuinely threatening top end, and the projected starting group carries real optimism. But the depth behind that top tier loses altitude fast, and when you project out the full roster, the whole thing lands at eighth in the Contra division. Oronde Gadsden projects as the weakest starter at TE16, which is functional but not comfortable. Bradys Deflation Needle played the value game correctly and has the receipts to prove it. The standings column just does not seem to care.

Going Kommado sits at 56th percentile and seventh in the Contra division, which tells you everything: not a contender, not a casualty, just a team whose season lives in the margins. The clearest edge here is at the top of the tight end group, where Trey McBride (TE2), Kyle Pitts (TE7), and Travis Kelce (TE10) give this roster a genuine advantage most managers cannot match. Kelce's return matters because he's not a sentimental add, he's fighting his way back into the TE12 conversation, and even a slightly diminished Kelce sliding into a lineup alongside McBride and Pitts is a problem for opponents. The worry is that the upside stalls out further up the field. Garrett Wilson (WR17) and Ladd McConkey (WR20) are solid, but Michael Wilson (WR39) is projected as the weakest starter, and James Cook (RB5) has to carry most of the backfield production almost alone. The draft was mostly chalk with 16 picks near ADP, meaning Going Kommado built exactly the roster you see, nothing hidden, nothing coming. This team wins its matchups when the margins break right and loses them when they don't.

LordReebs did not swing for the fences and whiff. This roster was built trade by trade, pick by pick, with the kind of quiet competence that only shows up when you scroll through the results. The clearest example is the quarterback situation: Patrick Mahomes at QB12 and Brock Purdy at QB13 were both sitting in the seventh round while the rest of the field had already moved on, each falling roughly 1.3 rounds past their ADP. That is not luck, that is someone doing their homework and staying patient. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 anchors the skill positions, and the supporting cast, Luther Burden at WR22, Terry McLaurin at WR24, and Saquon Barkley at RB8, keeps the floor elevated even if Barkley is entering a phase of his career where the Eagles may start managing his workload more carefully. The 59th percentile projection and a sixth-place division rank suggest LordReebs is firmly in the conversation without being the favorite, which is exactly where you want to be before the season starts.

callen625 did not chase a single splashy moment and build a roster around it. They just kept winning the pick. Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 anchors a starting group that projects deep into the field, and Nico Collins at WR9 alongside Jameson Williams at WR21 and Jaylen Waddle at WR23 gives this team the kind of top-end receiver production that quietly decides who survives late rounds. The real story, though, is the patience shown with Mark Andrews. Taken at 11.02 when his ADP sat at 8.12, Andrews slipped more than two full rounds while the board moved around him, and callen625 simply waited and collected. Pair him with Jake Ferguson at TE12, and the tight end depth alone separates this roster from most of the division. Lamar Jackson at QB3 completes a Jackson-Andrews stack that adds genuine ceiling to what is already a steady floor. After a 38th-percentile finish in 2025, the 63rd-percentile projection here reflects a real step forward, built draft pick by draft pick rather than staked on one bold swing.

dkrugel75 didn't build this roster with one bold swing, just a series of decisions that kept coming out right. The clearest example is at quarterback, where Jayden Daniels (QB5) slid nearly two rounds past his ADP before dkrugel75 scooped him at 4.06, then Caleb Williams (QB6) fell even further, landing at 5.07 against a 3.06 average. Two starting-caliber quarterbacks taken at discount prices, both paired with their receivers in stacks, Williams alongside Rome Odunze (WR30) and Kyler Murray (QB19) alongside Justin Jefferson (WR6). That kind of structural value compounds. The wild card holding real upside is Bhayshul Tuten (RB25), who steps into a Jacksonville backfield that lost Travis Etienne to New Orleans in the offseason and is now genuinely winnable. Add a 74th percentile standing in the field and a roster whose weakest projected starter is Tony Pollard (RB30), and this looks like a team that earned its position the quiet way: by drafting smarter than the room, round after round.

crburks2 lands at 87th percentile in this field and sits third in the Contra division, and the draft sheet tells you exactly why: four outright steals, two values, and only one minor reach across the entire board. That kind of discipline is rare. Dak Prescott fell more than two rounds past his ADP, and crburks2 was there to scoop a QB7 at 5.09. Harold Fannin cost one round early at 4.04, which looks less like a reach and more like a manager who knew what he wanted and refused to let the board take it. The CeeDee Lamb pairing with Prescott gives the stack some genuine upside, and with Jonathan Taylor at RB4 and Omarion Hampton at RB9 anchoring the top of the lineup, this roster has the kind of proven talent that converts projected rank into actual points. After a 2025 that landed in the fourth percentile of scoring, crburks2 responded by drafting smarter than almost everyone in the room. The blueprint is clean. Now the players have to execute it.

Ausbrin didn't win the draft with one flashy pick. They won it by being right, repeatedly, and quietly. The foundation is hard to argue with: Bijan Robinson at RB2 and De'Von Achane at RB6 are legitimate difference-makers, and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 keeps the ceiling high even when the top two have off weeks. Then consider that Justin Herbert, a projected QB8 and a legitimate starter, slipped a full round and a half past his ADP before ausbrin scooped him up, and Derrick Henry at RB12 fell nearly a round, too. That's a draft that didn't just avoid mistakes, it collected the mistakes other managers made. Parker Washington is the most interesting question mark in the mix, a player who somehow led Jacksonville in targets and receiving yards last season despite every reasonable indicator suggesting he wouldn't, though whether the Jaguars actually commit to him as their lead option remains genuinely unclear. At 94th percentile in projected scoring and second in the Contra division, ausbrin enters 2026 looking less like a lucky roster and more like a well-reasoned one.

natelance1851 did not build this roster with one lottery-ticket swing. They built it by being right, repeatedly, in the middle rounds. Drake Maye fell nearly a full round past his ADP and landed at QB2. Malik Nabers slipped almost a round and turned into a WR12 starter. Rashee Rice drifted past his price and came in as a WR13. None of those pickups look like genius in isolation, but stack them together and you get a team sitting first in the Contra division and in the 97th percentile of the field. The WR group is the engine, with Puka Nacua projecting as WR1 and Nabers and Rice both cracking the top 13 at the position. There is some real uncertainty at the bottom of the roster, where RJ Harvey's path to meaningful touches in Denver looks increasingly crowded with Dobbins back and a new back added in the draft. But Harvey is the weakest projected starter, not a reflection of the roster overall, and the overall picture here is a team that did the quiet work and earned a loud result.
